

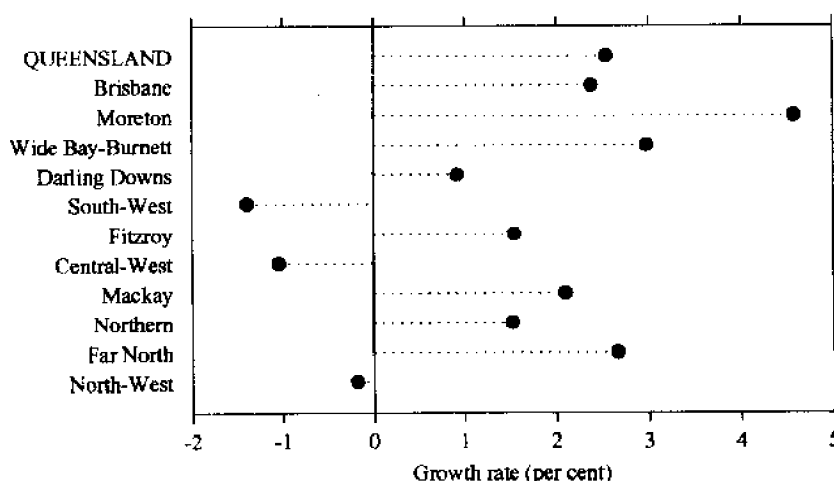
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ESTIMATED RESIDENT POPULATION AND AREA, QUEENSLAND, 1995, PRELIMINARY

MAIN FEATURES

- QUEENSLAND**
- The estimated resident population of Queensland increased by 2.5% during 1994–95 to 3,277,373 persons. The total increase of 81,239 persons in 1994–95 was the third largest on record exceeded only by 1988–89 (87,730) and 1992–93 (83,184).
- STATISTICAL DIVISIONS**
- The Brisbane and Moreton Statistical Divisions experienced strong population growth. Together, they accounted for 74.1% of the total population increase, whereas their share of the overall State population was 63.3%. By contrast, the three outback statistical divisions of South-West, Central-West and North-West, which account for 58.1% of the State's total area, continued their long term depopulation trends. Every shire in these three Divisions contained fewer persons in 1995 than in 1990, with the exceptions of Burke, Carpentaria and Longreach.
- TOP 10 GROWTH AREAS**
- In terms of percentage change, the top 10 growth statistical local areas (SLAs) are all located in the cities of Brisbane and Gold Coast. As would be expected, these areas are all newer suburbs. In terms of absolute increase, three regional SLAs appear in the top 10, namely Cairns City Part A, Hervey Bay and Mackay City Part A.
- LOCAL GOVERNMENT AREA AMALGAMATIONS**
- For Local Government Areas (LGAs), the largest increases occurred in Brisbane (13,531 persons) and the new supercity of Gold Coast (13,231 persons). Tables 1 to 3 in this publication reflect the most recent LGA amalgamations of Albert with Gold Coast, Mulgrave with Cairns, and Moreton with Ipswich. Table 5 provides a comprehensive listing of statistical area changes from 1991 to 1995.

EXPLANATORY NOTES

Introduction

1. This publication contains the estimated resident population (ERP) and area for each statistical local area (SLA), statistical district, statistical subdivision and statistical division in Queensland at 30 June 1990, 1994 and 1995.

Methodology

2. The ERP at 30 June 1991 for each SLA was calculated by adjusting usual residence census counts for under-enumeration and adding the number of residents temporarily overseas at the census date. Persons who did not state their usual residence on the census form were proportionately allocated to all the SLAs in the State.

3. As the 1991 Census was held on 6 August, a further adjustment was made to obtain the ERP at 30 June 1991. This involved subtracting the increase in population of each SLA, due to the natural increase and net migration between 1 July and 6 August, from the 6 August 1991 population estimate.

4. For intercensal years, the ERP for each SLA is calculated using a linear regression model. The model establishes a mathematical relationship between changes in population and other variables over the period between the two most recent censuses for which the required data are available, i.e. 1986 to 1991. The main variables used include building commencements, estimates of persons in dwellings (adjusted for changes in occupancy rates), electoral enrolments and medicare registrations.

5. Other indicators of resident population movement used to supplement the estimates from the regression model include information from councils about mining and other development projects in their area. Further information about the method of calculation of estimates in this publication is available on request.

ASGC

6. The data in this publication are presented according to *Australian Standard Geographic Classification (ASGC)*, Edition 2.5. Readers are encouraged to familiarise themselves with this publication for a full description of the boundary changes.

Boundary changes

7. The SLA boundaries which existed at 30 June 1995 are used in Tables 1 to 3. Population estimates for previous years have been adjusted to reflect the June 1995 boundaries. Table 4 provides estimates on 1994 boundaries for selected areas involved in boundary changes during the year ended 30 June 1994. A list of statistical area changes which occurred between 1 July 1991 and 30 June 1995 is shown in Table 5.

Definitions

8. *Legal local government areas (LGAs)*, as defined under the *Local Government Act 1993*, are spatial units which represent the geographical areas of incorporated local government councils, such as cities (C), towns (T) and shires (S).

9. *Statistical local areas* are the smallest spatial units for which the estimates of resident population are presented. They correspond either to LGAs, or to suburbs in certain LGAs. Some LGAs are split into two parts, with each part forming a separate SLA. The unincorporated area of Queensland also forms a SLA. In aggregate, SLAs cover the whole of the State without gaps or overlaps.

10. *Statistical subdivisions* consist of one or more SLAs.

11. *Statistical divisions*, which are groupings of SLAs, are designed to be relatively homogeneous regions characterised by identifiable social and economic units within the region. The Brisbane Statistical Division comprises the Cities of Brisbane, Ipswich, Logan and Redcliffe, the Shires of Pine Rivers and Redland and parts of the Shires of Albert, Beaudesert, Caboolture and Moreton.

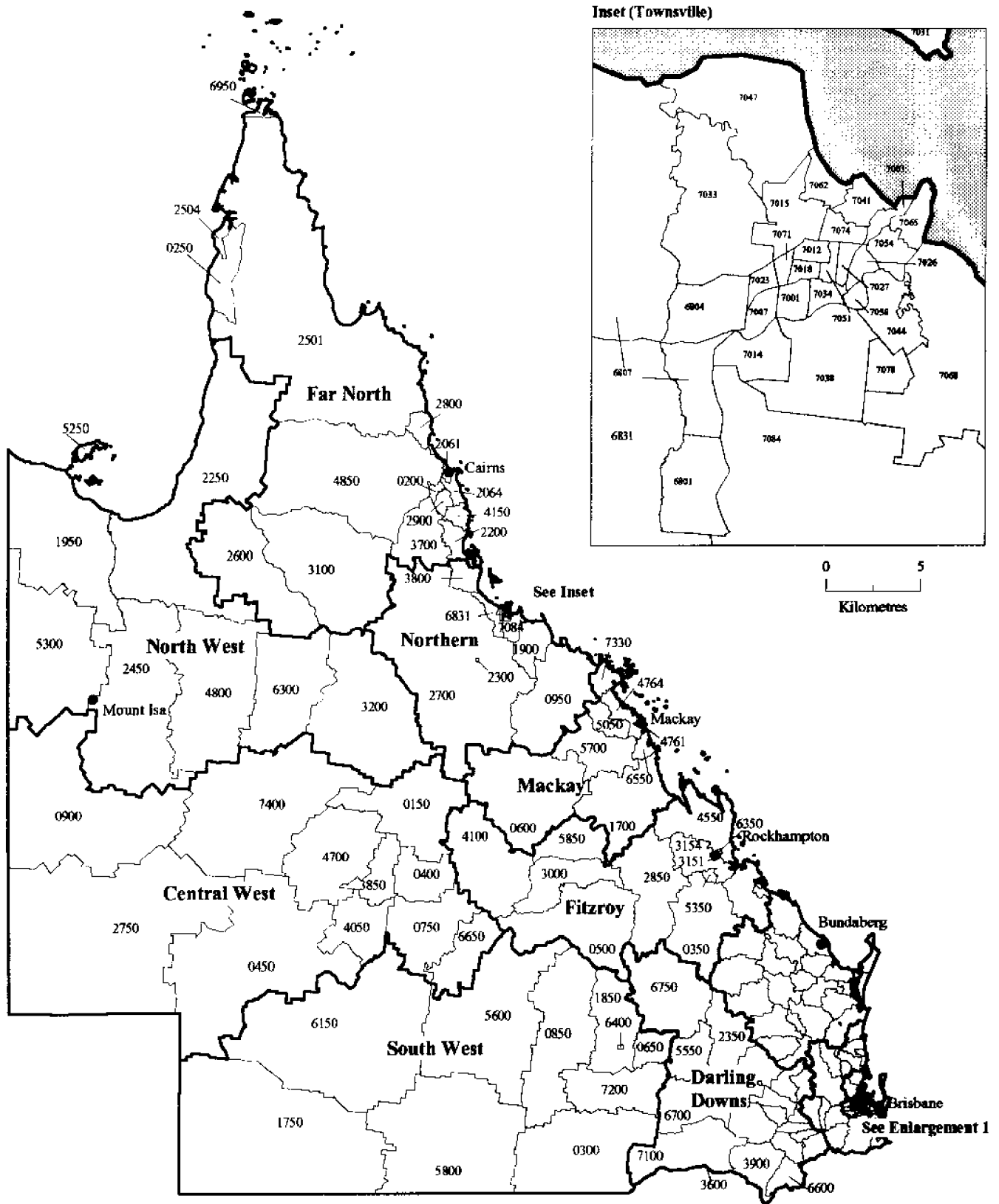
12. *Statistical districts* have been defined around selected urban areas to provide comparable statistics over a period of time. These districts, which are intended to contain the anticipated urban spread for at least 20 years, are generally defined as having a population of 25,000 or more and experiencing urban growth beyond the LGA boundaries.

13. Area estimates are based on digitised boundaries of statistical areas.

Statistical Divisions and Statistical Local Areas, 1 July 1995



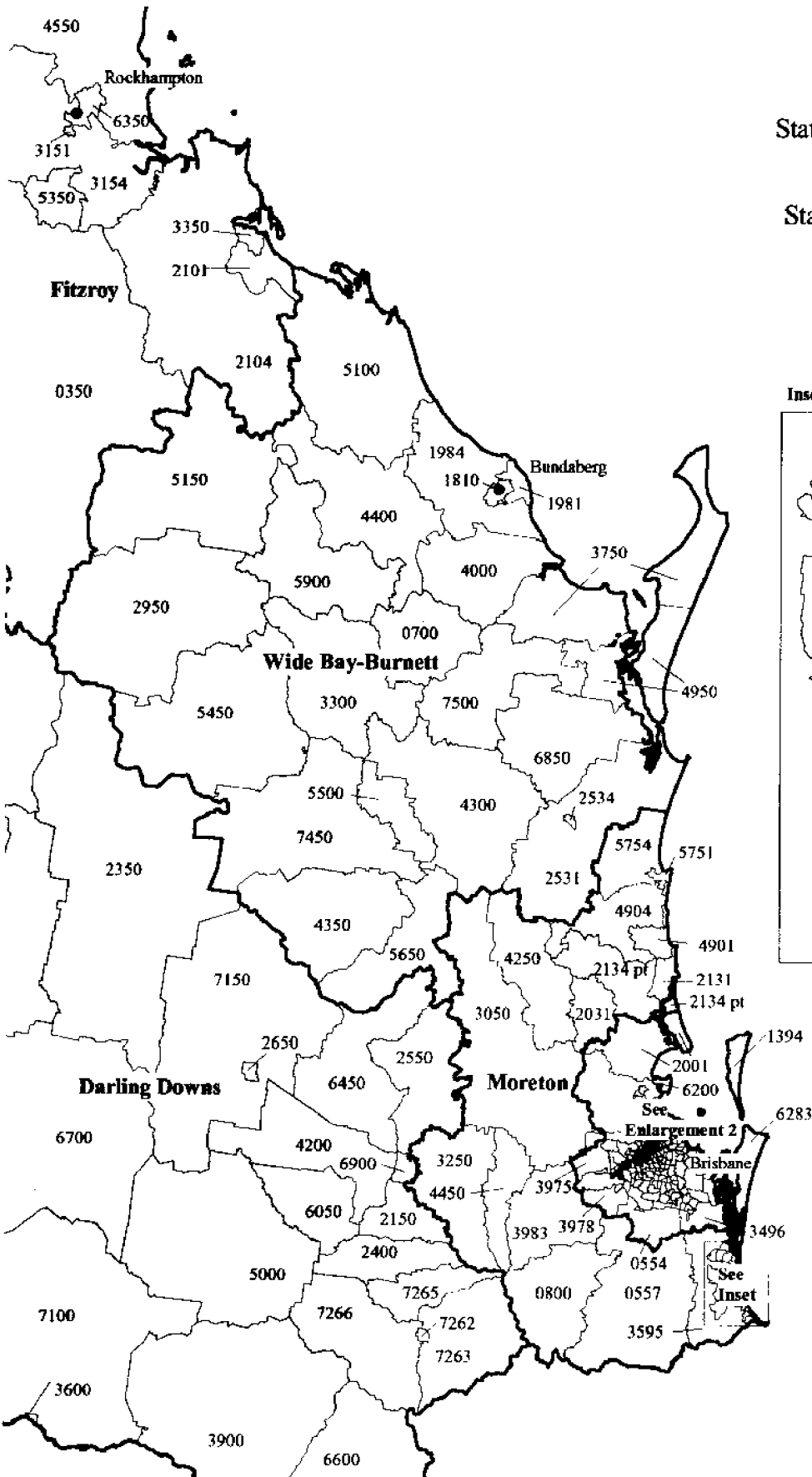

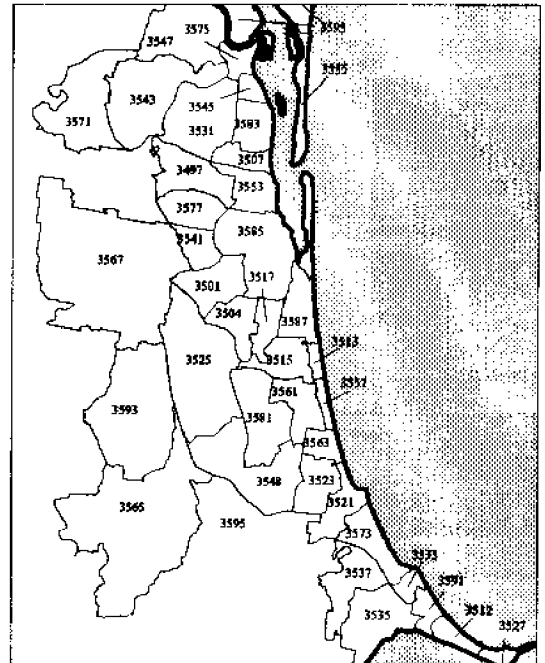

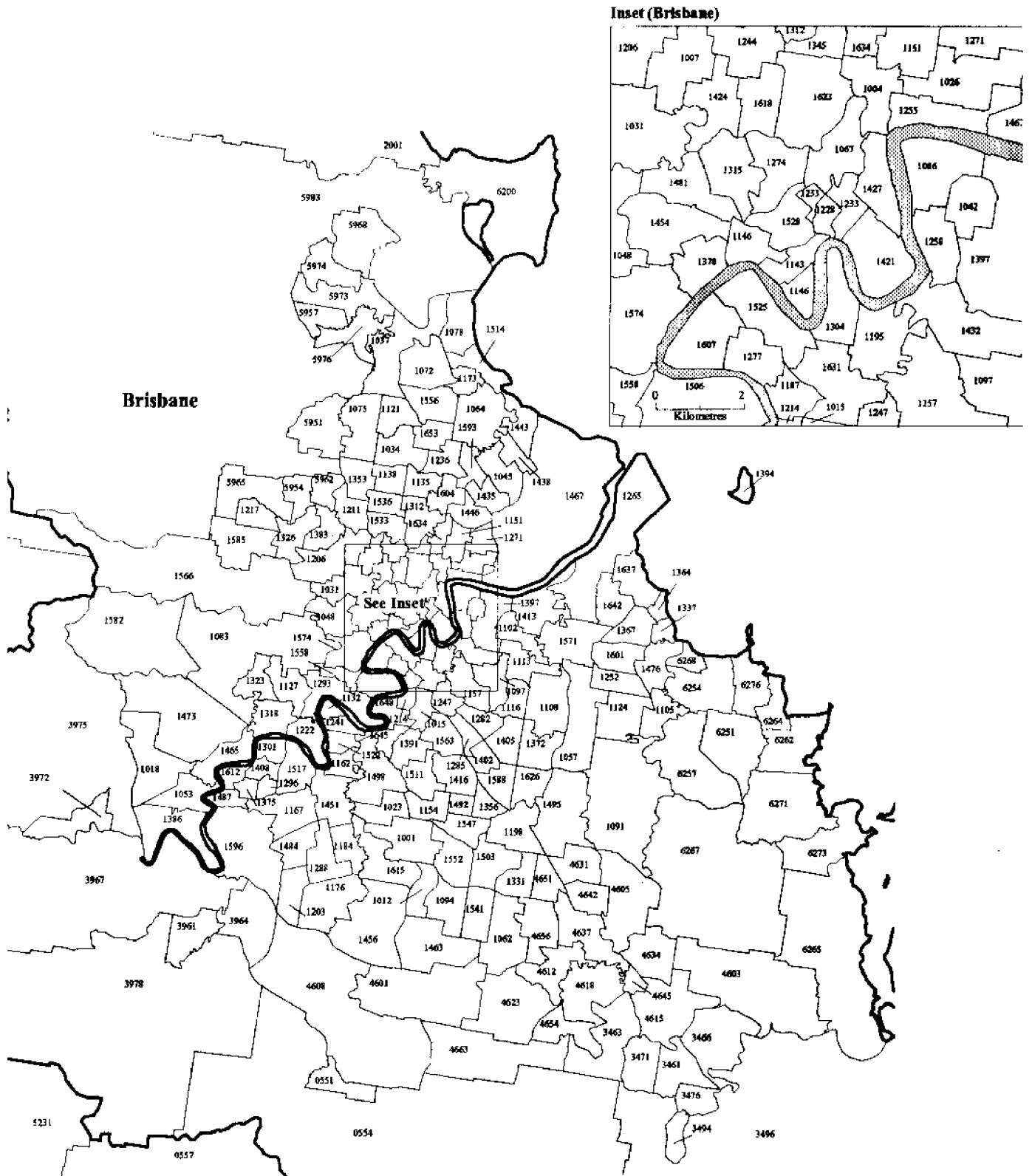
