Tables include information on the age, sex, living arrangements and educational and labour force experience of people with disabilities and people aged 65 and over. Information is provided on their need for and receipt of assistance with a range of everyday activities. Carer information indicates how much of this assistance is provided by family and friends.
	4515.6	Community Safety, Tasmania, October 1998 (\$16.00) Contains information collected from usual residents, aged 18 years and over, living in selected private dwellings. Includes data on level and nature of fear of crime in the community; factors which influence levels of fear of crime, such as experience of victimisation, home security and perception of neighbourhood problems. Details are also provided on main ways in which members of the community find out about crime in their neighbourhood; perceived level of crime in the community; and awareness and perceived effectiveness of community crime prevention programs.
