RACE OF THE POPULATION AUSTRALIA, STATES AND TERRITORIES

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INTRODUCTION

This bulletin contains particulars of the population of each State and Territory of Australia as at the Census of 30th June, 1961, classified according to race.

The characteristic "Race" refers broadly to the ethnic origin of the person irrespective of where born or of what nationality. For this characteristic the basic data do not permit of scientific classification of ethnic origin and the races are named with a geographical ratner than a truly ethnological description. Thus "Indian" refers to the ethnic types normally to be found in India. In other words, each racial group described in this fashion is a mixed group when viewed in the light of the hypothetical genetic types from which it is derived. The limitations imposed by the practical need to present the Non-European races by their commonly recognized rather than their scientific groupings are further complicated by the necessity of combining as one group all persons of European origin. Census statistics of "Race", cannot, therefore, answer fully the questions which interest the anthropologist and ethnologist, but they do possess utility for governmental administration and other practical purposes.

There were 41,580 persons of full-blood Non-European race and 47,845 persons of half European - half Non-European race recorded in Australia at the Census. The numbers of these born in and born outside Australia were as follows:-

The Australian Census is on a defacto basis, i.e. it enumerates persons in the country, whether permanently or temporarily, at the time of the Census. Persons enumerated thus include crews of vessels in port or on the Australian coast, and business men, students and others whose residence in Australia is of a temporary nature. These categories of persons are reflected in the statistics of period of residence in Australia of persons of Non-European race born outside Australia, as shown in the following table:-

In the general presentation of population statistics derived from the Census full-blood Australian Aboriginals are excluded because the Commonwealth Constitution (Section 127) provides that "In reckoning the numbers of the people

of the Commonwealth, or of a State or other part of the Commonwealth, aboriginal natives shall not be counted". Consequently they are excluded from Tables 1 and 2 of this bulletin. However, at the Census of 1961, as at previous Censuses, collectors were instructed to ascertain as fully as possible, by means of the ordinary schedule, detailed information concerning full-blood Australian Aboriginals who were either in employment, or living on reserves, camps, etc. in proximity to settlements. Details of the number of full-blood Aboriginals excluded from the results of the 1961 Census were first published in Census Bulletin No. 23 issued on 28th November, 1962. These have been repeated in the present bulletin for convenience of those wishing to find data for both full-blood Aboriginals and persons of half European blood and half Aboriginal blood in the one publication.

In accordance with standard practice, Census particulars were not required of diplomatic representatives of foreign governments and the High Commissioners representing the governments of the member countries of the Commonwealth of Nations, with their families and staffs. The greater proportion of these persons were in Canberra, Australian Capital Territory, where the number of persons excluded from the 1961 Census was approximately 800.

Detailed tabulations relating to race will be published in the final printed Detailed Tables of the 1961 Census.

A list of 1961 Census publications already issued appears at the end of this bulletin.
