## MAIN FEATURES

## Permanent and long-term movement

Permanent and long-term arrivals rose by 1.6 per cent from 57,800 in the March quarter 1981 to 58,700 in the March quarter 1982.

This compares with a decline of 5.8 per cent from the June quarter $1981(48,200)$ to 45,500 in the June quarter 1982.

Permanent and long term departures rose by 2.7 per cent and 3.0 per cent respectively to $\mathbf{2 6 , 3 0 0}$ and 19,700 in the March and June quarters 1982 from the same periods in 1981.

## Short-term movement

Visitor arrivals rose 4.5 per cent from 232,600 in the March quarter 1981 to 242,900 in the March quarter 1982. There was a small increase of 0.5 per cent from 203,500 in the June quarter 1981 to 204,600 in the June quarter 1982.

Short term departures of residents rose 3.7 per cent in the March quarter to $\mathbf{2 8 5 , 2 0 0}$ compared to the same quarter in 1981 and to $\mathbf{3 4 5 , 2 0 0}$ in the June quarter 1982, which is up 9.2 per cent on the June quarter 1981.

## March Quarter 1982

Visitor arrivals from Asia rose 15.7 per cent to 45,200 in the March quarter 1982 from 39,100 in the March quarter 1981. Visitor arrivals from Europe also rose 12.4 per cent to $\mathbf{9 0 , 9 0 0}$. Visitors from Oceania fell 9.7 per cent to 57,400 , the fall being due to a 14.4 per cent drop in visitors from New Zealand.

Short term departures of residents to Asia rose 5.5 per cent to 87,700 in the March quarter 1982 from 83,100 in the March quarter 1981. Departures to Oceania rose 11.4 per cent to $\mathbf{9 5 , 5 0 0}$. Departures to Europe fell 7.1 per cent to $\mathbf{5 8 , 6 0 0}$.

## EXPLANATORY NOTES

## Introduction

This series of publications is released at approximately monthly intervals and contains the latest available provisional and final estimates in summary form. The new data in this issue are final estimates for March 1982, and provisional estimates for April, May and June 1982.
2. Overseas arrival and departure statistics are obtained from passenger cards completed by travellers. Provisional estimates, based on early counts of cards by the Department of Immigration and Ethnic Affairs, are shown in these publications if they are available and not yet superseded by final estimates.

Comprehensive definitions and explanations, and detailed data for three and twelve monthly periods, are contained in Overseas Arrivals and Departures, Australia (3402.0 and 3404.0) and also in Australian Demographic Statistics Quarterly (3101.0).
