SCHOOLS, 1970

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EXPLANATORY NOTES

This bulletin contains statistics of schools, teachers, and pupils in Australia for 1970 with comparative figures for earlier years. "School censuses" are conducted annually in all States and the internal Territories of Australia at or about the beginning of August. The figures in this bulletin refer to schools and enrolments at the school census date. The numbers of teachers refer to the position at dates which vary from State to State.

2. Differences in the school systems, especially as regards types of schools, ages of commencing full-time education, cessation of compulsory education, the grading of pupils and advancement from grade to grade, the systems of examinations, transfer from secondary to vocational education, and the recruitment and employment of teachers, have a major bearing on the figures in this bulletin. Such differences should be kept in mind in inter-state and inter-system comparisons. Reference is made in the following notes to the effect on specific tables of some differences in systems and in administrative arrangements. To assist in the interpretation of pupil statistics, the bulletin contains a diagram of grades and examinations in the various state school systems. However, it may be necessary to refer to the annual reports of the State education departments if more precise information is required. For a general description of the Australian school systems, see the latest issue of the Official Year Book, and for comparative statements see the various publications of the Commonwealth Department of Education and Science. Detailed schools statistics for individual States appear also in the publications of the Deputy Commonwealth Statistician in the State concerned.

3. In Section I, statistics are given of the numbers and sizes of schools. The figures include the schools providing education according to the primary and/or secondary school curricula of the State education departments, whether provided in government or non-government schools. Junior technical schools, correspondence schools and schools in institutional homes, hospitals, missions and similar establishments are included. Senior technical and agricultural colleges, evening schools, continuation classes and institutions such as business colleges and coaching establishments are excluded. Pupils at pre-schools not attached to ordinary schools are excluded : statistics for Tasmania for 1970 and earlier years have been revised to exclude such pupils. Where pre-schools are attached to ordinary schools, pupils are shown against the lowest primary grade.

4. The numbers of "special schools" are shown separately in Tables 1 and 4. A "special school" is a school specifically intended for the instruction of pupils who are physically or mentally handicapped, socially maladjusted, or in other similar categories, and who are not normally taught in ordinary schools, and who, but for these handicaps, would be receiving full-time education at ordinary schools. Schools specifically set up for the education of Aboriginal boys and girls requiring other than ordinary schooling are included as special schools. Correspondence schools are included as ordinary schools except in Tasmania where the school is included with special and teachers and pupils have been divided between ordinary and special according to the curriculum being followed. See also paragraphs 10 and 12 for information about pupils attending special schools. In New South Wales there are sixteen non-government special schools, each of which is partially staffed by State Education Department teachers thereby forming distinct units (government and non-government) within each school. For statistical purposes each unit (including its teachers and pupils) has been treated as a separate school.

5. In Table 5 schools are classified as essentially primary, essentially secondary, and all other. Essentially primary schools are those having primary grade pupils only, and schools having pupils ranging over both primary and secondary grades, provided that facilities are available to teach the full range of primary grades, and that pupils do not go higher than the second secondary grade. Essentially secondary schools are those having secondary grade pupils only, and schools having pupils ranging over both primary and secondary grades, provided that there are pupils in at least the third or higher secondary grades and that no more than 20 per cent of total pupils are in primary grades. All other schools include all special and correspondence schools and those schools not included in the other categories.

6. Table 6 contains statistics of schools classified according to the numbers of primary and secondary pupils. These statistics were first compiled in 1969. The classification of pupils into primary and secondary is in accordance with the groupings set out in Table 13; as indicated in paragraph 12, the groupings vary from State to State. Therefore no Australian aggregates have been provided.

7. Section II contains statistics of teachers. Generally, the figures include principals and head teachers, but exclude teachers-in-training, teachers on leave without pay, and other teachers engaged wholly in advisory, administrative and other non-teaching duties. Footnotes to Table 8 indicate as far as possible the varying bases on which teacher figures have been compiled. (See also paragraph 9 below.) Apart from the differences noted, there are differences arising from the inclusion or exclusion of special purpose and casual teachers, the classification of teachers who, besides primary and secondary teaching, are also engaged on other duties, and the inclusion or exclusion of teachers who were employed for various periods during a year. Many differences of this nature exist between States and between systems, and the effect of these differences on the figures shown cannot be gauged. For these reasons, comparisons of teacher figures between States and systems and over years should be made with caution.

8. The numbers of full-time and part-time teachers are shown, and also teaching by part-time teachers in equivalent full-time units. The methods used for calculating equivalent full-time units of part-time teaching vary from State to State, between government and non-government schools, and even between primary and secondary schools within States. For most non-government schools the information was supplied by individual schools and is based on either total hours worked or total number of class periods taken in a week by part-time teachers, in relation to the normal hours worked or class periods taken by full-time teachers at that school. The methods used for government schools were essentially of three types : (i) total hours worked per week by part-time teachers related to average hours worked by full-time teachers; (ii) part-time payments as proportions of corresponding full-time salaries; and (iii) half-days or full-days worked by part-time teachers expressed as fractions of a five-day week or twenty-day month.

9. In Victoria, the method of estimating the full-time equivalent figures for part-time teachers was changed from 1969. The number of "sessions" taught by part-time teachers is now reported by schools. As ten sessions comprise a full-time week, the total number of sessions is divided by ten to obtain the full-time equivalent. The counting of teachers at Queensland government schools was changed from 1969 onwards. "Casual" teachers engaged on a full-time basis at 1 August 1969 have been included with full-time staff; "supply" teachers occupying posts during the temporary absence of permanent teachers are excluded. Teaching of evening classes part-time by teachers engaged full-time during the day, and teaching by sewing mistresses, is not included from 1969 : these are the only part-time teachers which are employed.

10. Section III provides information relating to pupils. Once a school is included in the collection, all pupils in that school are included, even though some of them may not receive primary or secondary education. For instance, there are schools in some States which cater for pre-school children as well as primary pupils. In these cases, the pre-school children are included in enrolments. However, adult and part-time correspondence pupils are excluded as far as possible. The figures in Table 12 show the total number of pupils in the various categories for schools set out in Table 4. Pupils attending special schools may follow the normal curricula, and pupils at ordinary schools may be in special classes and follow special curricula. Thus the figures provided in Table 12 do not give a reliable indication of the number of boys and girls requiring or receiving special education. In addition, there are differences in the organisation of special Aboriginal and correspondence education in the various States.

11. Care should be exercised in making comparisons of teacher and pupil statistics. Such comparisons are affected by the proportions of teachers and pupils in primary and secondary grades, in special schools and classes, and by differences in curricula and teaching arrangements.

12. The grade information provided in Table 13 is not comparable between States and for this reason the State figures have not been aggregated into Australian totals. The grading of pupils differs for the various school systems in Australia because of the difference in curricula set by education departments. In addition, the methods of allocating classes to grades, particularly classes for pupils in special categories, vary from State to State, and there are also differences in the administrative methods of aggregating grades of a more or less similar nature. There is some difference in the grading adopted, within each State, between government schools and non-government schools, but these differences are likely to be small. While the tables have been slightly rearranged from the data provided by the education departments and other sources (for instance, separate tables for primary and secondary schools in some States were combined into one table), they represent essentially for each State the system of grading adopted in that State.

13. Section IV shows pupils according to ages cross-classified with grades for each State and Territory. As explained above the grade information provided is not comparable between States.

14. The following symbols, when used in Tables, mean :



GRADES AND EXAMINATIONS IN THE PRIMARY AND SECONDARY SCHOOL SYSTEMS IN EACH STATE AND TERRITORY, 1970

The grade terminology follows, as nearly as possible, that used in government primary and high schools in each State in 1970. It is not necessarily used in all types of schools. The grades have been written in to agree with the age-scale shown on the diagram, in order to indicate differences in age-grade patterns between States. However, age-grade information is not precise enough to allow determination of accurate average age of pupils in each grade; and the age indications are therefore only approximate. The diagram should not be taken as a comparison of academic standards of grades between States. The columns of the diagram have been closed with a line where pupils are not accepted into government schools below the age shown. For a more detailed presentation of the systems operating in each State, reference should be made to diagrams etc. appearing in the annual reports of State Education Departments.
