# POPULATION AND DWELLINGS OF STATES AND TERRITORIES, METROPOLITAN URBAN, OTHER URBAN AND RURAL DIVISIONS.

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#### INTRODUCTION.

This Bulletin contains particulars of the population and dwellings of the States and Territories of Australia at the Census of 30th June, 1961, together with comparable figures for earlier Censuses. The information is restricted to totals for complete States and Territories or for Divisions of States or Territories (i.e. Metropolitan Urban, Other Urban and Rural), and is not further dissected into local government areas, etc. Such information is now available for the 1961 Census in Census Bulletin No. 2. - Population and Dwellings in Local Government Areas.

All 1961 Census figures in this Bulletin are derived from the initial balancing of the punched cards, and very little, if any, further amendment is expected.

All tables exclude particulars of full-blood aboriginals and of dwellings occupied solely by them.

In accordance with standard practice, Census particulars were not required of diplomatic representatives of foreign governments and the High Commissioners representing the Governments of the numbers of the Commonwealth of Nations, with their families and staffs. The greater proportion of these persons was in Canberra, Australian Capital Territory, where the numbers of persons excluded from the Census was approximately 800, and the number of dwellings excluded, 200.

A list of 1961 Census Publications issued to date appears at the end of this Bulletin.

### DEFINITIONS.

### Divisions of States and Territories -

(i) Metropolitan Urban. - Metropolitan Urban Divisions include the Capital Cities of the States and Canberra, the Capital City of Australia. The boundaries of the Capital Cities are determined for Census purposes by the Commonwealth Statistician in collaboration with the Deputy Commonwealth Statisticians of the States and normally include the city proper and all adjoining urban areas. To conform to the growth of the metropolitan urban population, the boundaries are reviewed at each Census, and adjustments are made wherever necessary, to embrace contiguous urban areas that have developed since the previous Census.

Amendments were made in 1961 to the boundaries of the Metropolitan Urban Divisions in Victoria, Queensland and Tasmania, but adjustments have been made to the 1954 figures in this Bulletin to permit comparisons of data for corresponding areas.

- (ii) Other Urban. Other Urban Divisions comprise:
  - o the Capital City of the Northern Territory;
  - o all separately incorporated cities and towns outside the Metropolitan Urban Division, except, in 1961, for any portions within the legal boundaries of the city or town which were specifically regarded as rural for Census purposes or where the population of the whole town was less than 1,000;
  - o all other towns (within boundaries defined for Census purposes) with a population of 1,000 persons or more (750 in Tasmania) outside the Metropolitan Urban Divisions. (Adjustments necessary to the 1954 data for Other Urban and Rural Divisions to permit of valid comparison with 1961 data have not been determined at this stage and therefore the data for these two divisions have been combined for the purposes of Tables 6 and 7 in this Bulletin).
- (iii) Rural. Rural Divisions comprise the remaining portions of each State and Territory. As mentioned above, they exclude the cities and towns of 1,000 persons or more (750 in Tasmania) which were not separately incorporated.
- (iv) Migratory. The term "Migratory" used in the following tables refers to persons not elsewhere enumerated who at midnight between 29th and 30th June, 1961 were on ships in Australian waters, or were travelling on long-distance trains, motor coaches or aircraft.

<u>Dwelling.</u> - For the purpose of the Census, a "dwelling" is any habitation occupied by a household group living together as a domestic unit, whether comprising the whole or only part of a building. The term has, therefore, a very wide reference, and includes, <u>in addition to houses and flats</u>, a great variety of "dwellings" ranging from a single-roomed hut to a multi-roomed hotel or institution.

Unoccupied dwellings. - "Unoccupied dwellings" include vacant dwellings available for sale or renting; dwellings such as "week-ender", "holiday home", "second home", "seasonal quarters", which were not occupied on the night of the Census; dwellings normally occupied but whose usual occupants were temporarily absent on the night of the Census; newly completed dwellings whose owners or tenants had not entered into occupation on the night of the Census; dwellings described as "condemned", "awaiting demolition", "deceased estate", "exhibition home", etc.; and buildings constructed as dwellings but used for non-dwelling purposes on the night of the Census. The total number of unoccupied dwellings shown for any area must not, therefore, be read as representing the number of vacant houses and flats available for sale or renting. Census Bulletin No. 2. - Population and Dwellings in Local Government Areas, includes a table showing the number of unoccupied dwellings, in each Division of State or Territory, classified according to reasons why unoccupied.
