7121.0 *Agricultural Commodities, Australia, 1997–98* (\$18.00)

Presents final estimates of production for all commodities collected in the Agricultural Commodity Survey. These include broadacre crops, fruit and vegetables as well as the number of livestock and livestock products. Also includes details of industry structure including counts of farms by the Australian and New Zealand Standard Industrial Classification and size (physical and economic).

8141.0.30.001 *Business Longitudinal Survey, Australia: Confidential Unit Record File on CD-ROM, 1994–95 to 1996–97* (\$7,500.00)

A Confidential Unit Record File (CURF) from the Australian Business Longitudinal Survey (BLS). The BLS provides a unique database which examines a wide range of business characteristics and behaviours, and links these to performance over time. The BLS provides the analyst with information to examine the impact of issues such as exporting, innovation, business planning, different employment structures, different financial structures, training, business networks (just to mention a few) have on business growth and performance. The analyst can choose or construct a range of different performance measures based on profit, sales, assets, equity or capital expenditure.

The file contains data from a sample of approximately 5,100 small and medium private sector businesses covering most industries for each of the three years 1994–95 to 1996–97.

8918.0.00.001 *Siena Group Papers: Families at the end of the 20th Century — Volume 1, 1998—99* (\$20.00)

The Siena Group was created in 1993. The main purpose of the group is the promotion and co-ordination of international co-operation in the area of social statistics. The focus is on social indicators, social accounting, concepts and classifications, as well as analysis of the linkages and framework for integrating social, economic and demographic data for the purposes of policy formulation and analysis.

There are three volumes of the proceedings of the Siena Group Meeting held in Sydney, Australia from 7 to 9 December 1998. The volumes describe the achievements of the group to date and proposes the future activities and mode of operation of the group.
