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INTRODUCTION.

The particulars given in the following tables relate to the quarter ended 31st December, 1910, with the exception of Tables No. 1 and 2, containing Summaries of Births; No. 6, Summary of Marriages; Nos. 12 and 13, Summaries of Deaths; and No. 17, Causes of Death, in which it has been thought advisable to shew particulars for each month.

Particulars relating to the Northern Territory are included in the South Australian figures. Marine Births and Deaths are not included.
