OVERSEAS ARRIVALS AND DEPARTURES. OCTOBER 1969

Monthly figures of overseas arrivals and departures are shown in the tables below. The figures for the latest months are subject to revision. More detailed statistics are published on a quarterly basis (see Overseas Arrivals and Departures, Part 1: Permanent and long-term movement; and Part 2: Total and short-term movement).

Permanent movement relates to persons arriving who state their intention of settling permanently in Australia and residents departing who state their intention of residing permanently abroad. Long-term movement relates to the arrival of visitors or temporary departure of residents who state their intention of staying (in Australia or in a country abroad respectively) for twelve months or more, and the departure of visitors or return of residents who have stayed (in Australia or in a country abroad respectively) for twelve months or more. Short-term movement relates to all other movement, including the movement of Australian troops irrespective of period of stay, and U.S. troops visiting Australia on rest and recreation leave. U.S. troops on rest and recreation leave have been classified for statistical purposes in the following tables as short-term visitors. Further information regarding the basis of these statistics is given in the quarterly publications referred to above. Table 2 includes seasonally adjusted figures for short-term visitors arriving in Australia.
