Details of stated purpose of journey for the long-term movement (i.e. for visitors arriving who intend to stay in Australia for twelve months or more and residents departing who intend to stay temporarily in a country abroad for twelve months or more) may be found in the notes at the foot of table 7 (visitors) and table 10 (residents).

For the classification of visitors arriving (long-term movement) by country of last residence, and of Australian residents departing (long-term movement) according to the country in which they next intend to stay for twelve months or more, - see "Overseas Arrivals and Departures, Part 1."

EXPLANATORY NOTES

This publication provides, in Section I, statistics of total overseas arrivals and departures and, in Section II, statistics of overseas arrivals and departures in the short-term movement during the March quarter 1968.

2. More detailed statistics of permanent and long-term movement have appeared in Part 1 of this publication, entitled "Overseas Arrivals and Departures, March quarter 1968. Part 1. - Permanent and Long-term Movement" and issued on 17 JUNE 1968. Monthly figures of overseas arrivals and departures are also issued, the latest being in respect of March 1968 (see "Overseas Arrivals and Departures - March quarter 1968, issued on 22 May 1968).

3. The statistics of overseas arrivals and departures exclude passengers passing through Australia on board the same ship or on the same flight (variously called direct transit passengers or "through" passengers), passengers on short pleasure cruises in the South West Pacific commencing and finishing in Australia on ships not then engaged in regular voyages, and all air crew and ships' crew. For statistics of direct transit and pleasure cruise sea passengers, see paragraph 9 of these Explanatory Notes.

4. The classification into permanent, long-term and short-term is based on information supplied by the traveller on arrival in or departure from Australia. THESE STATEMENTS REPRESENT THE TRAVELLER'S INTENTION AT THE TIME. MANY TRAVELLERS SUBSEQUENTLY CHANGE THEIR INTENTIONS AND THIS MUST BE BORNE IN MIND IN INTERPRETING THE STATISTICS.

5. Permanent movement consists of persons arriving with the stated intention of settling permanently in Australia, and Australian residents departing with the stated intention of residing permanently abroad. Settlers are persons who, on arrival in Australia, indicated that they came intending to settle. Former Settlers are persons who, on departure from Australia, stated that they had come to Australia intending to settle, had stayed for a period of twelve months or more, and were now departing permanently.

6. Long-term movement consists of the arrival of visitors and the departure of residents with the stated intention of staying (in Australia or in a country abroad, respectively) for twelve months or more and the departure of visitors and the return of Australian residents who have stayed (in Australia or in a country abroad, respectively) for twelve months or more.

7. Short-term movement consists of all other movements, including the movement of Australian troops irrespective of period of stay, and U.S. troops visiting Australia on rest and recreation leave. U.S. troops on rest and recreation leave have been classified for statistical purposes as short-term visitors travelling to and from Australia by air for holiday purposes and staying in Australia less than one week, and whose country of residence and of embarkation/disembarkation is "Asia-Other".

8. Visitors arriving and residents departing whether classified as long-term or short-term are further classified according to their stated purpose of journey, the categories being : for visitors, "in transit", "business", "holiday", "education" and "other purposes"; and for residents, "business", "holiday", "education" and "other purposes". "In transit" visitors include those who show "in transit" as their stated purpose of journey to Australia provided that their intended length of stay in Australia does not exceed one month.

9. The following two tables relate, respectively, to direct transit shipping passengers and passengers on short sea cruises in the South West Pacific area commencing and finishing in Australia. As explained in paragraph 3 above these passengers are not included amongst the arrivals and departures statistics shown in other tables of this bulletin.
