

Estimated Resident Population in Statistical Local Areas Western Australia 30 June 1992 Preliminary

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MAIN FEATURES

The preliminary estimated resident population of Western Australia at 30 June 1992 was 1,657,081 persons, an increase of 21,014 persons or 1.28 per cent since 30 June 1991.

The preliminary estimated resident population of the Perth Statistical Division was 1,205,268, an increase of 16,506 persons or 1.39 per cent, representing 72.7 per cent of the State population.

The preliminary estimated resident population for the rest of the State was 451,813 an increase of 4,508 or 1.01 per cent.

NOTES

This publication presents the estimated resident population of Western Australia at 30 June 1986 and 1991 and the preliminary estimated resident population at 30 June 1992.

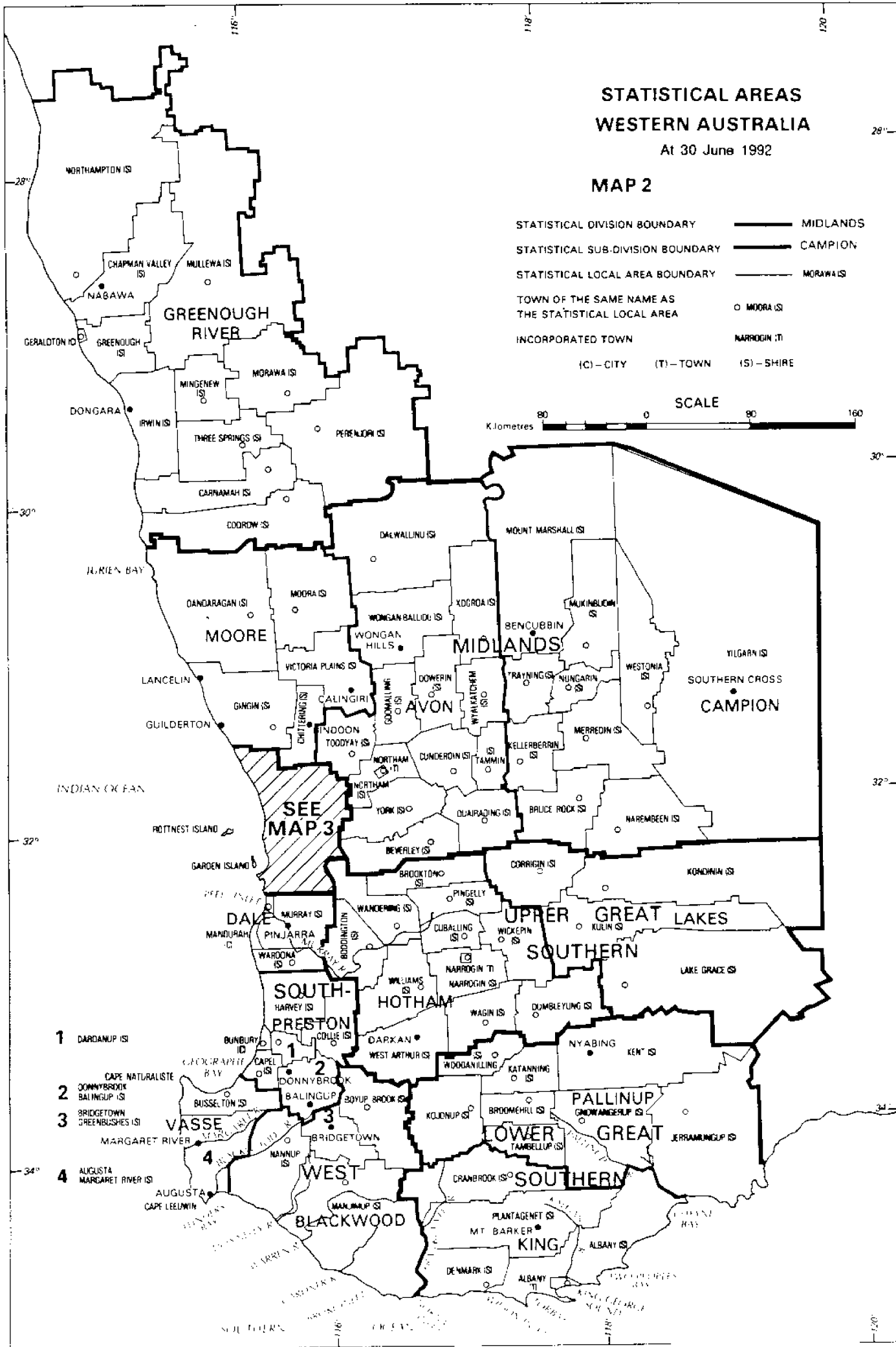

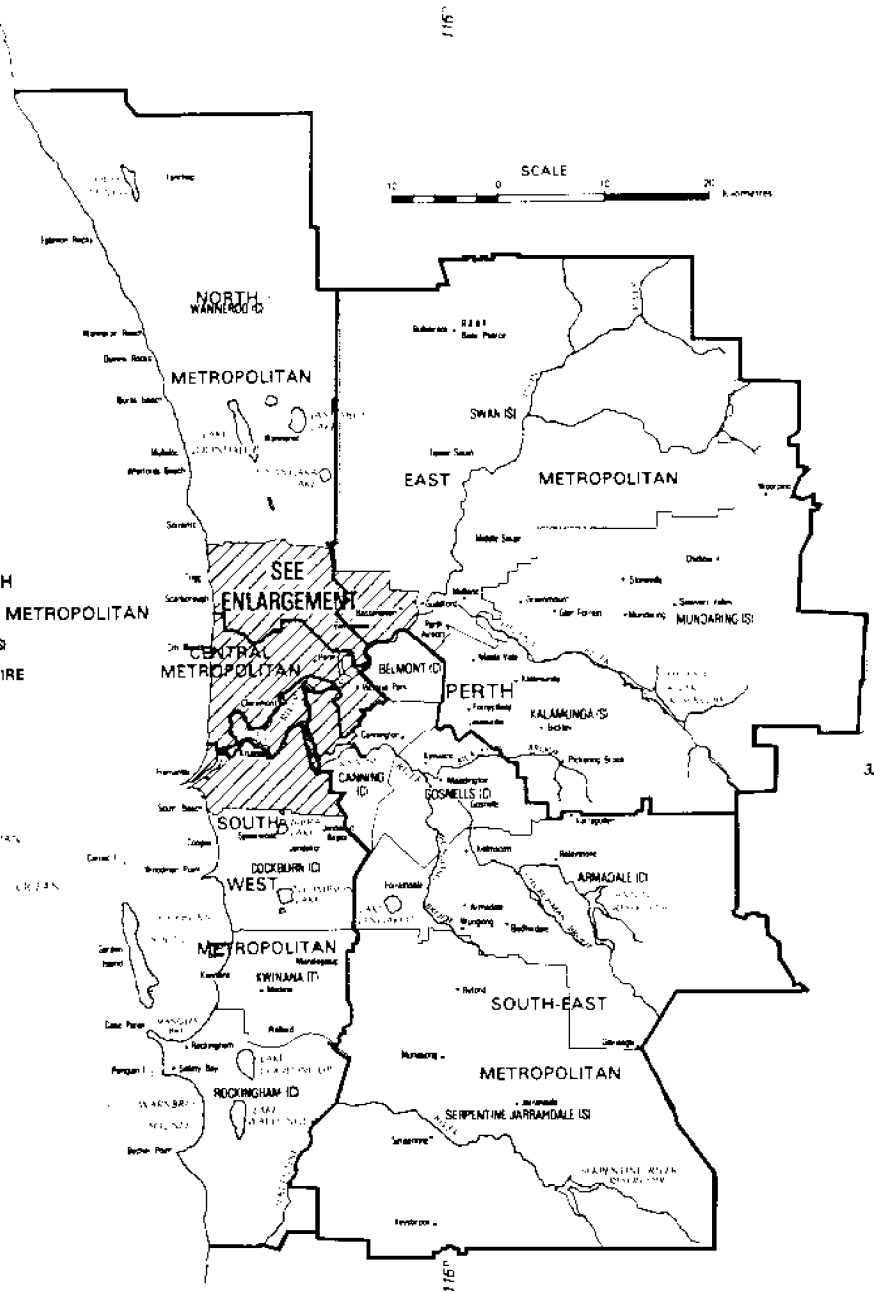

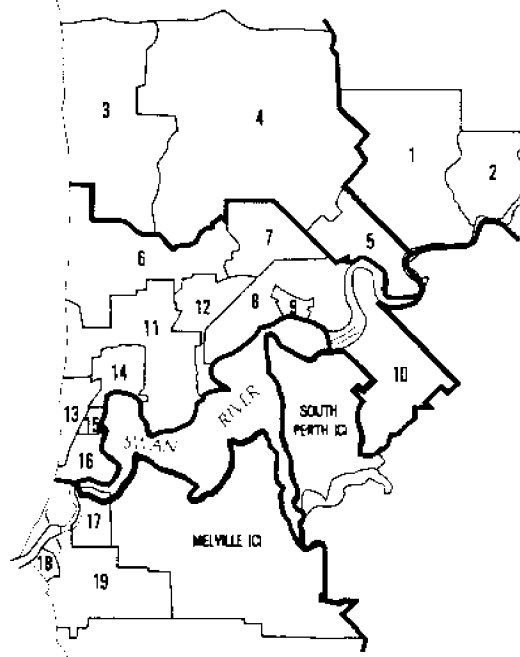

EXPLANATORY NOTES

Methodology

The estimated resident population is the official population estimates series compiled according to the place of usual residence of the population. An explanation of the conceptual basis is given in the ABS Information Paper entitled *Population Estimates: An Outline of the New Conceptual Basis of ABS Population Estimates* (Catalogue Number 3216.0) issued on 29 March 1982.

2. The estimated resident population as at 30 June 1986 and 30 June 1991 for each Statistical Local Area (SLA) are based on usual residence census counts, adjusted for census underenumeration and the number of residents temporarily overseas at the census date.

3. For intercensal years, the estimated resident population (at 30 June 1992) for each statistical local area (SLA) is calculated using a linear regression model. In this method a mathematical relationship is established between changes in population and changes in other variables, known as predictor variables, over the period between the two most recent censuses for which detailed information is available (i.e. 1986 and 1991). This relationship is then used to estimate the change in population of each area since the date of the last census (i.e. 1991), based on the changes in the predictor variables since that date. The predictor variables in the current model are private dwellings and medicare enrolment data.

4. Other relevant information is also used to supplement the estimates from the regression model when preparing the published estimates. This includes information provided by each local government authority on significant local factors which might have caused population changes during the relevant period.

Area statistics

5. ABS area statistics are now classified according to the *Australian Standard Geographical Classification*, Edition 5 (Catalogue Number 1216.0). Figures previously published for local government areas, statistical sub-divisions and divisions are directly comparable with this classification. The Cities of Perth, Fremantle and Stirling are comprised of a number of SLA's. However estimates for individual SLA's were not compiled for these areas prior to 1986.

6. SLA's are marked (C) for City, (T) for Town or (S) for Shire. The names and designations are as they existed at 30 June 1992.

Boundary and name changes

7. There were no significant boundary changes affecting population between 1 July 1991 and 30 June 1992.

Revisions

8. The estimates for 30 June 1986 and 1991 contained in this publication are final figures. The estimates for 30 June 1992 are preliminary and are subject to revision.

Reliability

9. Although estimates are calculated and presented to the nearest whole number, accuracy to this level is not claimed and should not be assumed.
