EXPLANATORY NOTES.

This Bulletin is the second in a series "Social Statistics" which will present statistics on education, health, welfare and justice, and contains statistics for hospitals throughout Australia for the year ended 30th June, 1960 with comparative figures for earlier years. The first bulletin in the series, No. 1 Schools, 1960, was issued on 12th December, 1961.

The particulars shown herein refer to public hospitals, mental hospitals, and also to those private hospitals approved for the payment of hospital benefits under the Commonwealth "National Health Act, 1953-1959". This is the first occasion on which statistics of the number of private hospitals and private hospital beds and patients have been included in Bureau publications. However, statistics of the number of medical and nursing staff at private hospitals are not as yet available.

The statistics shown under the heading of "Public Hospitals" refer to all institutions affording hospital relief, whether general or special, with the exception of mental hospitals, repatriation hospitals, leper hospitals, and private hospitals conducted commercially. They include hospitals wholly provided for by the State, hospitals partially subsidized by the State or by State endowments but receiving also private aid, and hospitals established and endowed by individuals for the benefit of the needy generally.

Statistics shown for mental hospitals (except those relating to staff) include particulars of the two licensed private mental hospitals in New South Wales. The mental hospital figures exclude particulars of reception houses, and observation wards in gaols.

Particulars of the six repatriation general hospitals (at Concord, N.S.W.; Heidelberg, Victoria; Greenslopes, Queensland; Springbank, S.A.; Hollywood, W.A.; and Hobart, Tasmania) are not included. The average daily number of patients resident in these hospitals during the year ended 30th June, 1960 was 2,677.

The four isolation hospitals for the care and treatment of persons suffering from Hansen's disease (leprosy), located at Little Bay, N.S.W.; Fantome Island, Queensland; Derby, W.A.: and East Arm Settlement, N.T., are also excluded. At the end of 1960 there were 358 patients at these hospitals.
