## MAIN FEATURES

## APRIL 1984

## Permanent and Long Term Movement

In April 1984 there were $\mathbf{1 0 , 2 5 0}$ permanent and long term arrivals, 15 per cent less than in April $1983(12,040)$ and 36 per cent less than in April 1982 (15,920). 7,630 permanent and long term departures were recorded in April 1984, 2 per cent higher than in April $1983(7,480)$ and 12 per cent higher than April 1982 (6,840).

Settler arrivals numbered 5,570 in April 1984, 24 per cent less than in April 1983 and 43 per cent below the April 1982 level. There was little change in the number of settler arrivals from Asia. In April 1984, 2,730 settlers arrived from Asia compared with 2,690 in April 1983. Settler arrivals from Europe remained at a low level, similar to that of the first quarter of 1984. Arrivals from Europe in April 1984 (1,600) was 47 per cent of that in April 1983 $(3,400)$. There was an increase in settler arrivals from Oceania (mainly New Zealand) over the same period from 500 in April 1983 to 640 in April 1984. The level is, however, below the 1,150 recorded in April 1982.

## Short Term Movement

Overseas visitor arrivals in April 1984 were 83,300, 18 per cent higher than in April 1983. Over that period, visitors from Oceania increased by $\mathbf{4 3}$ per cent and visitors from America by $\mathbf{2 6}$ per cent.

Short term departures of Australian residents were 126,300 in April 1984, 31 per cent higher than in April 1983, most of the increase being in travel to Europe (58 per cent) and Oceania ( 32 per cent).
2. Overseas arrival and departure statistics are obtained from passenger cards completed by travellers. The estimates in this publication are subject to both sampling and other errors and have been rounded to a level consistent with their general validity. The sums of components may not add exactly to totals, due to rounding.
