#### MAIN FEATURES

#### **YEAR 1983**

Permanent and long term movement

Permanent and long term arivals declined by 21.3 per cent from 195,210 for 1982 to 153,580 in 1983. Permanent arrivals fell by 26.9 per cent to 78,390.

Permanent arrivals of settlers born in Asia were 9.3 per cent higher at 29,700 (24,350 born in East and South Eastern Asia and 5,360 in other Asia); arrivals born in the UK and Ireland were 43.6 per cent lower at 19,630 and arrivals born in other European countries were down 41.9 per cent to 13,730.

Permanent and long term departures totalled 100,510, 8.8 per cent more than for 1982.

#### Short term movement

Visitor arrivals during 1983 of 943,900 were 1.1 per cent lower than during 1982. Visitor arrivals from the Americas increased 8.7 per cent to 178,000; from Asia they increased by 11.8 per cent to 204,500; from Europe they fell by 10.7 per cent to 268,100; and from Oceania they fell by 4.9 per cent to 273,800.

Total short term resident departures during 1983 fell 2.6 per cent to 1,253,000; departures to the Americas fell by 10.0 per cent to 163,800; departures to Asia fell by 2.1 per cent to 378,400; departures to Oceania fell by 2.3 per cent to 377,400 but departures to Europe rose by 0.7 per cent to 314,300.

#### MONTH OF DECEMBER

Permanent arrivals for December 1983 were 13 per cent lower than for December 1982, in line with recent trends. Arrivals of settlers born in Asia were 22 per cent more than for December 1982 at 2,330. Settlers born in the U.K. and Ireland totalled 1,110, 35 per cent lower, and settlers born in other European countries were 900, 40 per cent lower.

Short term visitor arrivals were 5 per cent higher at 117,600, including a 19 per cent increase from the Americas to 16,600 and a 24 per cent increase from Asia to 27,300.

Short term resident departures were 4 per cent higher at 149,800. Departures to Europe were 16 per cent higher at 30,000.

#### **EXPLANATORY NOTES**

#### Introduction

This series of publications is released at approximately monthly intervals and contains the latest available final estimates in summary form. The new data in this issue are final estimates for December 1983.

Overseas arrival and departure statistics are obtained from passenger cards completed by travellers. The estimates in this publication are subject to both sampling and other errors and have been rounded to a level consistent with their general validity. The sums of components may not add exactly to totals, due to rounding
