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EXPLANATORY NOTES

This bulletin contains statistics of schools in Australia for 1965 with comparative figures for earlier years. "School Censuses" are conducted annually in all States and the internal Territories of Australia at or about the beginning of August. The numbers of pupils in this bulletin refer to enrolments at the school census date. The numbers of schools and teachers refer to the position at dates which vary from State to State and in some instances from year to year. A summary statement of the number of pupils according to grades was issued on 26th April, 1966 (see Social Statistics, No. 39, School Enrolments, 1965) and appears also in Table 8 of this bulletin.

2. Differences in the school systems, especially as regards types of schools, ages of commencing full-time education, cessation of compulsory education, the grading of pupils and advancement from grade to grade, the systems of examinations, transfer from secondary to vocational education, and the recruitment and employment of teachers, have a major bearing on the figures presented in this bulletin. Such differences should be kept in mind in inter-State and inter-system comparisons. Reference is made in the following notes to the effect on specific tables of some differences in systems and in administrative arrangements. To assist in the interpretation of pupil statistics, a diagram of grades and examinations in the various school systems has been incorporated in this Bulletin. However, reference should be made, as appropriate, to the annual reports of the State Education Departments. For a general description of the Australian school systems, see the latest issue of the Commonwealth Year Book (No. 51. - 1965) and for comparative statements see the various publications of the Commonwealth Office of Education. Detailed schools statistics for individual States appear also in the publications of the Deputy Commonwealth Statistician in the State concerned.

3. In Section I, figures are given of the numbers of schools. The figures include the schools providing education according to the primary or secondary school curricula of the State Education Departments (or both), whether provided in government or non-government schools. Junior technical schools, correspondence schools and schools in institutional homes, hospitals, missions and similar establishments are included. Institutions providing only pre-school education, senior technical and agricultural colleges, evening schools, continuation classes and institutions such as business colleges and coaching establishments are, as a rule, excluded. Table 2, "Size of Schools" is shown for the first time in this series of bulletins.

4. "Special Schools" are shown separately. A "Special school" is a school specifically intended for the instruction of pupils who are physically or mentally handicapped, socially maladjusted, or who are in similar other categories not normally taught in ordinary schools, and who, but for these handicaps, would be receiving full-time education at ordinary schools. Schools specifically set up for the education of Aboriginal boys and girls requiring other than ordinary schooling are included as Special schools.

5. Section II contains statistics of teachers. The presentation of teacher statistics in this bulletin has been changed from that in issues for previous years, in order to show more clearly the bases used for counting part-time teachers. Tables 4 and 5 show, for 1965, numbers of full-time and part-time teachers separately, and the equivalent full-time units of part-time teaching for each State and Territory and for Australia. Table 6 shows statistics relating to teachers for earlier years, but information for the years prior to 1965 is not available in the same detail as for 1965. The footnotes to Tables 4, 5 and 6 indicate, as far as possible, the varying bases on which teacher figures have been compiled. Apart from the differences so noted, there are differences arising from the inclusion or exclusion of special purpose, casual and trainee teachers, the classification of teachers who, besides primary and secondary teaching, are also engaged on other duties, and the inclusion or exclusion of teachers who were employed for various periods during a year. Many differences of this nature remain between States and between systems, and the effect of these differences on the figures shown cannot be gauged. For these reasons, comparisons of teacher figures between States and systems and over years should be made with caution.

6. Section III provides information relating to school pupils. Once a school is included in the collection, all pupils in that school are included, even though some of them may not receive primary or secondary education. For instance, there are schools in some States which cater for pre-school children as well as

primary pupils. In these cases, the pre-school children are included in enrolments. However, adult correspondence pupils are excluded as far as possible. The figures in Table 7 show the total number of pupils in the various categories for schools set out in Table 1. It should be noted that pupils attending special schools may follow the normal curricula and pupils at ordinary schools may be in special classes, etc. and follow special curricula to suit their needs. Thus the figures provided in Table 7 give no indication of the number of boys and girls requiring or receiving special education. The differences in the organisation of special, Aboriginal and correspondence education in the various States should be borne in mind in this connection.

7. The grade information provided in Table 8 is not comparable between States and for this reason the State figures have not been aggregated into Australian totals. The grading of pupils differs for the various school systems in Australia because of the difference in curricula set by Education Departments. In addition, the methods of allocating classes to grades, particularly classes for special or ungraded pupils, vary from State to State and there are also differences in the administrative methods of aggregating grades of a more or less similar nature. There is some difference in the grading adopted, within each State, for government schools and various non-government schools, but these differences are likely to be small. While the tables have been slightly rearranged from the data provided by the Education Departments and other sources (for instance, separate tables for primary and secondary schools in some States were combined into one table), they represent essentially the system of grading adopted in each different State.

8. Tables 9 and 10 show ages of pupils for each State and for Australia. In Tables 11 to 13 comparative statistics of pupils are shown for earlier years. For the age tables, the ages for all pupils were collected for 1965, but for earlier years, where the ages of all pupils were not collected, these pupils are shown as "ages not stated" and are included in the totals. In previous bulletins, such pupils were excluded from all age tables, and the numbers excluded shown in footnotes.

9. Section IV., containing Tables 14 to 21, shows pupils according to ages cross-classified with grades for each State and Territory. As in Table 8, the grade information provided is not comparable between States.

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**GRADES AND EXAMINATIONS IN THE PRIMARY AND SECONDARY SCHOOL SYSTEMS IN EACH STATE AND TERRITORY, 1965**

The grade terminology follows, as nearly as possible, that used in government primary and high schools in each State in 1965. It is not necessarily used in all types of schools. The grades have been written in approximately to agree with the age-scale shown on the diagram, in order to indicate differences in age-grade patterns between States. The diagram should not be taken as a comparison of academic standards of grades between States. For a more detailed presentation of the systems operating in each State, reference should be made to diagrams etc. appearing in the annual reports of State Ministers of Education.
