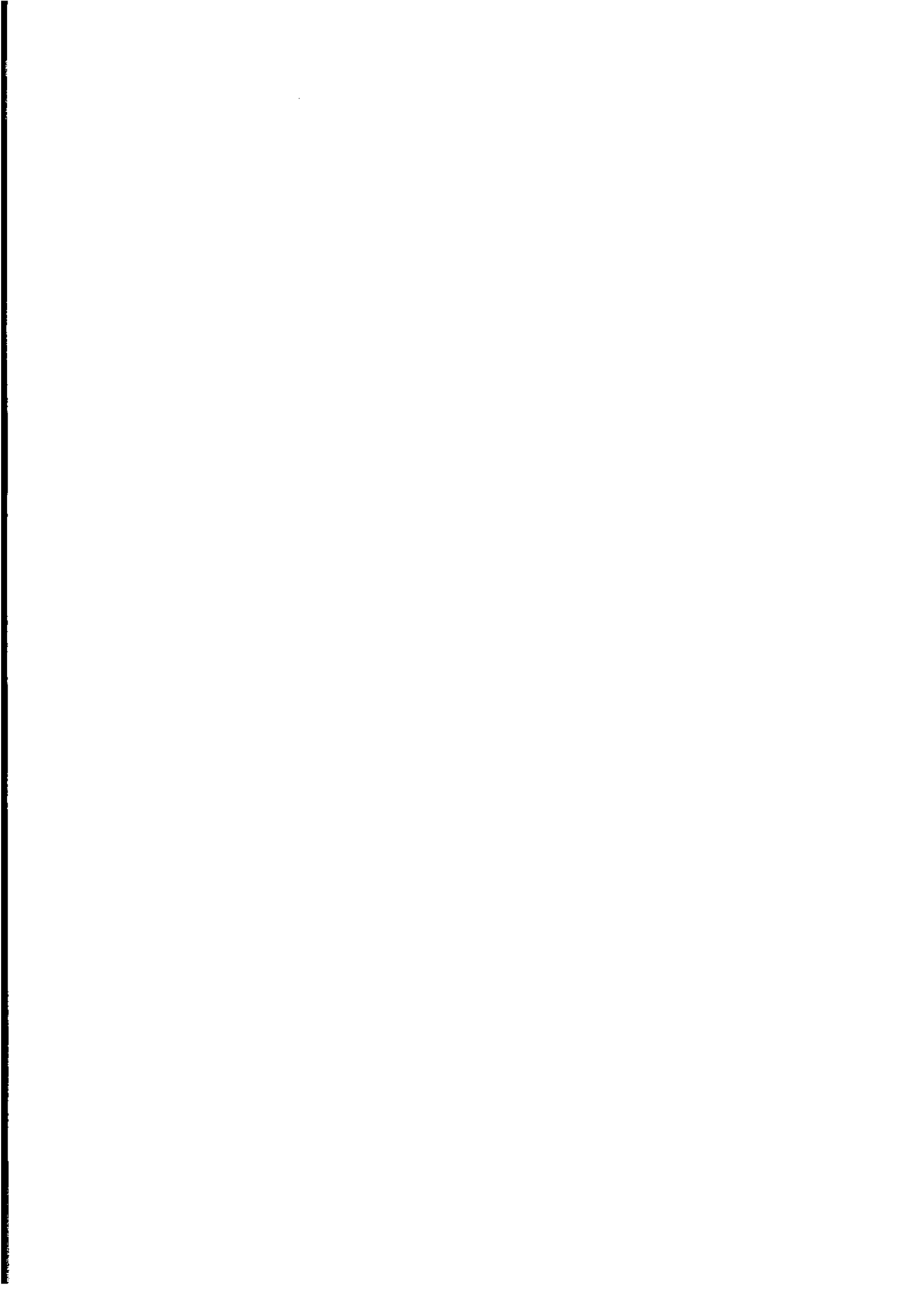

INTRODUCTION

This publication presents the age and sex distribution of the estimated resident population (ERP) of statistical local areas (SLAs) and broader statistical areas of New South Wales at 30 June 1993, for boundaries existing at that date.

The age and sex figures are derived from final estimates of total persons in SLAs at 30 June 1993 which replace preliminary estimates published in April 1994 in the publication *Estimated Resident Population of Statistical Local Areas, Preliminary, 1993* (3210.1). These age and sex estimates are derived by the use of a demographic cohort component method, which is described briefly in the Explanatory Notes at the back of this publication.

Users of estimated resident population statistics should be aware of the availability of preliminary estimates of total persons in SLAs at 30 June 1994. These were recently published in *Estimated Resident Population of Statistical Local Areas, Preliminary, 1994* (3210.1). Age and sex estimates for 1994 are expected to be available on request by the end of April and published in May 1995.

SUMMARY OF FINDINGS

Estimated Resident Population

The estimated resident population of New South Wales at 30 June 1993 was 5,997,400, which represented an increase of 38,700 (0.6%) since 1992.

The population of the Sydney Statistical Division was 3,713,250, or 61.9% of the total population for the State. Between 1992 and 1993 the population of Sydney increased by 13,500 (0.4%). The increase from 1992 to 1993 accounted for 34.9% of the increase for the State. Of the statistical local areas in the Sydney Statistical Division, Camden (4.4%), Hawkesbury (2.0%), Penrith (1.9%) and Wyong (1.9%) experienced the highest growth, whilst Botany (-1.1%), Manly (-1.1%), Pittwater (-1.1%) and Marrickville (-1.0%) showed the highest loss.

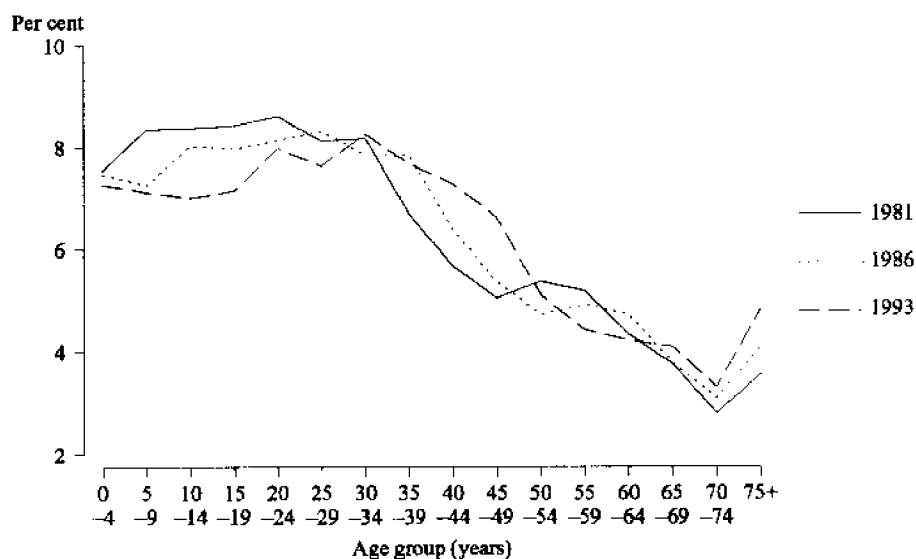
Across the remainder of New South Wales, the coastal statistical divisions of Richmond-Tweed (2.3%), Mid-North Coast (2.0%) and South Eastern (1.7%) continued to experience the highest growth. The statistical local areas with the most significant growth during the year were Junee (10.0%), Yarrowlumla (4.5%), Nymboida (3.6%), and Eurobodalla (3.2%).

Age Distribution

The established trend of the ageing of the State's population continues. In 1981, aged persons (those aged 65 years or more) constituted 10.1% of the New South Wales population, compared to 11.0% in 1986 and 12.2% in 1993.

Whilst the proportion of aged residents in New South Wales continues to increase, the proportion of children (persons aged less than 15 years) in New South Wales continues to diminish. In 1981 the proportion of children resident in New South Wales was 24.3%, in 1986 it was 22.8% and in 1993 it was 21.4%.

ESTIMATED RESIDENT POPULATION BY AGE, NSW, AT 30 JUNE



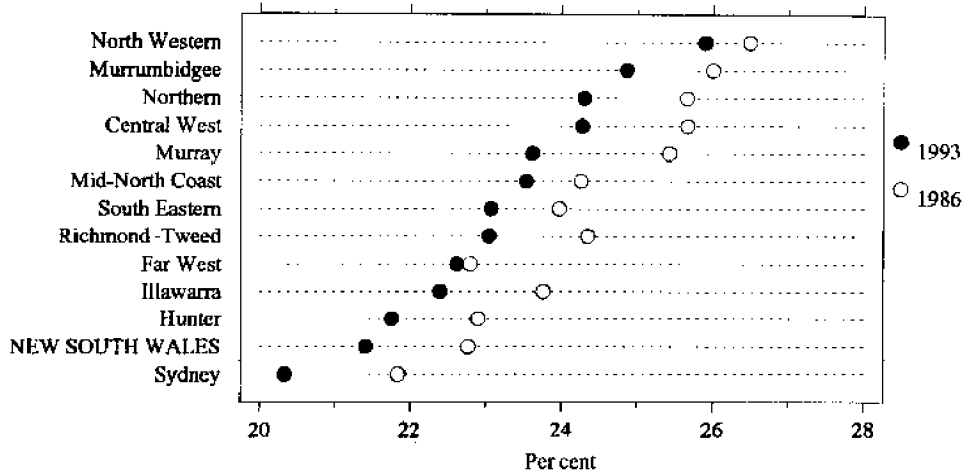
Children (aged less than 15 years)

At 30 June 1993, there were 1,284,083 children residing in New South Wales — 657,563 males and 626,520 females.

The Sydney Statistical Division maintains its position of having the lowest portion of children (20.3% of the estimated resident population) of all the statistical divisions in New South Wales. The lowest proportions of children within the Sydney Statistical Division were in Sydney (7.2%), South Sydney (8.6%) and North Sydney (8.7%). Within the Sydney Statistical Division the highest proportions of children were located in the outlying statistical local areas of Campbelltown (30.3%), Wollondilly (28.4%) and Penrith (27.1%).

Outside of the Sydney Statistical Division, North Western (25.9%) and Murrumbidgee (24.9%) Statistical Divisions continued to have the highest proportions of children whilst the Hunter Statistical Division (21.7%) remains as having the lowest proportion of children in its resident population.

The Aged (65 years or more)

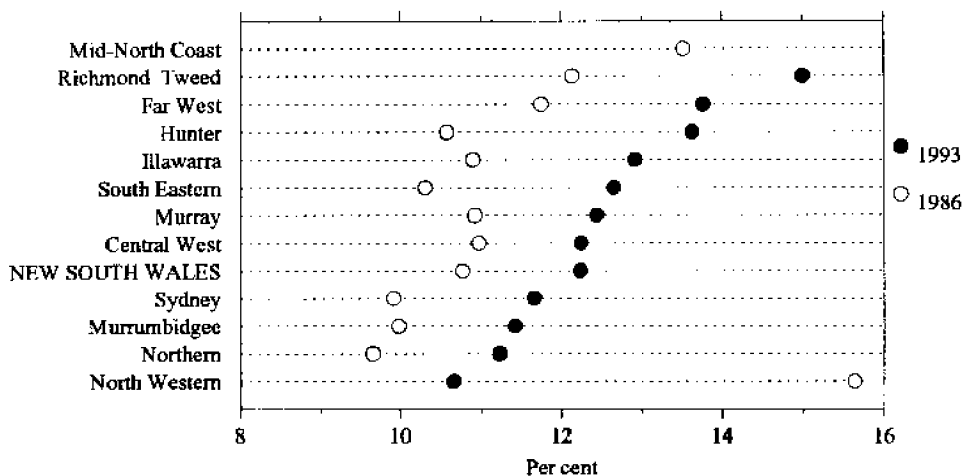
At 30 June 1993, there were an estimated 733,252 aged persons resident in New South Wales — 313,930 males and 419,322 females.

The aged represented 11.7% of the population of the Sydney Statistical Division. The statistical local areas with the highest proportions of aged persons within the Sydney Statistical Division were Hunters Hill (18.2%), Wyong (18.0%) and Manly (17.1%). The lowest proportions of the aged were found in Campbelltown (4.5%), Penrith (5.7%) and Blacktown (6.1%).

Outside of Sydney, the proportion of aged persons was 13.1% which was above the State figure of 12.2%. The statistical divisions with the highest proportions of aged persons were Mid-North Coast (15.6%) and Richmond-Tweed (15.3%). The statistical divisions with the lowest proportions were North Western (10.7%) and Northern (11.2%).

Of the State's 733,252 aged persons, 289,482 or 39.5% were aged 75 years or more. This proportion has increased since 1986 when 37.4% were aged 75 years or more.

Sex Ratio

Females continue to outnumber males in the older age groups. In 1993 the number of females aged 65 years or more was 419,322 and the number of males aged 65 years or more was 313,930. This represents a ratio of about 1.3 females for every male.

This ratio becomes greater when older age groups are examined. In 1993 there were about 1.7 females aged 75 years or more for every male aged 75 years or more. Whilst high, this ratio continues to decrease. In 1981, there were about 1.9 females aged 75 years or more for every male aged 75 years or more and in 1986 the ratio was about 1.8.

NSW, AT 30 JUNE 1993

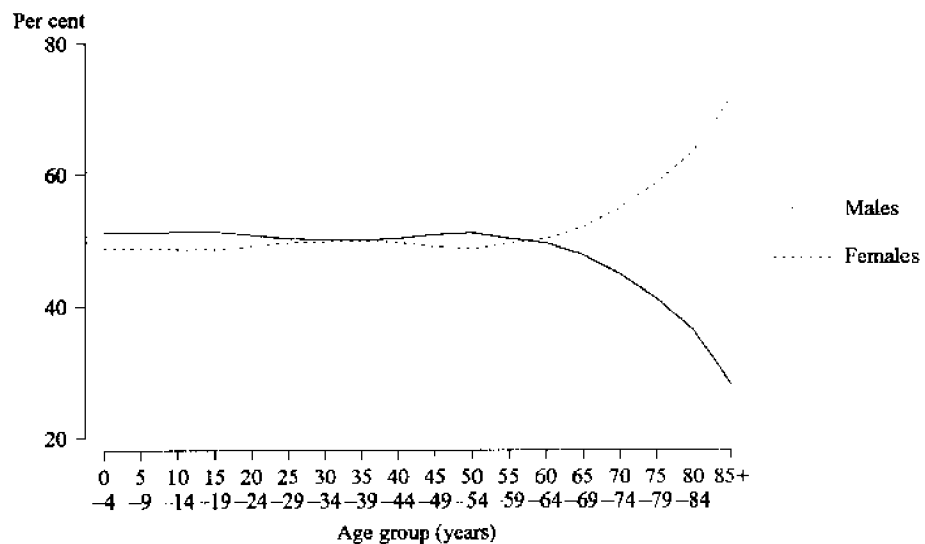

EXPLANATORY NOTES

Estimated Resident Population

The *Estimated Resident Population (ERP)* of an area (State, Statistical Local Area, etc.) is the estimate of the number of persons who usually reside in that area irrespective of where they were at the date of the estimate.

2. Intercensal estimates of resident population are based on the ERP at the date of the previous census (in this case, at the 1991 Census) and available measures of change in resident population since that date. As no direct measure of population movement at the statistical local area level is available, the indicators used may give an incomplete picture of such movement. Therefore it should be noted that all intercensal estimates will be subject to revision when final figures are available from the processing of the 1996 Census.

3. Detailed explanation of the concept of estimated resident population, as adopted by the Australian Bureau of Statistics for official population estimates, is contained in the ABS Information Paper *Population Estimates: An Outline of the New Conceptual Basis of ABS Population Estimates* (3216.0).

Method

4. The figures contained in this publication were obtained by a demographic cohort component method. The age and sex estimates at 30 June 1993 were produced as follows:

- (a) Census-based estimates by age and sex in SLAs at 30 June 1991 were used as the base for updating.
- (b) Estimates of total persons in each SLA at 30 June 1993 were made on the basis indicated in Note 2.
- (c) Age/sex migration profiles were derived for each SLA from 1986 Census data on usual residence one year prior to the Census date. Profiles were derived for:
 - (i) *Inter-SLA arrivals* — persons residing in the SLA whose usual residence one year ago was in another SLA within Australia.
 - (ii) *Inter-SLA departures* — persons whose SLA of usual residence one year ago was that SLA but whose residence at the date of the Census was another SLA within Australia.
 - (iii) *SLA overseas arrivals* — persons in the SLA whose usual residence one year ago was overseas.

SLA overseas departures profiles were derived using an average for the last three years of overseas departures data by usual residence, obtained from passenger cards.

(d) The total population growth for each SLA during 1992–93 was then split into natural increase and net migration components. Natural increase was derived for each SLA for 1992–93 from birth and death registration statistics. Net migration was derived for each SLA as the difference between total population growth and natural increase.

(e) Using the migration profiles and the derived net migration component for an SLA, the age/sex distribution of the net migration component was compiled for that SLA. This distribution and data of deaths by age, and births in each SLA were then added to (or subtracted from) the corresponding age/sex cell estimate at 30 June 1992, which was derived from the Census-based estimates described in (a) above. The totals for each age/sex group were then forced to the State total for that age/sex group independently determined.

Statistical areas of New South Wales

5. This publication contains data presented according to the Australian Standard Geographical Classification (ASGC). Under this classification, statistical areas are defined as follows:

- (a) *Statistical Local Areas (SLAs)*. These geographical areas are, in almost all cases, identical with, or have been formed from a division of, whole legal local government areas (LGAs) as defined under the (State) *Local Government Act 1919* and comprising cities (C), municipalities (M) and shires (S). In other cases, they represent areas which are unincorporated under the Act. In aggregate, SLAs cover the whole of the State without gaps or overlaps. In some cases legal LGAs overlap statistical subdivision boundaries and therefore comprise two SLAs (Part A and Part B) or three SLAs in the case of Cabonne (S) (Part A, Part B and Part C). Separate estimates for these legal LGAs are shown on page 28 of this publication.
- (b) *Statistical Subdivisions (SSDs)*. These consist of one or more SLAs and form the intermediate size spatial unit for the presentation of regional data.
- (c) *Statistical Divisions (SDs)*. These consist of one or more statistical subdivisions (SSDs). Where SSDs are not shown, statistical local areas are ordered alphabetically within statistical divisions. The divisions are designed to be relatively homogeneous regions characterised by identifiable social and economic units within the region, under the unifying influence of one or more major towns or cities.

6. Further information concerning statistical areas is contained in the publication *Regional Statistics, New South Wales* (1304.1) and in the publication *Australian Standard Geographical Classification* (1216.0).

Boundary changes

7. A list of name changes, amalgamations and boundary changes of SLAs and other statistical areas of New South Wales, from 1 July 1992 to 30 June 1993, is contained in the Appendix on page 31 of this publication.

Rounding

8. Estimates for each age and sex category are shown to the nearest unit without rounding; **accuracy to this level is not claimed and should not be assumed**. This procedure is consistent with 1987 to 1992 age and sex estimates, and is applied because rounding of small cells could result in substantial year to year fluctuations owing to the rounding process rather than an actual population change.

9. However, the estimates of total persons have been compiled independently and have been rounded to levels of relative significance. All areas in Sydney Statistical Division have been rounded to the nearest 50 persons; for the remainder of New South Wales, the SLA and subdivision totals have been rounded to the nearest 10 persons while statistical division totals have been rounded to the nearest 50 persons; the State total has been rounded to the nearest 100 persons. As a result, discrepancies may occur between sums of the component items and the totals shown for total persons.

Floppy disk

10. The data contained in this publication are also available on floppy disk.

Additional statistics available

11. In some cases, the ABS can also make available information which is not published. 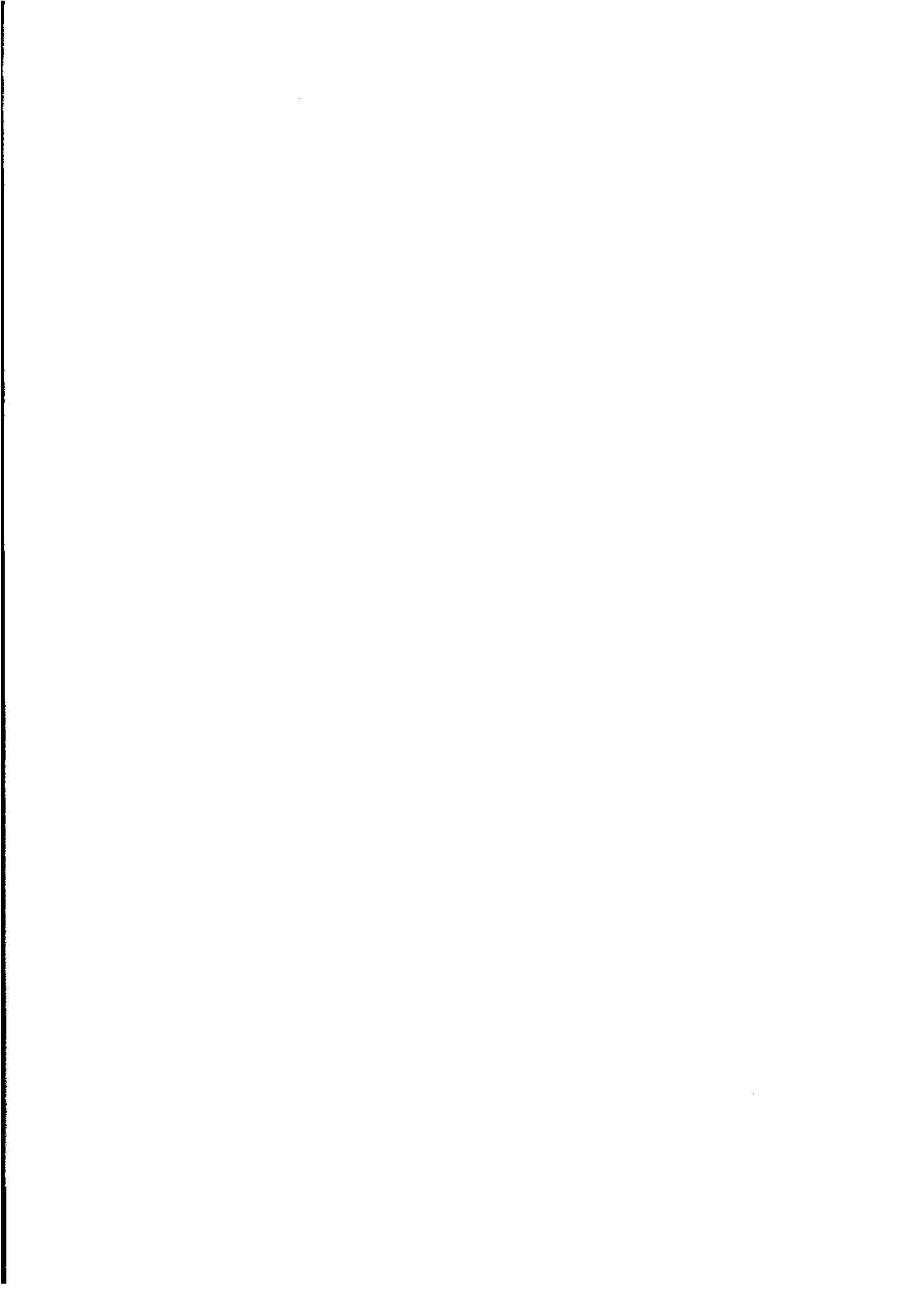
