MAIN FEATURES

Settler arrivals -

- During 1978, 68,419 settlers arrived in Australia, compared with 75,640 in 1977, a drop of 9.5 per cent.
- During 1978, 12,378 settlers came from the main South East Asian countries (7,778 in 1977), 28,010 from the UK and Ireland, Canada and New Zealand, and 9,873 (17,745 in 1977) from European and Mediterranean countries. The largest drop between 1977 and 1978 was in the number of settlers arriving from the UK and Ireland and from Lebanon.
- During the first six months of 1979, settlers arrived at the rate of 5,570 per month, which is 4 per cent lower than the average for the corresponding period in 1978.

Australian residents departing permanently

- . The number of these increased from 22,762 in 1977 to 24,961 in 1978, an increase of 9.7 per cent.
- Provisional figures suggest that, during the first half of 1979, departures remained at the 1978 levels.

International tourism

- Overseas visitors to Australia classified to the short-term movement (visits for less than one year) increased from 563,281 in 1977 to 630,594 in 1978, an increase of 12 per cent. The increase was large amongst visitors from Indonesia (35.6 per cent), the Philippines (23.7 per cent), New Zealand (23.1 per cent), South Africa (21.3 per cent) and Germany (21.1 per cent).
- Provisional figures suggest that the rising trend is continuing. The number of overseas visitors arriving for short-term stays in the first six months of 1979 was approximately 25 per cent higher than in the same period of 1978.

There occurred also an increase of Australian residents making trips abroad lasting less than a year. The number departing on such trips in 1978, 1,062,234, was 9.4 per cent higher than in the previous year. Provisional figures indicate that, during January-June 1979, 12.5 per cent more Australian residents departed for visits abroad for less than one year than in the same period in 1978.

EXPLANATORY NOTES

Introduction

This publication contains summary final statistics of overseas arrivals and departures during November and December 1978, and preliminary figures and provisional estimates to the end of June 1979.

- 2. Increasing delays in the primary processing of passenger cards by the Department of Immigration and Ethnic Affairs have recently prevented the regular monthly publication of this series of publications. The Department has introduced new arrangements, operative from July 1979, which will allow publication of detailed provisional figures in respect of the permanent and long-term movement within about two months after the month of movement. Revised publication arrangements to take account of these changes will be introduced by the ABS.
- 3. Provisional estimates are produced during an early stage of processing by the Department of Immigration and Ethnic Affairs, to provide first indications of the size of the various components of total movement. They should be regarded as approximate only. Preliminary figures (p) are obtained during a later stage of processing. They are subject to minor amendment following final processing by the ABS.

Source of the statistics

4. Persons arriving in or departing from Australia are required to complete prescribed questionnaires in the

form of Incoming and Outgoing Passenger Cards. These cards provide information to the Department of Immigration and Ethnic Affairs for administrative purposes and serve as the main source of statistics of overseas arrivals and departures.

Scope

5. The statistics published in this publication exclude air crew and ships' crew, transit passengers who pass through Australia but are not cleared for entry, and passengers on pleasure cruises commencing and finishing in Australia aboard ships not then engaged on regular voyages.

Seasonally adjusted series

6. Seasonally adjusted figures of total and short-term arrivals and departures are shown in Table 1. Details of the methods employed in seasonally adjusting these series are given in Seasonally Adjusted Indicators (1308.0).

Category of traveller

7. Permanent movement consists of persons who, on arrival, state that they intend to settle in Australia (settlers) and of Australian residents, including former settlers, departing permanently, i.e. those who, on departure, state that they do not intend to return to Australia. Long-term movement is defined as comprising overseas visitors arriving and Australian residents departing temporarily with the intention of staying (in Australia or abroad, respectively) for twelve months or more, together with the departure of visitors and the return of Australian residents who stayed, in Australia or abroad, for twelve months or more. Travellers whose intended or actual period of stay is less than twelve months are classified as short-term.

Country of stay, embarkation or disembarkation

8. Country of stay refers to the country in which Australian residents departing temporarily intend to spend most time, or the country in which Australian residents returning have spent most time. Country of embarkation or disembarkation refers to the country in which travellers board the actual ship or flight which brings them to Australia, or alight from the actual ship or flight which takes them from Australia. Travellers may answer this incorrectly, perhaps naming the country in which their journey commenced or will end, not withstanding any changes of flight or ship en route.

Sampling

9. All movements by air with a duration of stay equal to or less than one year are sampled.

Related Publications

- 10. Detailed statistics and more extensive explanations of these figures are published quarterly and annually in *Overseas Arrivals and Departures* (3402.0 and 3404.0). Related statistics are also available from the Department of Immigration and Ethnic Affairs and the Department of Transport. Published tabulations contain necessarily only a small part of the information which can be derived from the collection of passenger card data. Further details can be obtained by writing to the ABS or ringing the number shown above.
- 11. All publications produced by the ABS are listed in the *Catalogue of Publications* (1101.0) which is available free of charge from any ABS office.

Rounding

- 12. After sampling, weights are assigned to sampled records to three decimal places, to increase the accuracy of estimation. During estimation all figures are rounded to the nearest integer. Where figures have been rounded, discrepancies may occur between sums of the component items and totals.
- 13. Provisional figures are rounded to the nearest hundred to distinguish them from preliminary and final figures.
