## MAIN FEATURES

## MARCH QUARTER

## Permanent and long term movement

Permanent and long term arrivals totalled 47,443, 19.2 per cent below the total of $\mathbf{5 8 , 7 2 3}$ for the March quarter 1982. Permanent and long term departures totalled 29,299 $\mathbf{1 1 . 2}$ per cent above the total of $\mathbf{2 6 , 3 4 4}$ for the March quarter 1982.

Permanent settler arrivals declined 24.1 per cent from $\mathbf{3 0 , 1 9 4}$ in the March quarter 1982 to 22,910 in the March quarter 1983. The decline was principally due to a fall in the number of European born settlers, particularly those from U.K. and Ireland.

## Short-term movement

Short-term visitor arrivals fell 3.2 per cent from 242,900 in the March quarter 1982 to $\mathbf{2 3 5 , 1 0 0}$ in the March quarter 1983. The decline was principally due to a 10.4 per cent fall in the number of visitor arrivals in the month of March. Short term resident departures fell 3.6 per cent from 285,200 in the March quarter 1982 to 274,900 in the March quarter 1983.

The number of visitors from Europe fell 14.2 per cent from 90,900 (March quarter 1982) to 78,000 (March quarter 1983). The largest fall was from the U.K. and Ireland, down 18.6 per cent to $\mathbf{4 4 , 8 0 0}$. Visitors from Asia rose 19.1 per cent to $\mathbf{5 3 , 9 0 0}$.

The decline in visitors from Europe was heavily concentrated in the month of March, when arrivals fell 32.5 per cent from 31,100 in March 1982 to 21,000 in March 1983.

Resident departures to Africa fell $\mathbf{3 5 . 2}$ per cent over a twelve month period to 2,700 in the March quarter 1983. Departures to America rose 5.2 per cent to 39,800 . Departures to Asia fell 5.6 per cent to 82,800 . The decline in departures to Asia was the first since 1977 and was concentrated in the months of February and March. Departures to Oceania fell 3.1 per cent over the twelve month period to 92,500 in the March quarter 1983.

## MONTH OF APRIL - PROVISIONAL

Compared with the month of April 1982, provisional estimates for April 1983 indicate that permanent and long term arrivals fell 25.5 per cent to 11,866 and permanent and long term departures fell $\mathbf{2 6 . 9}$ per cent to 5,000.
Short term visitor arrivals and short term reisdent departures are provisionally estimated at $\mathbf{7 2 , 2 0 0}$ and 97,700 respectively, an estimated fall of 12.7 per cent and 3.0 per cent respectively on the March 1982 figures.

## EXPLANATORY NOTES

## Introduction

This series of publications is released at approximately monthly intervals and contains the latest available provisional and final estimates in summary form. The new data in this issue are final estimates for January, February and March 1983, and provisional estimates for April 1983.
2. Overseas arrival and departure statistics are obtained from passenger cards completed by travellers. Provisional estimates, based on early counts of cards by the Department of Immigration and Ethnic Affairs, are shown in these publications if they are available and not yet superseded by final estimates.
