## **MAIN FEATURES**

#### Permanent and long-term movement

Provisional estimates for 1982 show that permanent and long-term arrivals fell 8.5 per cent from 212,689 in 1981 to 194,700 in 1982. Permanent (settler) arrivals fell 9.9 per cent to 107,000 Permanent and long-term departures increased 7.6 per cent from 85,612 in 1981 to 92,100 in 1982. Permanent departures rose 12.2 per cent from 19.856 to 22,300.

Provisional estimates for the December quarter 1982 show that permanent and long-term arrivals fell 20.4 per cent from 56,655 in the December quarter 1981 to 45,100 in the December quarter 1982. Permanent (settler) arrivals fell 24.8 per cent to 23,300. Permanent and long-term departures rose 10.8 per cent from 21,688 in the December quarter 1981 to 24,000 in the December quarter 1982. Permanent departures rose 14.1 per cent to 6,100.

This issue includes a new table (Table 2) showing final estimates of permanent (settler) arrivals classified by Country of Birth. Settler arrivals fell 20.8% from 10,704 in October 1981 to 8,480 in October 1982, and this table shows that the main decrease was in respect of those born in Asia (down 38.0% from 2,935 in October 1981 to 1,821 in October 1982).

#### Short-term movement

Provisional estimates for 1982 show that short-term visitor arrivals rose 1.5 per cent from 936,700 in 1981 to 950,800 in 1982, while short-term resident departures rose 4.2 per cent from 1,217,300 in 1981 to 1,268,500 in 1982.

Short-term visitor arrivals in the December quarter 1982 fell 2.6 per cent to 274,500 (provisional) when compared with the same quarter in the previous year; while shortterm resident departures fell 5.0 per cent to 303,500 (provisional) over the same period.

#### EXPLANATORY NOTES

#### Introduction

This series of publications is released at approximately monthly intervals and contains the latest available provisional and final estimates in summary form. The new data in this issue are final estimates for October 1982, and provisional estimates for November and December 1982.

2. Overseas arrival and departure statistics are obtained from passenger cards completed by travellers. Provisional estimates, based on early counts of cards by the Department of Immigration and Ethnic Affairs, are shown in these publications if they are available and not vet superseded by final estimates.
