SUMMARY OF POPULATION AND DWELLINGS FOR THE TERRITORY OF NORFOLK ISLAND.

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
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INTRODUCTION.

This Bulletin contains an analysis, in summary form, of the population and dwellings of the Territory of Norfolk Island as enumerated at the Census of 30th June, 1961. It is one of a series of Census Bulletins for the States and Territories and for Australia as a whole being issued as information becomes available from the first phase of machine tabulation. The information herein may be subject to minor amendment on completion of later tabulations. A list of 1961 Census publications already issued appears at the end of this Bulletin.

In this Bulletin the population is classified according to age, conjugal condition, birthplace, period of residence in Norfolk Island of persons born outside Norfolk Island, nationality, religion, industry and occupational status. Dwellings are classified according to class, (i.e. private house, flat, etc.) and private houses according to number of rooms, number of inmates, material of outer walls, nature of occupancy, date of building, rent and facilities.

Each major table herein shows the numbers of males, females and persons or of dwellings according to one particular characteristic (e.g., age or conjugal condition of persons or number of rooms or inmates of dwellings). At a later stage the data in this Bulletin will be published in amplified form in the Detailed Tables of the Census and detailed analyses showing particulars of both population and dwellings in a series of cross-tabulations (e.g. the numbers of males and females in the various industries according to their age groups and the numbers of dwellings according to both numbers of rooms and inmates, etc.) will be available in the Census Division of the Bureau.

A feature of this table is the high proportion of persons in the older age groups. The proportion of persons 65 years and over was 14.5 per cent. at the 1961 Census and 15.2 per cent. in 1954.

A marked decrease (46.2 per cent) occurred between Censuses in the female population of the age group 0-4. This accounted for the decrease of 21.7 per cent. in this age group.

Although there was an overall decrease in total population of 10.4 per cent. since 1954, the age groups 5-14, 35-39 and 75-94 increased by 11.4 per cent., 15.1 per cent. and 24.0 per cent. respectively.

Because the male population decreased by a greater proportion than the female (11.9 per cent. compared with 8.8 per cent.) the male surplus of 14 in 1954 was changed to a male deficit of 2 in 1961.

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2. <u>Conjugal Condition</u> - The following table shows the population of Norfolk Island classified according to sex and conjugal condition.

At the 1961 Census 42.3 per cent. of the population were never married (39.9 per cent. in 1954); 44.5 per cent. married (46.7 per cent. in 1954); 1.7 per cent. married but permanently separated (2.1 per cent. in 1954); 8.9 per cent. widowed (9.4 per cent. in 1954) and 2.6 per cent. divorced (1.7 per cent. in 1954).

At the 30th June, 1961, 46.9 per cent. of the total population were born in Norfolk Island compared with 45.9 per cent. in 1954.

Of the persons born outside Norfolk Island, those born in the following countries were most numerous : Australia, 22.2 per cent. of the total population (19.7 per cent. in 1954); New Zealand 18.2 per cent. (20.8 per cent. in 1954); and England, 6.5 per cent. (8.0 per cent. in 1954).

4. <u>Period of Residence.</u> - The following table shows, for the 1954 and 1961 Censuses, the period of residence in Norfolk Island of persons born outside Norfolk Island.

Of those persons born outside Norfolk Island who stated their period of residence, 51.8 per cent. had, at 30th June, 1961, resided on the Island less than 7 years. At 30th June, 1954 this figure was 63.3 per cent.

At the 1961 Census persons who had resided less than 1 year accounted for 28.6 per cent, of those who answered the question.

There were 87 persons or 10.3 per cent. of the population who declined to answer this question in 1961 compared with 93 persons or 9.9 per cent. in 1954.

The Church of England had most adherents in 1961 with 451 followed by Methodist, 130; Seventh Day Adventist, 69; Roman Catholic and Catholic (so described), 54; and Presbyterian, 34. The 54 adherents of the Roman Catholic Church consisted of 41 who described themselves as "Roman Catholic" and 13 as "Catholic". It is presumed that most of the latter were adherents of the Roman Catholic Church. 7. <u>Industry.</u> - The following table shows the main groups of industry for persons on Norfolk Island at 30th June, 1961, compared with 1954. For industry groups Finance and Property, Public Authority (n.e.i.) and Defence Services and Community and Business Services (including Professional) the figures derived from the 1954 classification have been adjusted to the classification used in 1961.

The largest group in 1961 was Primary Production with 91 persons (87 males and 4 females). It represented 29.3 per cent. of the total work force. Commerce was next with 44 persons (14.1 per cent. of the work force) followed by Public Authority (n.e.i.) and Defence Services (11.9 per cent.). Community and Business Services (including Professional), and Amusement, Hotels, etc., each had 27 persons or 8.7 per cent. of the work force.

Although there was a decrease of 8.5 per cent. in the total work force since 1954, the number of persons in Primary Production increased by 56.9 per cent. The increase of 32 males contrasted with the decrease of 40 males in Building and Construction.


Figures are not yet available for 1961 to show industry in any greater detail than given in Table 7.

8. <u>Occupational Status.</u> - The following table gives details of the occupational status of the population at 30th June, 1961, compared with the 1954 Census. It shows the capacity in which persons are engaged in the work force, whether as employer, employee, not at work, etc., as well as particulars of those persons not in the work force.

At the 30th June, 1961, 71.4 per cent. of the work force were employees (66.4 per cent. in 1954); 20.3 per cent. self-employed (24.5 per cent. in 1954); and 5.5 per cent. employers (6.4 per cent. in 1954). The proportion of dependent population (i.e. persons not in the work forge) to total population was lower in 1961 than in 1954 being 63.2 per cent. and 63.9 per cent. respectively.

9. <u>Definitions and Scope</u>. - For the purpose of the Census a dwelling is any habitation occupied by a household group living together as a domestic unit, whether comprising the whole or only a part of a building.

Occupied Dwellings are classified into "private" and "other than private" dwellings.

<u>Private Dwellings</u> in Norfolk Island comprise private houses, shares of private houses, and flats.

Dwellings Other than Private include the hotel, hospital and boarding houses.

<u>Unoccupied Dwellings</u> include dwellings temporarily unoccupied on the night of the Census and nearly completed dwellings awaiting occupation.

The detailed information in this Part relates to private houses occupied at the date of the Census. However, the number of private dwellings (other than private houses) and the number of dwellings other than private is given in Table 10. The number of unoccupied dwellings is shown in Table 9.

10. <u>Summary of Population and Dwellings</u>. - The following table is a summary of the population and dwellings (as defined above) in the Territory of Norfolk Island at the Censuses of 1954 and 1961.

11. Occupied Dwellings according to Class of Dwelling. - The following table shows the number of occupied dwellings according to class of dwelling at the Censuses of 1954 and 1961. The only private dwellings at 30th June, 1961 other than private houses were five flats. The number of occupied private houses decreased by 7.8 per cent. between Censuses.

12. Occupied Private Houses according to Material of Outer Walls. - Wood was used as the material for outer walls in 79.4 per cent. of all the occupied private houses on Norfolk Island at 30th June, 1961. compared with 81.0 per cent. in 1954. Fibro-cement, the only other material of significance, was used in 15.1 per cent. of private houses in 1961 compared with 14.2 per cent. in 1954.

13. Occupied Private Houses according to Number of Rooms per Private House. - At 30th June, 1961, 68.0 per cent. of all occupied private houses had 2-6 rooms compared with 69.2 per cent. in 1954. There was no significant change in the average number of rooms per private house (5.59 in 1961 compared with 5.57 in 1954).

14. Occupied Private Houses according to Number of Inmates per Private House. -Noticeable features of this table are the increase between Censuses of 30.6 per cent. in private houses with one inmate and the decreases of 31.0 per cent. and 26.7 per cent. respectively in those with four and two inmates.

The average number of inmates per private house decreased from 2.83 in 1954 to 2.72 at 30th June, 1961.


