The 1996 Census of Population and Housing, conducted by the Australian Bureau of Statistics (ABS) on 6 August 1996, collected data on a range of social and demographic topics, including the occupation of all employed persons aged 15 years and over. The principal statistical output on the occupation of employed persons is classified according to the Australian Standard Classification of Occupations (ASCO), Second Edition. This replaced ASCO First Edition which was used for 1986 and 1991 Censuses.

To facilitate the comparison of occupation data between the 1996 Census and the 1986 and 1991 Censuses, the ABS has developed a link between the two editions of ASCO. Such a quantitative link is necessary because of significant structural differences between ASCO First Edition and ASCO Second Edition. The link was developed by coding responses to questions for occupation to both the First and Second Editions of ASCO, using a specially developed coding index. This paper explains the nature of the link and provides a set of basic statistical tables for comparative analysis showing actual numbers of responses coded to each of the major groups of the First and Second Editions of ASCO.

An electronic file showing detailed links between the First and Second Editions of ASCO at the occupation level is available on floppy disk (1996 Census of Population and Housing: Link File Between First and Second Editions of Australian Standard Classification of Occupations (ASCO) (Cat. no. 1232.0.55.001)). The electronic file is explained further on page 8 of this information paper. The floppy disk, which also contains an electronic version of this paper and a complete listing of ASCO First and Second Edition occupations, can be ordered using the form at the back of this paper.

CONCEPTUAL BASIS OF ASCO

ASCO is a skill-based classification of occupations which covers all jobs in the Australian work force. The concepts of 'job' and 'occupation' are fundamental to an understanding of the classification.

For the purposes of ASCO, a job is defined as the set of tasks designed to be performed by one individual in return for a wage or salary. Of course, some people may work for themselves but they are still regarded as having a job and as belonging to the labour force.

An occupation is a set of jobs with similar sets of tasks. Within ASCO, occupations are classified according to two criteria; skill level and skill specialisation.

SKILL LEVEL

Skill level is defined as the range and complexity of the set of tasks involved: the greater the range and complexity of the set of tasks, the greater the skill level of the occupation.

In ASCO First Edition, this was measured operationally as the amount of formal education, on-the-job training and previous experience usually necessary for the satisfactory performance of the set of tasks.

Whilst the concept of skill level remains unchanged in ASCO Second Edition, the operational criteria used to measure skill level have been refined to reflect competency-based initiatives in employment and training; and increase the emphasis on entry requirements to an occupation. This emphasis on entry requirements arises in part from the difficulty in objectively measuring the skill level required for the satisfactory performance of tasks.

The criteria used in ASCO Second Edition to measure skill level are the formal education and/or training, and previous experience usually required for entry to an occupation.

In instances where information relating to these entry requirements was not available, relevant minimum endorsed competency standards were also considered where appropriate.

Where these criteria were not sufficient, skill level was determined by application of a secondary set of criteria:

- breadth/depth of knowledge required;
- range of skills required;
- variability of operating environment; and
- level of autonomy as determined by the degree of discretion and choice which may be required to perform the set of tasks.

SKILL SPECIALISATION

The skill specialisation of an occupation is a function of the field of knowledge required, tools and equipment used, materials worked on, and goods or services produced in relation to the tasks performed. In ASCO Second Edition the definition of skill specialisation remains unchanged but includes reference to non-production based operations.

STRUCTURE OF ASCO SECOND EDITION

The structure of ASCO Second Edition comprises five hierarchical levels: Major Group, Sub-Major Group, Minor Group, Unit Group and Occupation. This represents a change from ASCO First Edition, where the structure consisted of four levels; Major Group, Minor Group, Unit Group and Occupation. The Sub-Major group level has been added to the structure to enhance users' options for statistical output. The table below indicates the number of groups in each edition:

In addition to the introduction of a fifth level in the classification hierarchy mentioned previously, there are a number of significant structural differences between the First and Second Editions of ASCO.

SKILL LEVEL

A more rigorous approach to the application of the skill level criteria resulted in changes to the way some occupations are classified in ASCO Second Edition. ASCO First Edition had eight major groups representing eight skill levels. In the Second Edition each of nine major groups is assigned to one of five broad skill levels. This addresses criticism of First Edition ASCO which has eight skill levels corresponding with the eight major groups. Major groups at the same skill level are differentiated from each other on the basis of skill specialisation.

Clerical, Sales & Service Occupations

Another major change has been the reorganisation of clerical, sales and service occupations. ASCO First Edition included these occupations in Major Group 5 'Clerks' and Major Group 6 'Sales and Personal Service Workers'. However, in ASCO Second Edition these have been included in three major groups, Major Group 5 'Advanced Clerical and Service Workers', Major Group 6 'Intermediate Clerical, Sales and Service Workers' and Major Group 8 'Elementary Clerical, Sales and Service Workers'. These new groups have different skill levels which better reflect the skill level of the occupations they include.

OTHER STRUCTURAL CHANGES

In some areas of the classification additional unit groups have been created to provide more detailed information at the unit group level.

Specific examples of some other important changes to the classification are outlined on the following page.

Managing Supervisors

Managers of small organisations and businesses which do not necessarily have a hierarchy of managers, are now classified in Major Group 3 'Associate Professionals' (Skill Level 2), in contrast to the First Edition where they were classified in Major Group 1 (Skill Level 1) along with general and specialist manager occupations.

Air and Sea Transport Technical Workers

ASCO First Edition Minor Group 33 'Air and Sea Transport Technical Workers', e.g. Aircraft Pilot, Air Traffic Controller, Ship's Master, has been moved to Second Edition Major Group 2 'Professionals'.

Registered Nurses

The First Edition Minor Group 34 'Registered Nurses' has been moved to Second Edition Major Group 2 'Professionals'.

Enrolled Nurses

The First Edition Unit Group 6603 'Enrolled Nurses' has been moved to Major Group 3 'Associate Professionals' and is now Second Edition Minor Group 341 'Enrolled Nurses'.

Welfare Workers

Welfare Workers have been moved from ASCO First Edition Unit Group 3901 'Welfare Para-professionals' to Second Edition, Unit Group 2512 'Welfare and Community Workers'.

Other changes

Other changes reflected in the ASCO Second Edition structure are the result of the emergence and decline of occupations in the Australian labour market. The increased significance of various industry sectors to the economy, in particular the service and information technology sectors, has led to the emergence of a number of new occupations. Conversely, technological and structural changes in the Australian work force have also resulted in the decline of some occupations.

CODING OCCUPATION RESPONSES

SCOPE OF CENSUS DATA

In the 1996 Census, data on occupations were collected from persons aged 15 years and over whose labour force status was classified as employed. Persons were defined as employed if they:

- worked for payment or profit, or as an unpaid helper in a family business, during the week prior to census night; or
- were on leave or otherwise temporarily absent; or
- were on strike or stood down temporarily.

Occupation data were not collected for persons who were unemployed or not in the labour force.

Persons were classified as unemployed if they did not have a job but were actively looking for work and available to start work.

Persons aged 15 years and over who were neither employed or unemployed were classified as not in the labour force. This included persons who were retired, pensioners and persons engaged solely in home duties.

CENSUS OCCUPATION QUESTIONS

Four questions on the census form (questions 32, 33, 34 and 36 shown below) were used to assist in coding of occupation for the 1996 Census.

Q32 In the main job held last week, what was the person's occupation?

- Give full title.
- For example, Childcare Aide, Maths Teacher, Pastry cook, Tanning Machine Operator, Apprentice Toolmaker.
- For public servants, state official designation and occupation. For armed services personnel, state rank and occupation.

Q33 What are the main tasks that the person himself/herself usually performs in that occupation?

- Give full details.
- For example, looking after children at day care centre, teaching secondary school students, making cakes and pastries, operating leather tanning machine, learning to make and repair tools and dies.
- For managers, state main activities managed.

Q34 For the main job held last week, what was the employer's business name?

- For self-employed persons, print name of business.
- For teachers, print name of school.

Q36 What kind of industry, business or service is carried out by the employer at that address?

 Describe as fully as possible, using two words or more, for example, dairy farming, footwear manufacturing.

CODING RESPONSES

Occupation information was coded using standard computer-assisted coding procedures to ensure accuracy and consistency of data. More details on coding occupations can be found in *ASCO — Australian Standard Classification of Occupations, Second Edition* (Cat. no. 1220.0) and *ASCO — Australian Standard Classification of Occupations, Second Edition and ASCO Coder* (Cat. no. 1220.0.30.001).

ASCO FIRST EDITION/SECOND EDITION LINK

The link was developed by coding all occupation responses in the 1996 Census to both First and Second Editions of ASCO.

INFORMATION PAPER

The tables in this paper show the distribution of ASCO First Edition major groups across Second Edition major groups, and vice versa, by sex and State.

ELECTRONIC LINK FILE

The electronic link file available on floppy disk, 1996 Census of Population and Housing: Link File Between First and Second Editions of Australian Standard Classification of Occupations (ASCO) (Cat no. 1232.0.55.001), contains frequencies for each First Edition occupation linked to Second Edition codes. These data are provided electronically in tables for each State and Territory and a table for total Australia.

Frequencies of less than or equal to 3 are set to 0 to maintain confidentiality of data.

Responses which contained insufficient detail to be coded to occupation level (6 digits) were coded to unit, minor, sub-major or major group depending on the level of detail in the responses provided. These codes ending in zero are described as 'not further defined' (n.f.d.) codes.

For example, responses which cannot be identified as relating directly to a particular occupation within a particular unit group are coded to that unit group. Such responses are allocated an n.f.d. code consisting of the four-digit code of the Unit Group followed by '-00'. For instance, the response 'Medical Specialist' does not contain sufficient information to be coded directly to any particular occupation category, but it can be coded to Unit Group 2312 'Specialist Medical Practitioners', which encompasses all medical specialists. It is thus allocated the code 2312–00 'Specialist Medical Practitioners', n.f.d.

ELECTRONIC LINK FILE continued

The link file also contains a number of codes to deal with responses which do not provide sufficient information to be coded to any level of the ASCO structure. These codes commence with '9' for ASCO First Edition and with '0' for Second Edition. For example, the response 'Public Servant' without task information indicates that the person is employed by a government agency but provides no information about occupation in ASCO terms. To assist users in interpretation of the data this response was assigned the ASCO First Edition code 9994–00 and the Second Edition Code 0998–40. These codes are not part of the ASCO classification. Further information regarding these codes can be obtained by contacting the ASCO Hotline on 02 6252 5757.

The 'inadequately described' category comprises responses which could not be coded to any level of the classification.

TABLE INFORMATION

The tables in this publication refer to employed persons aged 15 years and over. Tables 1 and 2 on the following pages show the proportion of these people in First Edition major groups that were allocated to Second Edition major groups.

These tables are designed to be read by row, and not by column. For example, the first row of table 1 (see opposite page) refers to responses that would have been coded to First Edition Major Group 'Managers and Administrators' for the male population. This row indicates that, of these responses:

- 75.90% were coded to Second Edition Major Group 'Managers and Administrators;
- 2.12% were coded to Second Edition Major Group 'Professionals'; and
- 21.66% were coded to Second Edition Major Group 'Associate Professionals'.
