

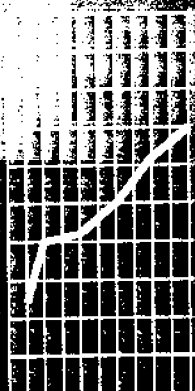

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METHODOLOGY

The estimates in this publication are based on the results of the 1991 Population Census. Mathematical statistical techniques are used to produce the Statistical Local Area population estimates during the intercensal period and they are revised each time a population census is taken. 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MAIN FEATURES

SOUTH AUSTRALIA

South Australia's estimated resident population at 30 June 1995 was 1,473,966, an increase of 4,595 persons (0.3%) over the 1994 figure.

STATISTICAL DIVISIONS

Adelaide	The estimated resident population of the Adelaide Statistical Division (SD) increased by 4,842 persons (0.4%). Significant population growth in the Adelaide SD has traditionally been confined to the Northern and Southern Statistical Subdivisions (SSDs). However, in recent years the growth has dropped off markedly in the Southern SSD whilst being maintained in the Northern SSD. The growth for 1994-95 in Northern SSD was 3,696 persons (1.1%) and in Southern SSD it was 857 persons (0.3%). In 1991-92 the respective figures were 4,557 persons (1.4%) for Northern SSD and 5,280 persons (1.7%) for Southern SSD. In the Northern SSD the trend has been maintained in the Statistical Local Areas (SLAs) of Tea Tree Gully (C) and Munno Para (C) with increases during 1994-95 of 1,744 persons (1.8%) and 1,092 persons (3.0%) respectively. Also, Enfield (C) - Pt A has experienced a population turnaround with an increase of 167 persons (0.4%).
Outer Adelaide	Outer Adelaide SD continued to experience population growth with an annual increase of 2,433 persons (2.4%). The SLAs of Victor Harbor (DC) and Port Elliot and Goolwa (DC) had the greatest percentage increases of all SLAs in the State, growing by 6.4% (580 persons) and 4.6% (368 persons) respectively. The SLA to show the greatest increase in number in the Outer Adelaide SD was Mount Barker (DC) with an increase of 591 persons (2.8%).
Yorke and Lower North	The Yorke and Lower North SD has experienced a population decline for the first time since the estimated resident population series began in 1976, with an annual decrease of 327 persons (-0.7%). The SLA of Burra Burra (DC) had the greatest population decline of 105 persons (-5.1%). Despite the general decline within the SD, the SLA of Wallaroo (M) increased by 78 persons (3.3%).
Murray Lands	Murray Lands SD continued to decline in population. The 30 June 1995 population of 66,501 persons represents a decline of 942 persons or 1.4% over the four years since 30 June 1991.
South East	After experiencing a population gain of 54 persons (0.1%) in 1993-94 the South East SD reverted back to a declining population, losing 477 persons (-0.8%). The main contributors to the population decline were the SLAs of Millicent (DC) and Naracoorte (M), which experienced a decrease of 125 persons (-1.6%) and 106 persons (-2.2%) respectively. The large urban centre of Mount Gambier (C) recorded a turnaround from an increase of 267 persons (1.2%) in 1993-94 to a decrease of 68 persons (-0.3%) in 1994-95.
Eyre	The decline of 439 persons (-1.3%) for Eyre SD almost doubles the annual population loss at 30 June 1994 (-228 persons or -0.7%). This highlights a departure from the trend of slowed population loss present since 30 June 1991. The annual population change was -143 persons (-0.4%) at 30 June 1992 and -80 persons (-0.2%) at 30 June 1993.
Northern	Northern SD experienced a population decline of 1,026 persons (-1.2%), the largest decline of any Statistical Division in the State. The decline is largely attributable to falling population levels for the SLAs of Whyalla (C) (-414 persons or -1.7%), Port Augusta (C) (-155 persons or -1.1%) and Port Pirie (C) (-136 persons or -0.9%). Despite the continued population decline within the SD, the mining towns of Coober Pedy and Roxby Downs experienced population gains of 55 persons (2.5%) and 79 persons (3.1%) respectively.

CHANGE IN STATISTICAL SUBDIVISION BOUNDARY

The boundary between the Riverland and Murray Mallee Statistical Subdivisions has been adjusted because of the amalgamation of Ridley (DC) and Truro (DC). The new SIA of Ridley-Truro (DC) is in the Murray Mallee Statistical Subdivision. Truro (DC) was formerly in the Riverland Statistical Subdivision.

EXPLANATORY NOTES

INTRODUCTION

1 This publication contains preliminary estimates of the resident population by age and sex in statistical local areas (SLAs) in South Australia at 30 June 1995.

2 The *estimated resident population* (ERP) is the official ABS estimate of the Australian population.

METHODOLOGY

3 The total population of each SLA is based on results of the 1991 population census and calculated for post-census dates by a linear regression model which uses independent indicators of population change such as dwelling commencements, licensed drivers and Medicare enrolments for children aged 15 years and under. These inter-censal estimates of the resident population are revised each time a population census is taken.

4 The age and sex estimates were prepared using the cohort component method. Post-censal age distributions were obtained by advancing the age and sex estimates for 30 June 1994 to the next age, subtracting deaths and adding births and net estimated inter-regional and overseas migration. Inter-regional and overseas migration was estimated from analysis of arrivals and departures data and individual SLA profiles derived from the 1986 Census. More details can be provided by the ABS South Australian Office.

5 After each census final estimates for the preceding inter-censal period are calculated by incorporating an additional adjustment (intercensal discrepancy) to ensure that the total inter-censal increase at each age agrees with the difference between the estimated resident population at the two respective census dates.

GEOGRAPHIC BOUNDARIES

6 The geographic areas used in this publication are defined in the *Australian Standard Geographical Classification, Edition 2.5* (1216.0). The statistical local areas shown in this publication equate directly with local government areas except for Enfield which is split into two SLAs, Part A and Part B.

7 The SLA population estimates in this publication are calculated on SLA boundaries at 30 June 1995.

SMALL SLAs

8 The SLAs of Unincorporated Western and Unincorporated Lincoln have been combined with Port Adelaide (C) and Lower Eyre Peninsula (DC) respectively.

RELIABILITY

9 All SLA estimates are shown to the nearest person, although accuracy to this level is not claimed and should not be assumed.

DATA ON FLOPPY DISK

10 The data in this publication is also available on floppy disk.

POPULATION PROJECTIONS

11 The ABS compiles and publishes population projections for Australia, States and Territories (3222.0).

12 The ABS as part of its Statistical Consultancy Service can prepare ad hoc population projections at the SLA or higher level. The projections are based on the latest ERP by age and sex. Clients can supply their own assumptions or approve the use of ABS formulated assumptions.

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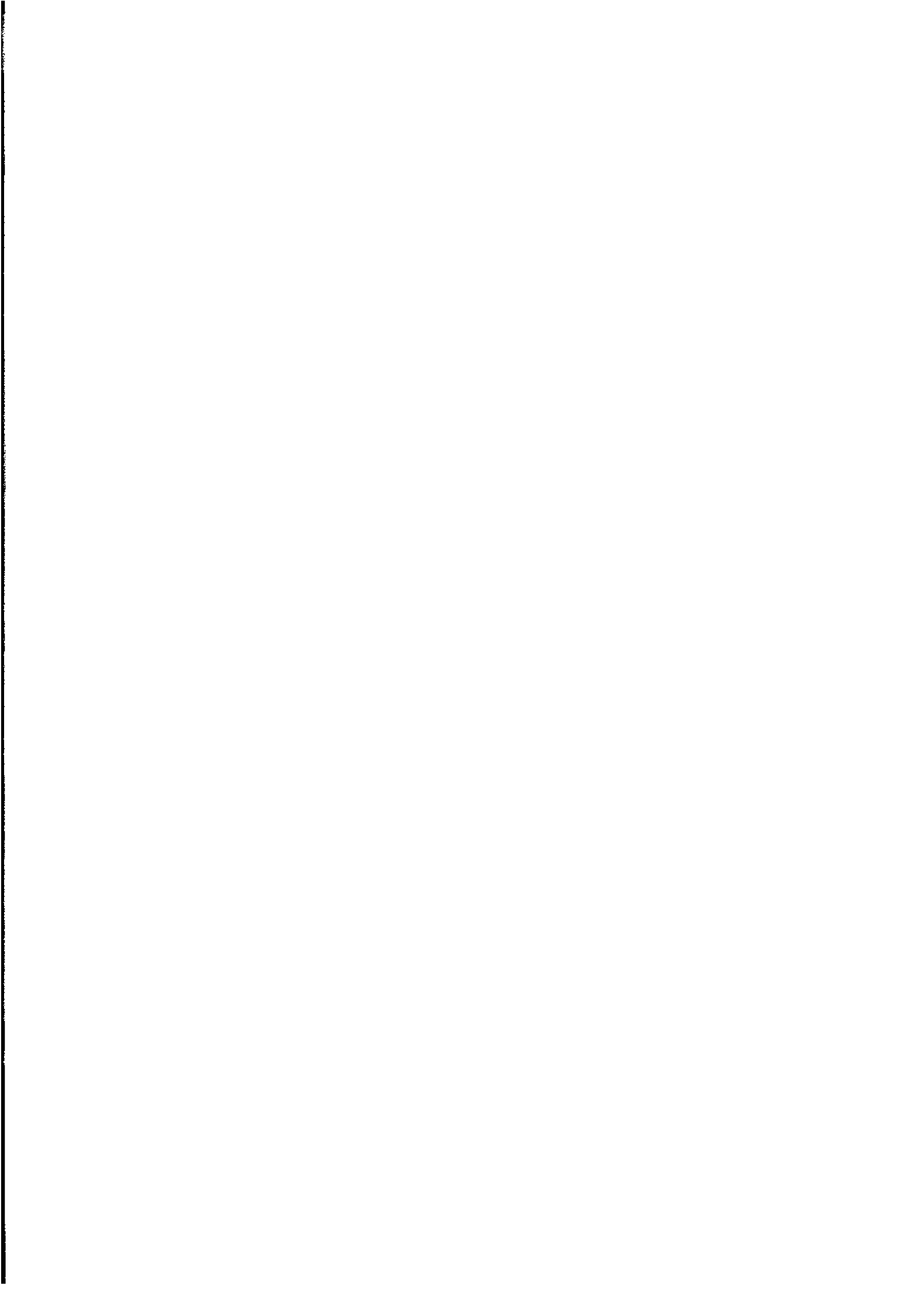
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
