## OVERSEAS ARRIVALS AND DEPARTURES, JULY 1978 AND PROVISIONAL ESTIMATES FOR THE MONTHS AUGUST 10 NOVEMBER 1978

#### MAIN FEATURES

- Provisional figures for total arrivals in the months of October and November 1978 are 163,133 and 163,960 respectively, representing increases of 8 per cent and 7 per cent over the corresponding months of 1977. Total departures are estimated at 127,715 and 127,192, increases of 13 per cent and 10 per cent over corresponding 1977 figures.
- During the year ended June 1978, 73,171 settlers arrived and 23,096 Australian residents (including former settlers) departed permanently, resulting in a net gain on permanent movement of 50,075, slightly higher than the corresponding 1976-77 figure of 46,328.
- The number of settlers arriving in October 1978 was 5,496, 20 per cent less than in October 1977. In November 1978 5,017 settlers arrived, 16 per cent less than in the corresponding month of 1977.
- 91,468 Australian residents departed for short-term trips abroad in July 1978, approximately 8 per cent more than in July 1977. In the year ended June 1978, the most popular destination for trips by Australian residents was New Zealand, followed by the U.K. and U.S.A. as the second and third most popular destinations. 4,474 Australian residents made short-term trips to the People's Republic of China in 1977-78, approximately two and a half times the number who did so in the previous twelve months.
- Overseas visitors arriving for short-term visits in July 1978 numbered 44,335, an increase of 9 per cent over the July 1977 figure. New Zealand remained the largest source of overseas visitors in 1977-78, providing approximately 30 per cent of all visitors to Australia, the number of visitors coming to Australia from New Zealand increasing 17 per cent over the 1976-77 figure.

### Introduction

This publication contains summary statistics of overseas arrivals in and departures from Australia during the month of July 1978, together with statistics for earlier periods. More detailed statistics are published quarterly and annually in *Overseas Arrivals and Departures* (3402.0 and 3404.0).

#### Provisional estimates

2. Provisional estimates of total arrivals and departures and of settlers arriving from different countries in the months August to November 1978, included in Tables 1, 3 and 5, were provided by the Department of Immigration and Ethnic Affairs.

## Source of the statistics

3. Persons arriving in or departing from Australia are required to complete prescribed questionnaires in the form of Incoming and Outgoing Passenger Cards. These cards provide information to the Department of Immigration and Ethnic Affairs for administrative purposes and serve as the main source of statistics of overseas arrivals and departures.

#### Scope

4. The statistics published in this bulletin exclude air crew and ships' crew, transit passengers who pass through Australia but are not cleared for entry, and passengers on pleasure cruises commencing and finishing in Australia aboard ships not then engaged on regular voyages.

## Seasonally adjusted series

5. Seasonally adjusted figures of total and short-term arrivals and departures are shown in Tables 1 and 7. Details of the methods employed in seasonally adjusting these series are given in Seasonally Adjusted Indicators (1308.0).

## Category of traveller

6. Permanent movement consists of persons who, on arrival, state that they intend to settle in Australia (settlers) and of Australian residents, including former settlers, departing permanently, i.e. those who, on departure, state that they do not intend to return to Australia. Long-term movement is defined as comprising overseas visitors arriving and Australian residents departing temporarily with the intention of staying (in Australia or abroad, respectively) for twelve months or more, together with the departure of visitors and the return of Australian residents who stayed, in Australia or abroad, for twelve months or more. Travellers whose intended or actual period of stay is less than twelve months are classified as short-term.

## Country of stay, embarkation or disembarkation

7. Country of stay refers to the country in which

Australian residents departing temporarily intend to spend most time, or the country in which Australian residents returning have spent most time. Country of embarkation or disembarkation refers to the country in which the traveller boards the actual ship or flight which brings him to Australia, or alights from the actual ship or flight which takes him from Australia. Travellers may answer this incorrectly, perhaps naming the country in which their journey commenced or will end, not withstanding any changes of flight or ship en route.

#### Related statistics

8. Related statistics are available from the Department of Immigration and Ethnic Affairs and the Department of Transport. The tables in this and other publications necessarily contain only a small part of the cross-classifications of items which are or can be produced. Also, items such as country, occupation and length of stay are necessarily summarised from more detailed classifications. Further details can be obtained by writing to the Bureau or ringing the number shown on page 1.

## Sampling

9. While all permanent and long-term movement, and short-term movement by sea, is fully enumerated, statistics of short-term movement by air are estimates derived from a sample. The sampling fractions used for the various sampling strata are as follows:

	Australian residents departing	1 in 10

Estimates based on a sample are likely to differ from those obtained from a full enumeration. A measure of the difference which may be expected due to sampling is the "standard error" of the estimate. There are approximately two chances in three that the difference will be less than one standard error, and nineteen chances in twenty that it will be less than two standard errors. Thus, for example, if the estimate for Australian residents departing short-term is 500 then the approximate standard error is 70. There are two chances in three that the actual number of Australian residents departing short-term would lie between 430 and 570. and nineteen chances in twenty that it would lie between 360 and 640. The standard error varies with the sampling fraction used and the size of the estimate. The table below gives approximate standard errors for estimates of various sizes for three categories of traveller.

#### Rounding

11. After sampling, weights are assigned to sampled records to three decimal places, to increase the accuracy of estimation. During estimation all figures are rounded to the nearest integer. Where figures have been rounded, discrepancies may occur between sums of the component items and totals.
