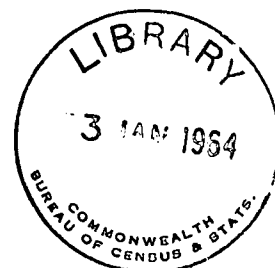

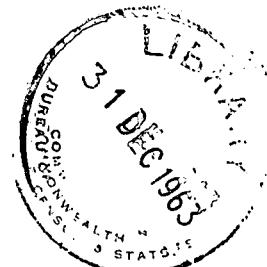

EXPLANATORY NOTES

This Bulletin contains preliminary summary figures of university students, staff and finance, as far as these are available.

2. Major modifications to the scope and detail of Australian university statistics, first introduced in respect of 1961, have caused some delay in the publication of 1962 and 1963 statistics, and this bulletin is intended to provide summary figures before the publication of the remaining detailed statistics. It is also proposed to issue similar preliminary university statistics as early as possible in 1964 and future years.

3. While the statistics contained in this bulletin are derived from information supplied by the universities and are considered to be final in most respects, they are subject to revision in the detailed bulletins to be published.

4. Tables 1 to 3 contain estimates of the number of full-time, part-time and external students in each university in 1963. For 1962 student statistics, see "University Statistics 1962", Part 1 - Students and Degrees Conferred, issued on 14th October, 1963. In table 4 estimates are given of staff positions provided for teaching and research purposes in 1962 and 1963. Detailed 1962 staff statistics will be issued shortly as Part 2 of "University Statistics 1962". Table 5 contains summary figures of income and expenditure of the universities in 1962, together with comparable figures for 1961 as published in Part 3 of "University Statistics 1961", issued on 3rd September, 1963. For detailed figures in respect of past years, reference should be made to the various parts of "University Statistics", issued each year by this Bureau.

5. The statistics in this bulletin are on the same bases as those published for 1961 in "University Statistics". For full definitions of the concepts used, see the Explanatory Notes therein.

6. Care should be exercised in making comparisons of figures from year to year and between universities. For instance, staff and student comparisons are affected by the proportions of full-time and part-time teaching and students.
