PREFACE

This publication contains particulars of the characteristics of population and dwellings in the Territory of Papua and New Guinea, the Territory of Norfolk Island and the Territory of Nauru recorded at the 1954 Census.

Details are shown of the characteristics of the population (Age, Conjugal Condition, Birthplace, Period of Residence in the Territory of Persons born outside the Territory, Nationality, Race, Religion, Occupational Status and Industry) and of dwellings (Class of Dwelling — i.e., whether Private House, Flat, etc., — Material of Outer Walls, Number of Rooms, Number of Inmates, Nature of Occupancy, Date of Building and Weekly Rent (Unfurnished)) as recorded for each Territory. The distribution of population and dwellings by districts in the Territory of Papua and New Guinea is also shown.

This is the last Part issued of the five Parts which will constitute the Census Volume for the Territories. Parts already issued are Part I. - Northern Territory: Population, Part II. - Northern Territory: Dwellings and Householders, Part III: Australian Capital Territory: Population and Part IV. Australian Capital Territory: Dwellings and Householders.

Inside the back cover of this Part is a list of 1954 Census publications issued by this Bureau.

Explanatory Notes relative to the contents of the Part follow the Table of Contents.

NON-INDIGENOUS POPUL ATION

Age. — In tables relating to age herein, ages recorded at the 1954 Census have been adjusted prior to tabulation by the distribution of unspecified ages, i.e., instances where ages have been omitted from the Census Schedule. A detailed explanation of the procedure adopted for the distribution will be contained in the Statistician's Report.

Nationality. — British protected persons and Australian protected persons were classified in one category separate from British nationality but for publication they have been included under the heading "British". Naturalized British persons are also included under the heading "British" but separate particulars of these persons are not available.

Race. — The classification of race adopted for the Census in the Territories was that used for the Census of the Commonwealth of Australia except that, for the Territory of Papua and New Guinea, the classification was extended to show separately those persons whose parents were both of non-European race but either of whom was wholly or partly descended from an aboriginal native of the Territory of Papua and New Guinea.

Religion. - Under the Census Ordinances of the Territories the Census question on religion has always been optional.

DWELLINGS OCCUPIED SOLELY BY NON-INDIGENOUS POPULATION

Dwellings. - For the purpose of the Census, a "dwelling" is any habitation occupied by a household group living together as a domestic unit, whether comprising the whole or only part of a building. The term has, therefore, a very wide reference, and includes, in addition to houses and flats, a great variety of "dwellings" ranging from a single-roomed shack to a multi-roomed hotel or institution.

Occupied Dwellings. - Occupied Dwellings are classified into private and other dwellings.

Private Dwellings. — These comprise Private Houses (including Sheds, Huts, Garages, etc., used for dwelling purposes), Shares of Private Houses, Flats and Rooms, Apartments, etc. In previous Censuses dwellings returned on the Schedules as sheds, huts, garages, etc. were included with private houses. In the Census of 1954 these dwellings are shown in tabulations as a separate group wherever practicable, but are linked with private houses to preserve continuity with past Census results. Separate particulars are shown in the 1947 Census publications for private houses which were shared by two or more family units and for which only one Householder's Schedule was received, but in 1954 these dwellings were included with private houses.

Share of Private House. — A share of a private house is a portion of a shared private house which is occupied separately and for which portion a separate Householder's Schedule was furnished.

Flat. - A flat is part of a house or other building which can be completely closed off and which includes both cooking and bathing facilities.

Other Private Dwellings. - These include dwellings such as apartments, rooms, etc., which are parts of buildings but are not self-contained units.

Dwellings other than Private. - These include Hotels, Boarding Houses, Lodging Houses, Hostels, Educational, Religious and Charitable Institutions, Hospitals, Defence and Penal Establishments, Police and Fire Stations, Clubs, Staff Barracks, and Quarters, etc.

Rents. - All rents shown in this Part are on an unfurnished basis. Dwellings shown as rent "Not Stated" include those whose rents were shown on Householders' Schedules on a furnished basis, and those whose rents were not applicable (e.g. for shop and dwelling combined).

This Part contains particulars relating to each characteristic of the population and of dwellings obtained from the 1954 Census tabulations. However, additional information is available in some instances. Such additional information may be obtained on inquiry from the Commonwealth Statistician, Canberra, A.C.T.

Particulars of indigenous population and of dwellings occupied solely by indigenous population are excluded throughout. There was no indigenous population in Norfolk Island.
