

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1.0 Introduction

The Households Sample File (HSF) contains census information for a one per cent sample of households in occupied private dwellings and all persons counted within each selected household and a one per cent sample of persons in non-private dwellings, on census night, 30 June 1981.

The release of this sample file is made possible by changes to the *Census and Statistics Act 1905* which allow for the release of data in the form of unit records where the information is not likely to enable the identification of a particular person or organisation. There are no names or addresses on any census files held by the Australian Bureau of Statistics (ABS) and for the sample files the ABS have suppressed or reduced the detail for some items of data to ensure that the confidentiality of individuals is protected.

This file is released only under certain conditions of issue which are specified in Section 2.6 of *Census 81—Sample Files on Magnetic Tape* (2165.0). It is important that all users, whether making use of the file shortly after receipt, or in subsequent months or years, be fully aware of the information contained in *Census 81—Sample Files on Magnetic Tape* (2165.0) on the permitted uses of the contents of the file and the penalties for its misuse.

Since the contents of the HSF are in coded form, another magnetic tape file—the *Descriptor File for Households Sample*—has been prepared to simplify the production of tabular output from the HSF; it contains descriptions for codes on the HSF in the format required in Table Producing Language (TPL), the tabulation software used by the ABS. These descriptions are also contained in Appendix A. For users who have access to TPL, descriptors for the file can be input directly to their computer system. If other software packages are used, some text editing and reformatting may be necessary.

According to an agreement between the United States Bureau of Labour Statistics (who wrote TPL) and the ABS, the ABS can supply some organisations with the package free of charge.

2.0 Features of the Households Sample File

The HSF

- (a) contains a record of census information for each person in the one per cent sample of unidentified households in private dwellings and all persons within them, plus a one per cent sample of unidentified persons in non-private dwellings;
- (b) is further divided into 20 subsamples (ten subsamples containing persons in private dwellings, the other ten containing persons in non-private dwellings, each subsample representing 0.1 per cent of the population) and the file is sorted into order of subsample number;
- (c) has all geographic references removed, other than a code showing major urban/other urban/rural, to ensure that the confidentiality of households and individuals is protected;
- (d) contains data on all persons in the selected households, and therefore allows a user to produce tabulations on characteristics of households, dwellings, families and persons, and to study how characteristics of household or family members are interrelated.

3.0 File structure

The HSF is distributed as a single reel of magnetic tape containing one data file. Section 4.0 describes the information available.

Records on the HSF are 96 characters long. Block size is 2,016 characters, thus there are 21 records per block. The last block on the file may be short.

4.0 Record structure

The records on the file are sorted into 10 groups, by subsample number. Each group is further sorted into private and non-private dwellings. All fields in the record are numeric. Appendix A contains a detailed list of all the characteristics and their classifications as they are held on this file.

5.0 Using the data

Any counts derived from this file should be multiplied by 100 to obtain estimates of the total number of persons or households in the population with the same characteristics. All estimates so obtained are subject to sampling error and the sampling error on small cells can be very high. More details are contained in Appendix A of *Census 81—Sample Files on Magnetic Tape* (2165.0).

To assist in the validation of estimates produced from the sample file, some basic estimates obtained by the ABS from the file are:

To assist further in validation, seven pages of 34 census tables containing statistics for total Australia are contained in Appendix B. These tables were produced from the census unit record file, not from the sample file, and therefore do not contain any sampling error.

Users should note that monthly mortgage payments (ALM) is relevant only for dwellings with a Nature of occupancy (NOC) value of 2, and Weekly rental payment (RNT) is relevant only for dwellings with an NOC value in the range 4 to 15.
