MAIN FEATURES

JULY 1984

Permanent and Long Term Movement

In July 1984 there were 12,020 permanent and long term arrivals, 1 per cent lower than in July 1983 (12,160), and 26 per cent lower than in July 1982 (16,150). There were 7,270 permanent and long term departures in July 1984, 17 per cent lower than in July 1983 (8,780), but 4 per cent more than in July 1982 (6,980).

Settler arrivals numbered 5,950 in July 1984, 5 per cent fewer than in July 1983 (6,280) and 36 per cent fewer than in July 1982 (9,250). 2,920 of the settlers who arrived during July 1984 were born in Asia, constituting 49 per cent of all settler arrivals in July 1984 compared with 35 per cent in July 1983 (2,170).

27 per cent (1,630) of settler arrivals in July 1984 were born in Europe, compared to 44 per cent (2,790) in July 1983.

Short Term Movement

The number of short term visitor arrivals in July 1984 was 85,500, a small increase of 2 per cent over the number for July 1983 (84,000).

119,600 Australian resident departures were recorded in July 1984, 6 per cent higher than in July 1983 (113,400). 2. Overseas arrival and departure statistics are obtained from passenger cards completed by travellers. The estimates in this publication are subject to both sampling and other errors and have been rounded to a level consistent with their general validity. The sums of components may not add exactly to totals, due to rounding.
