INTRODUCTION.

This Bulletin contains an analysis, in summary form, of the population and dwellings of the Territory of Cocos (Keeling) Islands as enumerated at the Census of 30th June, 1961; the first Census of Population and Housing since the islands were transferred to Australian administration on 23rd November, 1955. It is one of a series of Census Bulletins for the States and Territories and for Australia as a whole being issued as information becomes available from the first phase of machine tabulation. The information herein may be subject to minor amendment on completion of later tabulations. A list of 1961 Census publications already issued appears at the end of this Bulletin.

In this Bulletin the population is classified according to age, conjugal condition, birthplace, period of residence on Cocos (Keeling) Islands of persons born outside Cocos (Keeling) Islands, nationality, religion, race, industry and occupational status. Dwellings are classified according to class, (i.e., private house, flat, etc.) and private houses according to number of rooms, number of inmates, material of outer walls, nature of occupancy, date of building, rent and facilities.

Each major table herein shows the numbers of males, females and persons or of dwellings according to one particular characteristic (e.g., age or conjugal condition of persons or number of rooms or inmates of dwellings). At a later stage the data in this Bulletin will be published in amplified form in the Detailed Tables of the Census and detailed analyses showing particulars of both population and dwellings in a series of cross tabulations (e.g. the numbers of males and females in the various industries according to their age groups and the numbers of dwellings according to both numbers of rooms and inmates, etc.) will be available in the Census Division of the Bureau.

PART A. - POPULATION OF THE TERRITORY OF COCOS (KEELING) ISLANDS CENSUS, 30TH JUNE, 1961.

1. Age. - The following table shows the numbers of each sex in each five-year age group at the 1961 Census.

More than one-half of the population was aged less than 20 years and in this group females were more numerous than males. From age 20 years to age 59 years there was a considerable excess of males.

2. <u>Conjugal Condition</u>. - The following table shows the population of the Cocos (Keeling) Islands classified according to sex and conjugal condition.

At the 30th June, 1961, 60.6 per cent. of the population were never married; 34.5 per cent. married; 0.2 per cent. married but permanently separated; 2.8 per cent. widowed and 2.0 per cent. divorced. The ratio of males to females in the never married group "15 years of age and over" was 2.53: 1.

3. Birthplace. - The following table shows the birthplaces of the population of the Cocos (Keeling) Islands at the 1961 Census.

At the 30th June, 1961, 70.3 per cent. of the total population were born in the Cocos (Keeling) Islands.

Of those born outside the Cocos (Keeling) Islands Australian-born persons were most numerous with 19.1 per cent. of the total population. Persons born in England accounted for a further 5.9 per cent.

4. Period of Residence. - The period of residence in the Cocos (Keeling) Islands, at 30th June, 1961, of persons born outside the Islands is shown in the following table.

Of those persons born outside the Cocos (Keeling) Islands who stated their period of residence 85.0 per cent. had, at 30th June, 1961, resided in the Islands less than 3 years.

At 30th June, 1961, 99.0 per cent. of the total population and 96.7 per cent. of the oversea-born population were British subjects.

6. Religion. - The following table shows the religions of those persons who answered this question (which is not obligatory), at the 1961 Census. There were 35 persons or 5.8 per cent. of the population who declined to answer the question.

Of the 571 who answered, 73.2 per cent. were Non-Christian and 26.1 per cent. Christian. Of the Christian religions Church of England had most adherents with 77 followed by the Roman Catholic Church with 33, consisting of 22 who described themselves as "Roman Catholic" and 11 as "Catholic". It is presumed that most of the latter were adherents of the Roman Catholic Church.

No details of Non-Christian religions are available.

7. Industry. - The following table shows the main groups of industry for persons in the Cocos (Keeling) Islands at 30th June, 1961.

Primary Production accounted for 59.2 per cent. of the total work force at 30th June, 1961. Transport and Storage and Communication absorbed a further 27.3 per cent. Females in the work force were principally in Primary Production (88.5 per cent.).

8. Occupational Status. - The following table gives details of the population's occupational status at 30th June, 1961.

At the 1961 Census all persons but one in the work force gave their status as employee. Of the total population 53.5 per cent. were dependent population (i.e. persons not in the work force).

^{9.} Race. - At 30th June, 1961, 180 persons (125 males and 55 females) or 29.7 per cent. of the total population of the Cocos (Keeling) Islands were of European race; 422 persons (205 males and 217 females) or 69.6 per cent. were of Malay race; and 4 persons (3 males and 1 female) were of other races.

PART B. - DWELLINGS IN THE TERRITORY OF COCOS (KEELING) ISLANDS. CENSUS, 30TH JUNE, 1961.

10. <u>Definitions</u> and <u>Scope</u>. For the purpose of the Census a dwelling is any habitation occupied by a household group living together as a domestic unit, whether comprising the whole or only a part of a building.

Occupied Dwellings are classified into "private" and "other than private" dwellings.

Private Dwellings in the Cocos (Keeling) Islands comprise only private houses.

Dwellings Other than Private include the hospital and staff quarters.

Unoccupied Dwellings include dwellings temporarily unoccupied on the night of the Census and newly completed dwellings awaiting occupation.

The detailed information in this Part relates to private houses occupied at the date of the Census. However, the number of dwellings other than private is given in Table 10. The number of unoccupied dwellings is shown in Table 9.

11. Summary of Population and Dwellings. - The following table is a summary of the population and dwellings (as defined above) in the Territory of Cocos (Keeling) Islands at 30th June, 1961.

13. Occupied Private Houses according to Material of Outer Walls. - At the 1961 Census, 51.7 per cent. of the private houses had outer walls of wood, 32.2 per cent. walls of concrete and 13.8 per cent. walls of fibro-cement.

14. Occupied Private Houses according to Number of Rooms per Private House. - At the 1961 Census 65.5 per cent. of all occupied private houses had 4 rooms and 29.9 per cent. had 5 rooms. The average number of rooms per private house was 4.53.

17. Occupied Private Houses according to Date of Building. - Of the 86 occupied private houses for which a date of building was supplied 48 or 55.8 per cent. were built before 1st July, 1954.

18. Occupied Private Houses according to Facilities. - The question on facilities - gas and electricity - was answered for the 87 occupied private houses on Cocos (Keeling) Islands. Of these, 81 had electricity only, and 6 had both gas and electricity.
