AUSTRALIAN DEMOGRAPHIC REVIEW NO.163 OVERSEA ARRIVALS AND DEPARTURES - MARCH, 1963 (PRELIMINARY)

Monthly figures of oversea arrivals and departures are shown in the tables below. The figures for the latest month are obtained OFFICE from a preliminary count and are subject to revision. Final figures for this month will be shown in the next issue of these statistics.

"Permanent Movement" relates to persons arriving who state their intention to settle permanently in Australia, and residents departing who state their intention to reside permanently abroad. "Long-term Movement" relates to the arrival of visitors or temporary departure of residents who state their intention to stay (in Australia or in a country abroad respectively) for twelve months or more, and the departure of visitors or return of residents who have stayed (in Australia or in a country abroad respectively) for twelve months or "Short-term Movement" relates to all other movement, including the movement of Australian troops irrespective of period of stay.

Statistics of Permanent Movement and Long-Term Movement were shown separately for the first time in Demographic Review No. 143. Further information regarding the basis of these figures and statistics for earlier periods were also shown in that Review. regarding other aspects of "Permanent Oversea Migration" was shown in Part II of Demographic Review No. 113).
