PREFACE

This publication contains particulars of dwellings and householders in the Northern Territory recorded at the 1954 Census. The distribution of dwellings is shown by districts and in urban and rural divisions while the characteristics of dwellings and of householders (Class of Dwelling - i.e., whether Private House, Flat, etc., - Material of Outer Walls, Number of Rooms, Number of Inmates, Nature of Occupancy, Date of Building and Weekly Rent (Unfurnished) for Dwellings, and Sex, Age, Conjugal Condition, Period of Residence in Australia of persons born outside Australia, Industry and Occupational Status for Householders) are shown for the Territory as a whole and for the urban and rural divisions of the Territory in comparison with the 1947 Census and in cross-classification with other recorded characteristics.

This is the second Part issued of the five Parts which will constitute the complete Census Volume for the Territories. Part I. - Northern Territory : Population, has already been issued while the remaining Parts, which are in course of preparation, are Part III. - Australian Capital Territory : Population, Part IV. - Australian Capital Territory : Dwellings and Householders and Part V. - External Territories : Population and Dwellings. A separate Volume has been prepared for each State and for Australia as a whole.

Inside the back cover of this Part is a list of 1954 Census publications issued by this Bureau.

Explanatory Notes relative to the contents of the Part follow the Table of Contents.

## EXPLANATORY NOTES

Urban and Rural Divisions (Divisions of State). Because of the smallness of the population the designation "Metropolitan Urban" has not been applied to any area in the Northern Territory at any Census to date. The "Divisions of State" for the Northern Territory - Other Urban (term retained for uniformity with State Volumes), Rural and Migratory - as defined for Census purposes and as referred to throughout this Part, are constituted as follows :-

Other Urban - Comprises the towns of Darwin (the principal town of the Northern Territory) and Alice Springs. At the time of the 1947 and 1954 Censuses there was no system of local government in the Territory similar to that which exists in the States, so boundaries of these towns were specially adopted for Census purposes. In the case of Darwin, for the 1954 Census the boundaries were those of the area known at that time as "Proposed Greater Darwin", which embraced a considerably larger area than did the boundaries adopted at the 1947 Census. This area must not be confused with the Municipality of Darwin which was constituted on 28th June, 1957. The differences between the 1947 and 1954 Census areas for Darwin and the new Municipality of Darwin are explained in a footnote to Table No. 53 of Part I. For Alice Springs, the area covered by the town at these two Censuses may be regarded as unaltered.

Rural - Comprises the remainder of the Territory, and is affected by the changed boundaries of Darwin.

Migratory - Refers to persons not elsewhere enumerated who at midnight between 30th June and 1st July, 1954, were travelling on ships in Northern Territory waters or on long-distance trains or aircraft. Particulars of this division, which refer to population only, are shown in Table No. 2. of this Part.

Variation in the boundaries of the town of Darwin must be borne in mind when making comparisons between Censuses for urban and rural population.

Dwellings. - For the purpose of the Census, a "dwelling" is any habitation occupied by a household group living together as a domestic unit, whether comprising the whole or only part of a building. The term has, therefore, a very wide reference, and includes, in addition to houses and flats, a great variety of "dwellings" ranging from a single-roomed shack to a multi-roomed hotel or institution.

Occupied Dwellings. - Occupied Dwellings are classified into private and other dwellings.

Private Dwellings. - These comprise Private Houses (including Sheds, Huts, Garages, etc., used for dwelling purposes), Shares of Private Houses, Flats, and Rooms, Apartments, etc. In previous Censuses dwellings returned on the Schedules as sheds, huts, garages, etc. were included with private houses. In the Census of 1954 these dwellings are shown in tabulations as a separate group wherever practicable, but are linked with private houses to preserve continuity with past Census results. Separate particulars are shown in the 1947 Census publications for private houses which were shared by two or more family units and for which only one Householder's Schedule was received, but in 1954 these dwellings were included with private houses. For purposes of comparison in this Part particulars of the 1947 houses so shared are similarly treated.

Share of Private House. - A share of a private house is a portion of a shared private house which is occupied separately and for which portion a separate Householder's Schedule was furnished.

Flat. - A flat is part of a house or other building which can be completely closed off and which includes both cooking and bathing facilities.

Other Private Dwellings. - These include dwellings such as apartments, rooms, etc., which are parts of buildings but are not self-contained units.

Dwellings other than Private. - These include Hotels, Boarding Houses, Lodging Houses, Hostels, Educational, Religious and Charitable Institutions, Hospitals, Defence and Penal Establishments, Police and Fire Stations, Clubs, Staff Barracks, and Quarters, etc.

Unoccupied Dwellings. - The tables in this Part, except for Nos. 1 and 2, exclude particulars of unoccupied dwellings. The term "unoccupied dwellings" is not synonymous with vacant houses and flats available for occupancy, but refers mainly to dwellings whose usual occupants were temporarily absent on the night of the Census. Newly-completed dwellings awaiting occupancy are also included.

Wagons and Camps. - This group, which includes caravans, relates to the transient habitations of itinerants and persons camping out, where occupancy is of short duration only. Particulars are excluded from all tables in this Part, except Nos. 1 and 2. This group is distinct from "Migratory" - see definition above.

Rents. - All rents shown in this Part are on an unfurnished basis. Dwellings shown as rent "Not Stated" include those whose rents were shown on Householders' Schedules on a furnished basis, and those whose rents were not applicable (e.g. for shop and dwelling combined).

The broad features of this Part may be ascertained from the Table of Contents on page 2, but to facilitate reference to particular subjects an index is also provided - see last pages of the publication.

This Part contains particulars relating to each characteristic of dwellings and of householders obtained from the 1954 Census tabulations. However, additional information is available in some instances, but limitations of space prohibit its publication in complete detail. Such additional information relative to this Part and also to Part I. - Northern Territory : Population, may be obtained on inquiry from the Commonwealth Statistician.

Particulars of full-blood aboriginals and of dwellings occupied solely by them are excluded throughout.
