P R E F A C E

This publication contains particulars of the characteristics of dwellings and of householders in the Northern Territory recorded at the 1961 Census.

The distribution of dwellings is shown by districts and by Urban and Rural Divisions of the Territory. Dwellings are classified by a number of characteristics (i.e. Class of Dwelling, Material of Outer Walls, Number of Rooms, Number of Inmates, Date of Building, Weekly Rent (unfurnished), and Facilities) which are shown for the Territory as a whole and for Urban and Rural Divisions. Comparisons are also made with the 1954 Census. Certain of these dwellings characteristics are also shown in cross-classification with each other.

For private dwellings, the nature of the householder's occupancy of the dwelling is shown in conjunction with certain characteristics of the dwelling (Class of Dwelling, Number of Rooms, Date of Building) and also in conjunction with other characteristics of the householder (Sex, Age, Conjugal Condition, Occupational Status, Industry and Period of Residence in Australia for Householders born outside Australia).

This is one of five Parts which will constitute the complete Census Volume for the Territories, viz. Part I.—Northern Territory: Population; Part II.—Northern Territory: Dwellings and Householders; Part III.—Australian Capital Territory: Population; Part IV.—Australian Capital Territory: Dwellings and Householders; Part V.—External Territories: Population and Dwellings. A similar Volume is being prepared for each State and for Australia as a whole. A list of printed and mimeographed 1961 Census publications already issued is shown inside the back cover of this Part.

Explanatory notes relative to the contents of this Part follow the Table of Contents.

Owing to limitation of space a number of the cross-classified tabulations of characteristics of dwellings and householders have been published only for Northern Territory as a whole. However, these cross-classifications are available separately for the Other Urban and Rural Divisions on application to the Commonwealth Statistician.

EXPLANATORY NOTES

Urban and Rural Divisions (Divisions of State).—Because of the smallness of the population, the designation “Metropolitan Urban” has not been applied to any area in the Northern Territory at any Census to date. The “Divisions of State” for the Northern Territory—Other Urban (term retained for uniformity with State Census Volumes), Rural and Migratory—as defined for Census purposes and as referred to throughout this Part, are constituted as follows—

Other Urban. Refers to the City of Darwin and Alice Springs Town. Comparison cannot be made between 1954 and 1961 data for Darwin because of different boundaries used at each of these Censuses. The 1961 data relate to the City of Darwin (boundaries proclaimed 28th June, 1957—area 19 square miles). The 1954 data relate to an area at that time known as Proposed Greater Darwin (area 90 square miles). For Alice Springs town the area may be regarded as having been unaltered between the 1954 and 1961 Censuses.

Rural. Comprises the remainder of the Territory and any comparison between 1954 and 1961 is affected by the changed boundaries of Darwin referred to above.

Migratory. Refers to persons not elsewhere enumerated who at midnight between 29th and 30th June, 1961, were on ships in Northern Territory waters, or were travelling on long-distance trains, motor coaches or aircraft. Particulars for this division, which refer to population only, are shown in Table No. 2 of this Part.

Variation in the boundaries of the City of Darwin must be borne in mind when making comparisons between Censuses for urban and rural population.

DEFINITIONS

Occupied Dwelling. An occupied dwelling is any habitation occupied by a household group living together as a domestic unit, whether comprising the whole or only part of a building. The term has therefore a very wide reference and includes, in addition to houses and flats, a great variety of “dwellings” ranging from a single-roomed shack to a multi-roomed hotel or institution. Occupied dwellings are classified into “private” and “other than private” dwellings.

Private Dwelling. Private dwellings are further classified into the following four categories.

Private House. Private Houses include houses, sheds, huts, garages, etc., used for dwelling purposes, and shared private houses for which only one Householder’s Schedule was received.

Share of Private House. A Share of a Private House is a portion of a shared private house which is occupied separately and for which portion a separate Householder’s Schedule was received.

Flat. A Flat is part of a house or other building which can be completely closed off and which has its own cooking and bathing facilities.

Other Private Dwelling. These include private dwellings such as rooms, apartments, etc., which are parts of buildings but are not self-contained units.

Other than Private Dwelling. These include Hotels; Motels; Boarding Houses, Lodging Houses and Hostels; Educational, Religious and Charitable Institutions; Hospitals; Defence and Penal Establishments; Police and Fire Stations; Clubs; Staff Barracks and Quarters, etc.

Unoccupied Dwelling. These include vacant dwellings available for sale or renting; dwellings such as “week-ender”, “holiday home”, “second home”, “seasonal workers’ quarters”, which were not occupied on the night of the Census; dwellings normally occupied but whose usual occupants were temporarily absent on the night of the Census; newly completed dwellings whose owners or tenants had not entered into occupation on the night of the Census; dwellings described as “to be demolished”, “condemned”, “deceased estate”, “exhibition home”, etc.; and buildings constructed as dwellings but used for non-dwelling purposes on the night of the Census. The total number of unoccupied dwellings shown for any area must not, therefore, be read as representing the number of vacant houses and flats available for sale or renting.

Campers-out. Refers to those people, (other than “Migratory” (*see above*)), who were not enumerated in a dwelling. Included are such people as those camped beside their vehicle by the roadside, drovers and other itinerants.

Rooms. These include kitchen and permanently enclosed sleep-out, but do not include bathroom, pantry, laundry or storehouse. Rooms in non-attached buildings are included only if used for living or sleeping purposes by the household group. Rooms recorded for a “share of private house” include only those used by the occupier of the share. A shared kitchen or living room is recorded only for the share occupied by the owner or principal tenant.

Rent. The data relating to rents are only for dwellings rented unfurnished. The figures representing “rent not stated” include rent-free dwellings, those rented on a furnished basis and those for which the rents were not applicable (e.g., for shop and dwelling combined).

Particulars of full-blood aboriginals and dwellings occupied solely by them are excluded throughout.
