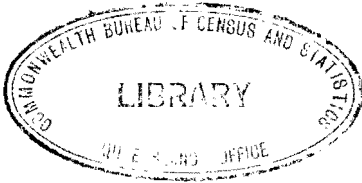

PREFACE

This Bulletin contains particulars of the population and dwellings of the States and Territories of Australia at the Census of 30th June, 1954, together with comparable figures for earlier years. The information provided is restricted to totals for complete States and Territories or for Divisions of States or Territories (i.e. Metropolitan Urban, Other Urban and Rural), and is not further dissected into local government areas, etc. Such information is provided in respect of the 1954 Census in Census Bulletin No. 2. — Population and Dwellings in Local Government Areas.

The figures herein were obtained after the completion of the preliminary check of Census returns, and were compiled at a later stage in the tabulation process than were the Field Count figures previously issued. The figures are not final, however, and are subject to revision on completion of the detailed tabulation.

All tables in this Bulletin exclude particulars of full-blood aboriginals and of dwellings occupied solely by them.

In accordance with previous practice, Census particulars were not required of diplomatic representatives of foreign governments and the High Commissioners representing the governments of the members of the British Commonwealth, with their families and staffs. The greater proportion of these persons was in Canberra, Australian Capital Territory, where the numbers of persons excluded from the Census was approximately 400, and the number of dwellings excluded 74.

DEFINITIONS

DIVISIONS OF STATES AND TERRITORIES

(i) Metropolitan Urban

Metropolitan Urban Divisions include the Capital Cities of the States and Canberra, the Capital City of Australia. The boundaries of the Capital Cities are determined for Census purposes by the Statisticians of the States, and normally include the city proper and all adjoining urban areas. In order to conform to the growth of the metropolitan urban population, the boundaries are reviewed at each Census and adjustments made, wherever necessary, to embrace contiguous urban areas that have developed since the previous Census.

Amendments were made in 1954 to the boundaries of the Metropolitan Urban Divisions in New South Wales, Victoria and Tasmania, but adjustments have been made to the 1947 figures in this Bulletin to permit comparisons of data from corresponding areas.

The City of Canberra was included in the Metropolitan Urban Division for the first time in 1954. Previously it was included in the Other Urban Division, or, as it was known at previous Censuses, the Provincial Urban Division.

(ii) Other Urban

Other Urban Divisions comprise the Capital City of the Northern Territory, all separately incorporated cities and towns, and all other towns with a population of 1,000 persons or more (750 in Tasmania), outside the Metropolitan Urban Divisions. The inclusion in the Other Urban Divisions in 1954 of the larger cities and towns not separately incorporated was a significant departure from the classification adopted at previous Censuses, when these towns (in all states except Tasmania) were included in the Rural Divisions, and the Other Urban Divisions (or Provincial Urban Divisions) were restricted to provincial separately incorporated cities and towns only. The foregoing transfer was designed to secure a more realistic subdivision of urban and rural areas outside the Metropolitan Urban Divisions.

As it is not possible to provide 1947 particulars for all these towns, it was necessary to combine the particulars for the Other Urban and Rural Divisions in all tables showing comparable data for the last two Censuses.

(iii) Rural

Rural Divisions comprise the remaining portions of each State and Territory, and are affected by the intercensal changes in the areas of the Metropolitan Urban and Other Urban Divisions. As already mentioned, the Rural Divisions exclude the cities and towns of 1,000 persons or more (750 in Tasmania) which were not separately incorporated.

The local government areas which provide the framework for the 1954 Census information in this Bulletin are as constituted at 30th September, 1953, except in several instances where it was possible to make provision for subsequent alterations to boundaries. The areas concerned, and the nature and dates of these alterations, are as follows:—

New South Wales — area of Cooma Municipality increased by 2,013 acres taken from Monaro Shire, 2nd October, 1953. Victoria — Borough of Kyabram created out of Rodney Shire, 1st April, 1954; increase in area of Narracan Shire taken from Yallourn Works Area, 26th May, 1954. South Australia — area of Corporation of Naracoorte increased by 1,512 acres taken from District Council of Naracoorte, 1st July, 1954; area of Corporation of Mount Gambier increased by 1,140 acres taken from District Council of Mount Gambier, 1st January, 1954. Western Australia — Kwinana Road District created out of Rockingham Road District, 15th February, 1954.

MIGRATORY

The term "Migratory" used in the following tables refers to persons not elsewhere enumerated who at midnight between 30th June and 1st July, 1954 were on ships in Australian waters or were travelling on long distance trains or aircraft.

DWELLING

For the purpose of the Census, a "dwelling" is any habitation occupied by a household group living together as a domestic unit, whether comprising the whole or only part of a building. The term has therefore a very wide reference, and includes, in addition to houses and flats, a great variety of "dwellings" ranging from a single-roomed shack to a multi-roomed hotel or institution.

UNOCCUPIED DWELLINGS

"Unoccupied Dwellings" is not synonymous with vacant houses and flats available for occupancy. Such dwellings consist mainly of "week-end", holiday and other dwellings whose usual occupants were temporarily absent on the night of the Census. They also include newly-completed dwellings awaiting occupancy. Examination of the geographical distribution of such "unoccupied dwellings" indicates that for the most part they were temporarily unoccupied, or located in rural areas other than towns with a population of 1,000 or more.
