**ESTIMATED RESIDENT POPULATION AND AREA, QUEENSLAND, 1994, PRELIMINARY**

**MAIN FEATURES**

- QUEENSLAND**
- The estimated resident population of Queensland increased by 2.6 per cent during 1993-94 to 3,196,934 persons. The total increase of 80,916 persons in 1993-94, although slightly lower than the 1992-93 increase (83,184), was the third largest on record.
- STATISTICAL DIVISIONS**
- Brisbane Statistical Division recorded the largest absolute increase (33,212 persons or 2.3 per cent) although Moreton experienced the highest growth rate (25,127 persons or 4.7 per cent). Other statistical divisions to grow by more than 3,000 persons were Wide Bay-Burnett (6,879), Far North (5,325), Fitzroy (3,433) and Northern (3,314).
- STATISTICAL DISTRICTS**
- Gold Coast-Tweed Statistical District experienced the largest total increase (13,880 persons or 4.6 per cent) while the highest relative growth occurred in Sunshine Coast (7,796 persons or 5.8 per cent). Elsewhere in Queensland, increases of more than 2,000 persons occurred in the statistical districts of Cairns (3,972) and Townsville (2,928).
- LOCAL GOVERNMENT AREAS**
- Albert Shire had the largest increase of any local government area with a rise of 10,128 persons or 6.3 per cent. In south-east Queensland, other local government areas to grow by more than 3,000 persons were the Cities of Brisbane (9,512), Logan (4,353) and Gold Coast (3,982), and the Shires of Caboolture (6,739), Maroochy (5,237), Redland (3,804) and Pine Rivers (3,063). Elsewhere in Queensland, Mulgrave Shire (3,360) and the Cities of Hervey Bay (2,742) and Thuringowa (2,448) all had increases in excess of 2,000 persons.

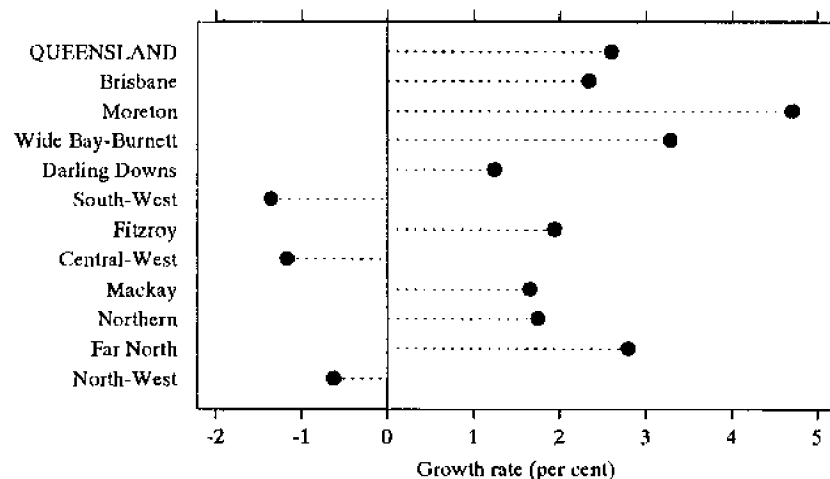
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**GROWTH RATE BY STATISTICAL DIVISION,  
QUEENSLAND, 1993-94**

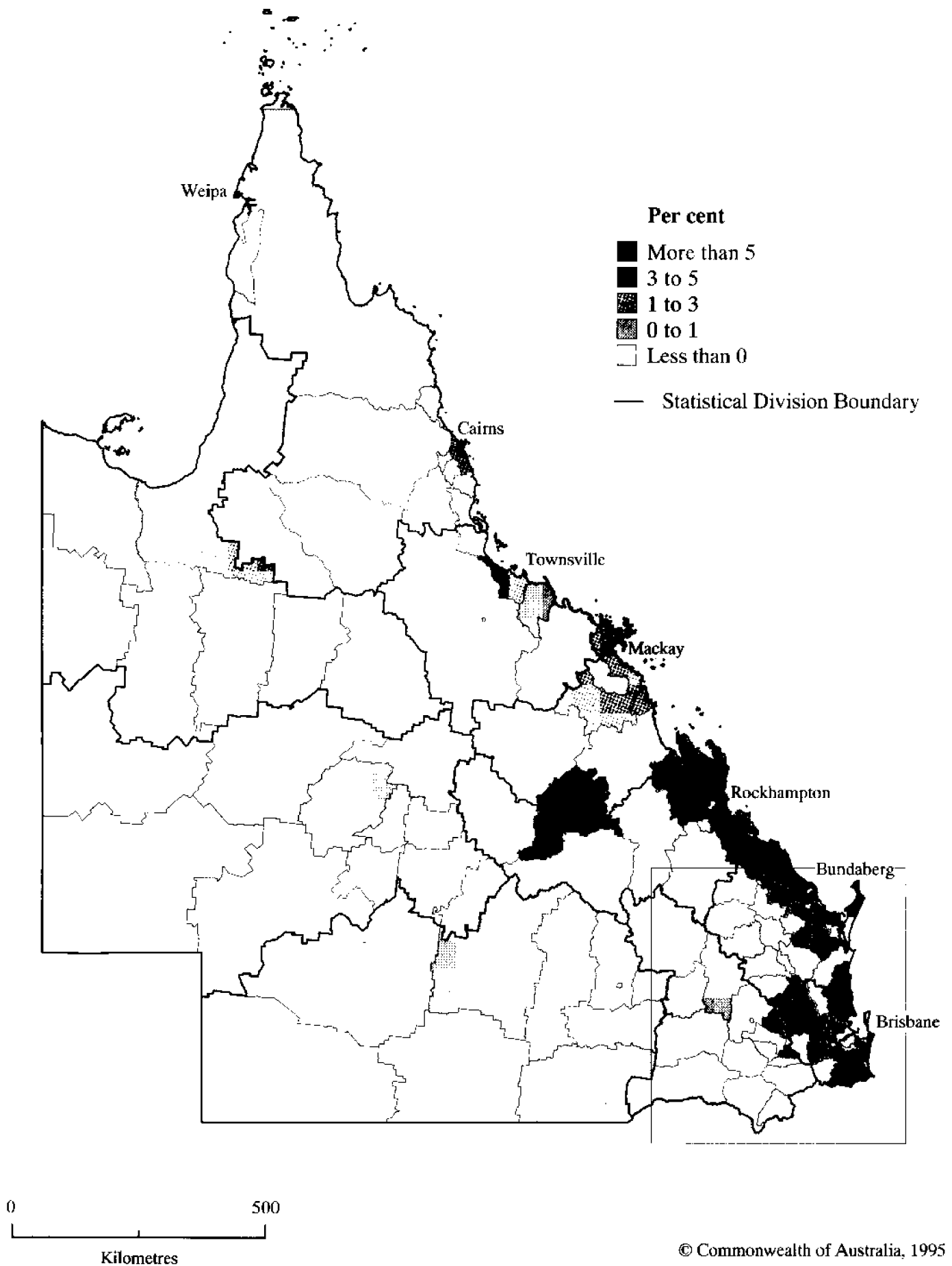

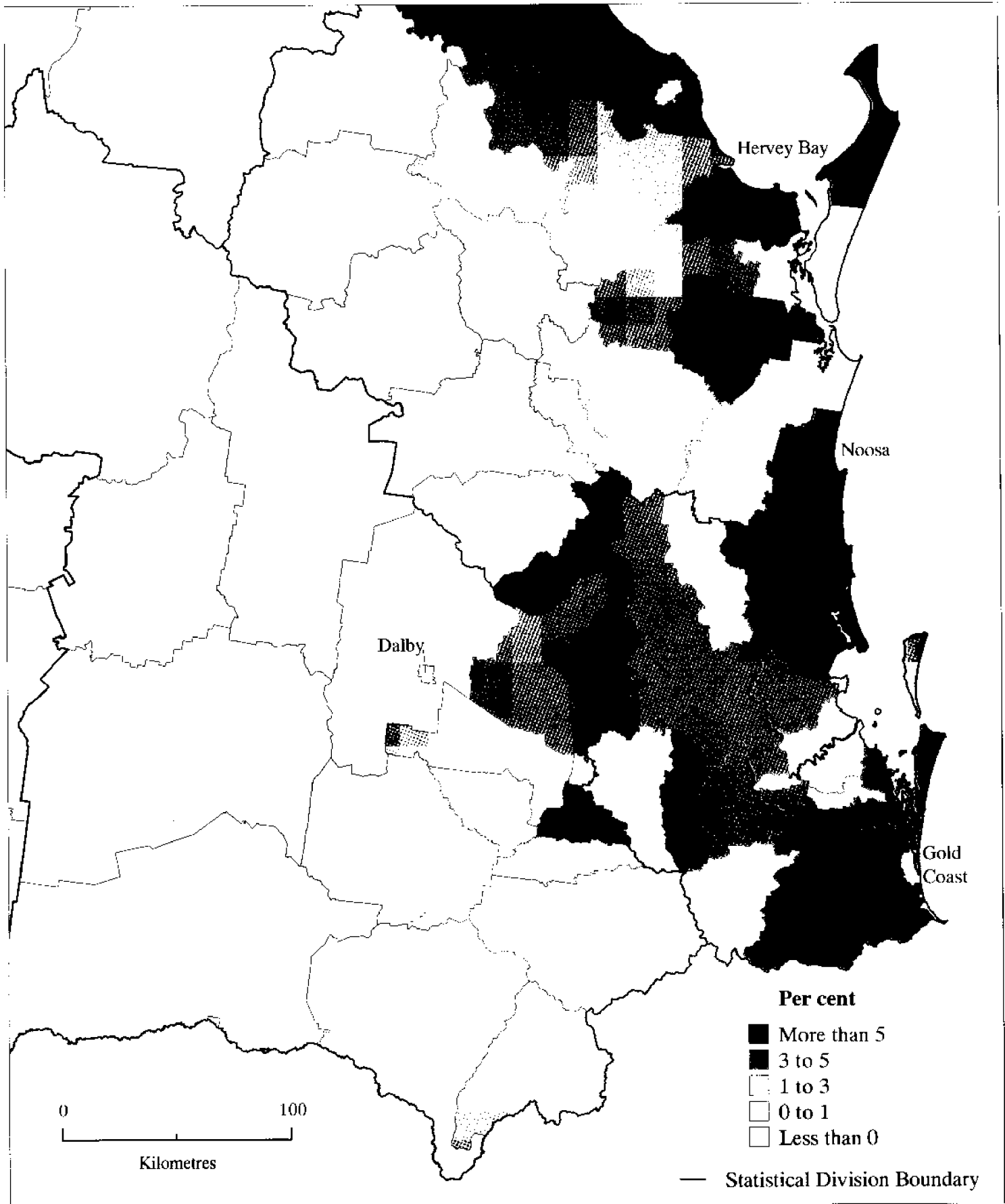

## EXPLANATORY NOTES

- Introduction**
1. This publication contains the estimated resident population (ERP) and area for each statistical local area (SLA), statistical district, statistical subdivision and statistical division in Queensland at 30 June 1989, 1993 and 1994.
- Methodology**
2. The ERP at 30 June 1991 for each SLA was calculated by adjusting usual residence census counts for under-enumeration and adding the number of residents temporarily overseas at the census date. Persons who did not state their usual residence on the census form were proportionately allocated to all the SLAs in the State.
  3. As the 1991 Census was held on 6 August, a further adjustment was made to obtain the ERP at 30 June 1991. This involved subtracting the increase in population of each SLA, due to the natural increase and net migration between 1 July and 6 August, from the 6 August 1991 population estimate.
  4. For intercensal years, the ERP for each SLA is calculated using a linear regression model. The model establishes a mathematical relationship between changes in population and other variables over the period between the two most recent censuses for which the required data are available, i.e. 1986 to 1991. The main variables used include building commencements, estimates of persons in dwellings (adjusted for changes in occupancy rates), electoral enrolments and medicare registrations.
  5. Other indicators of resident population movement used to supplement the estimates from the regression model include information from councils about mining and other development projects in their area. Further information about the method of calculation of estimates in this publication is available on request.
- ASGC**
6. The data in this publication are presented according to *Australian Standard Geographic Classification (ASGC)*, Edition 2.4. Readers are encouraged to familiarise themselves with this publication for a full description of the boundary changes.
- Boundary changes**
7. The SLA boundaries which existed at 30 June 1994 are used in Tables 1-3. Population estimates for previous years have been adjusted to reflect the June 1994 boundaries. Table 4 provides estimates on 1993 boundaries for selected areas involved in boundary changes during the year ended 30 June 1994. A list of statistical area changes which occurred between 1 July 1991 and 30 June 1994 is shown in Table 5.
- Definitions**
8. *Legal local government areas (LGAs)*, as defined under the *Local Government Act 1936*, are spatial units which represent the geographical areas of incorporated local government councils, such as cities (C), towns (T) and shires (S).
  9. *Statistical local areas* are the smallest spatial units for which the estimates of resident population are presented. They correspond either to LGAs, or to suburbs in certain LGAs. Some LGAs are split into two parts, with each part forming a separate SLA. The unincorporated area of Queensland also forms a SLA. In aggregate, SLAs cover the whole of the State without gaps or overlaps.
  10. *Statistical subdivisions* consist of one or more SLAs.
  11. *Statistical divisions*, which are groupings of SLAs, are designed to be relatively homogeneous regions characterised by identifiable social and economic units within the region. The Brisbane Statistical Division comprises the Cities of Brisbane, Ipswich, Logan and Redcliffe, the Shires of Pine Rivers and Redland and parts of the Shires of Albert, Beaudesert, Caboolture and Moreton.
  12. *Statistical districts* have been defined around selected urban areas to provide comparable statistics over a period of time. These districts, which are intended to contain the anticipated urban spread for at least 20 years, are generally defined as having a population of 25,000 or more and experiencing urban growth beyond the LGA boundaries.
  13. Area estimates are based on digitised boundaries of statistical areas.

- Reliability** 14. Although estimates of the resident population are shown to the nearest unit, accuracy to this level is not claimed and should not be assumed.
