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PREFACE

This publication presents, for the first time, the geographic distribution, at the detailed level, of the Indigenous population of Australia, using results of the 1996 Census of Population and Housing.

For this purpose, an Indigenous geographical classification was specially developed after extensive consultation with users. Details of this classification are given on page 2 of this publication.

In this publication, data are provided on the number of Indigenous people counted according to where they were enumerated on census night or where they usually resided. In addition, experimental Indigenous estimated resident populations (ERPs) are also presented. Whilst the counts data are obtained from the 1996 Census, the Indigenous ERPs are derived from the usual residence counts, after the following adjustments have been made:

- non-response to the census question on Indigenous status;
- census under-counting of the Indigenous people; and
- Indigenous births and deaths between 30 June and 6 August 1996.

This publication presents only a selection of data from the full range of census Indigenous and non-Indigenous variables. For further information about other census or Australian Bureau of Statistics (ABS) data refer to *Directory of Census Statistics, 1996* (Cat. no. 2910.0) or the *Catalogue of Publications and Products* (Cat. no. 1101.0).

ABS publications draw extensively on information provided freely by individuals, businesses, governments and other organisations. Their continued cooperation is very much appreciated: without it, the wide range of statistics published by the ABS would not be available. Information received by the ABS is treated in strict confidence as required by the *Census and Statistics Act 1905*.

INTRODUCTION

The size and geographic distribution of Australia's Indigenous population are significant determinants of the distribution of government resources and are essential components in the calculation of key Indigenous social statistics needed to monitor progress in addressing social disadvantages.

The tables in this publication provide three types of population figures about the Indigenous and non-Indigenous population in 1996. Two are counts from the Census of Population and Housing conducted on 6 August 1996, the first by place of enumeration and the second by place of usual residence. The third of the population figures is the estimated resident population (ERP) for 30 June 1996. These concepts are explained below.

The publication also presents comparative data from Censuses in 1986 and 1991. Selected non-Indigenous and total Australian population figures are also presented. Comparisons with years prior to 1981 can be made by reference to Smith (1980), and will be analysed further in a future Australian Bureau of Statistics (ABS) occasional paper.

The publication also presents selected population figures about people of Torres Strait Islander origin.

To assist users in interpreting the data a brief description of the Commonwealth definition and census question to determine membership of the Indigenous population group is also provided.

POPULATION CONCEPTS

Place of enumeration counts	<p>Place of enumeration counts are based on where people stated they were located on census night, regardless of where they usually lived. They are the most readily obtained population figures from a census. No adjustments are made for temporary visitors, or for residents who are temporarily absent, or for incomplete or imperfect counting. Place of enumeration counts are only available for the day of the Census.</p> <p>Place of enumeration counts are the only population figures available for geographic areas based on Collection Districts (CD), the smallest geographic bounded area used in the Census. CDs usually contain about 200 dwellings in urban areas or a community or group of outstations in remote areas. Place of enumeration counts presented in this publication exclude overseas visitors.</p>
Place of usual residence counts	<p>Place of usual residence counts are derived from place of enumeration counts after adjustments for temporary visitors based on answers to the census question about the '...address at which the person has lived or intends to live for a total of six or more months in 1996'. Adjustments have also been made for residents who are temporarily absent (but counted elsewhere in Australia) but not for incomplete or imperfect</p>

Place of usual residence counts *continued* counting. Usual residence counts are only available for the day of the Census and cannot be derived for all geographic areas. In particular, they are not available for CDs.

Population estimates The ERP for a given area is the best estimate of the area's resident population at a given time. It is calculated by adjusting census usual residence counts by the extent of incomplete counting during the census (estimated to be 1.7% overall in the 1996 Census (ABS 1997a)). Further modifications are made for births, deaths and migration between the date of the census and the date for which the ERP is calculated which, by convention, is 30 June of each year.

The ERP for the Indigenous population is still considered to be 'experimental' because of the particular difficulties associated with deriving population estimates for the group.

Counts based on place of usual residence are, on average, slightly lower than ERP for the same year, in part because ERP figures are adjusted for people missed in the Census. Counts based on place of enumeration may be higher or lower than the ERP, depending largely on the number of visitors to the area. More detailed information on the three types of population figures is available from the Explanatory Notes and other ABS publications (ABS 1994, 1996a, 1996b).

INDIGENOUS GEOGRAPHY IN THE CENSUS

Geographic areas There are two types of geographic areas used in the output of most census statistics — the Australian Standard Geographical Classification (ASGC) and Census Geographic Areas. Both are based on the CD as the smallest spatial unit.

Both these standard classifications are designed to meet the local area statistical needs for the whole Australian population. As a consequence, neither provides an ideal basis for presenting local area and regional Indigenous statistics due to the significant differences between the geographic distributions of the Indigenous and total Australian populations. This has been overcome by the creation of a new geographical classification, better adapted to the distribution of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander population.

Indigenous geography Like the ASGC, the new Indigenous geographical classification is hierarchical and built up from CDs. It consists of three levels; from smallest to largest: Indigenous Locations (ILOC), Indigenous Areas (IARE), and Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Commission (ATSIC) Regions (AREG). CDs aggregate to form ILOCs, ILOCs aggregate to form IAREs and IAREs aggregate to form AREGs. In most areas, AREGs

aggregate to form States or Territories. There are two exceptions — the Australian Capital Territory is entirely included within the AREG of Queanbeyan which also includes part of New South Wales and the Jervis Bay Territory; and Christmas Island and Cocos (Keeling) Islands are included in the AREG of Perth. Detailed Indigenous statistics are also available at the State or Territory level.

The map on page 4 shows the AREG boundaries, code numbers, and the names of AREGs and associated Regional Councils.

Availability of population
statistics for Indigenous
people

ILOCs are comprised of a number of CDs which together will nearly always have a population of at least 80 Indigenous people. IAREs will usually have at least 280 Indigenous people. ILOCs and IAREs have been constructed with the intention of allowing users to aggregate boundaries according to their own requirements. AREGs are as specified by ATSiC in 1996. Each enumerated Indigenous person is included in just one of the 934 ILOCs, one of the 692 IAREs, and one of the 36 AREGs. For further information on the Indigenous geography and ILOCs, IAREs and AREGs refer to ABS (1997b).

The table below indicates the availability of the three types of population data for Indigenous people by geographic area.

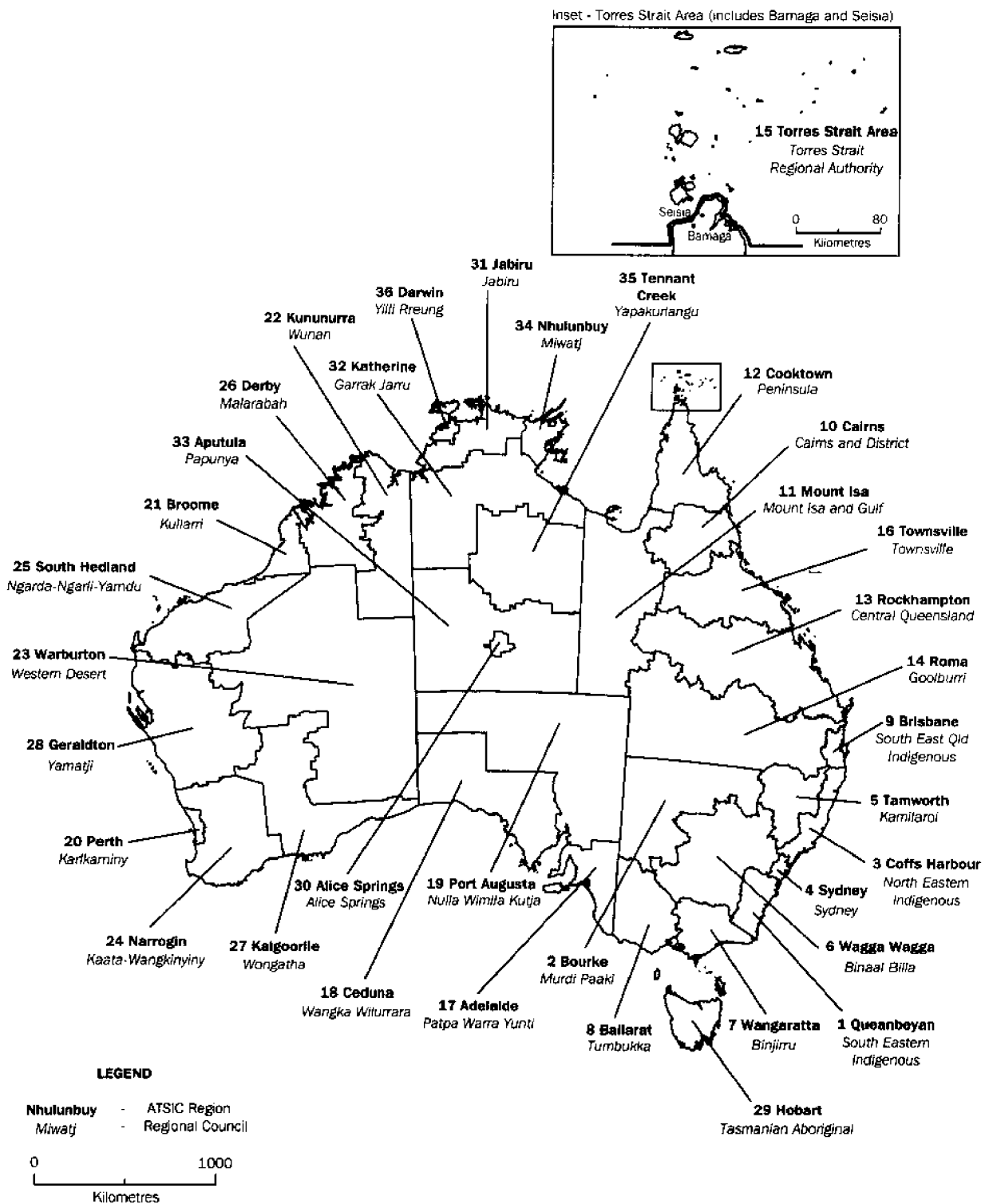

Definition of Indigenous The term Indigenous is used in this publication to refer to Australian Aboriginal people and Torres Strait Islanders. According to the most widely adopted definition of Aboriginal/Torres Strait Islander (the 'Commonwealth working definition'):

An Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander is a person of Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander descent who identifies as an Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander and is accepted as such by the community in which he or she lives. (DAA 1981, p. 1)

This definition was developed during the period 1967 to 1978 and is now widely accepted by Commonwealth and other government agencies. The definition has three elements — descent, self-identification and community acceptance. The choice of which one or combination of these elements to use in collecting information about Indigenous people can affect the resulting statistics.

ABS standard question All ABS Indigenous population figures are based on results from the ABS standard question. The 1995 standard, first used in the 1996 Census, is as follows.

In the 1986 and 1991 Censuses the same question was used but respondents were required to mark only one of the available boxes, i.e. people could not nominate as both Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander.

SUMMARY OF FINDINGS

1996 ERP

At 30 June 1996 the ERP for the Indigenous population of Australia was 372,052. This was 2.0% of the total ERP for Australia (see table 1).

In June 1996 more than a quarter of the Indigenous population were estimated to live in each of New South Wales (29%) and Queensland (27%). Both of these States are estimated to have Indigenous populations in excess of 100,000 people. Western Australia (14%) and the Northern Territory (13%) are together the home of a further quarter of Australia's Indigenous population, each with about 50,000 people.

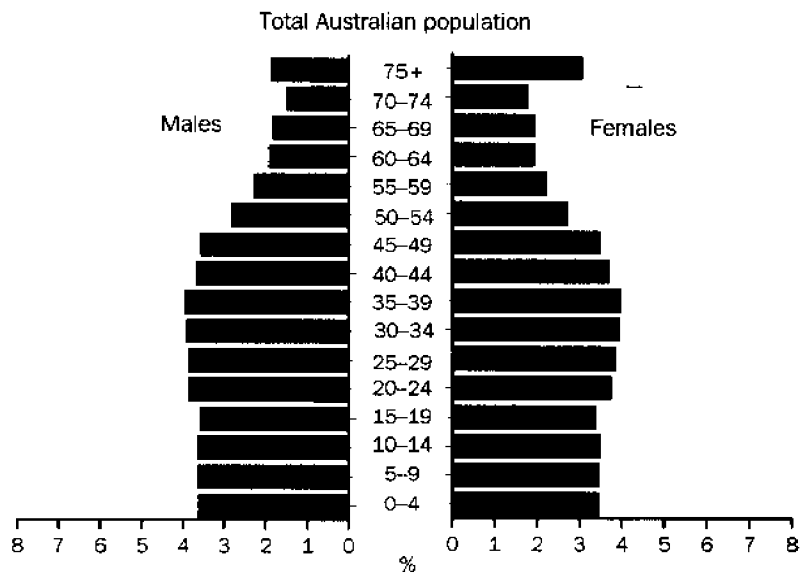
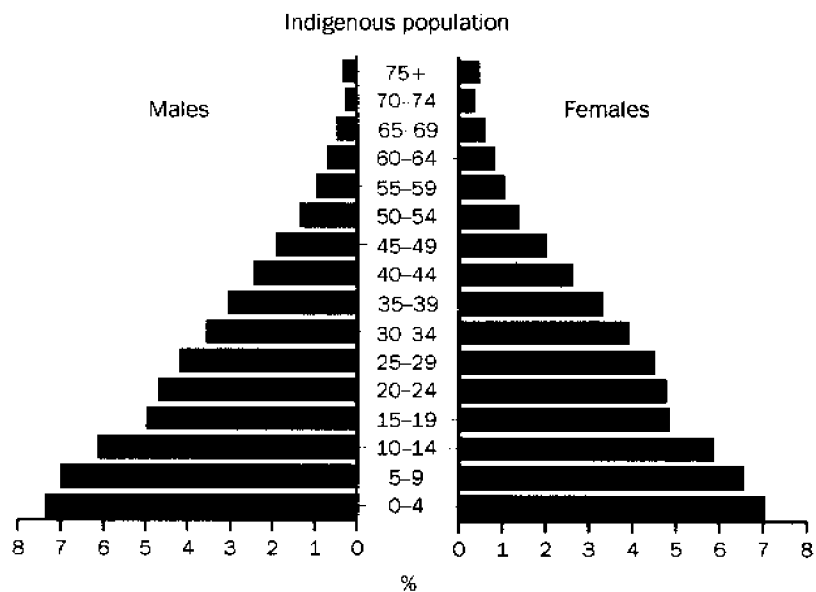
More than a quarter (27%) of the population of the Northern Territory was estimated to be of Indigenous origin. In three other States (Tasmania, Western Australia and Queensland) Indigenous people were estimated to comprise 3% of the population. In all other States and the Australian Capital Territory, Indigenous people comprised less than 2% of the population.

Age and sex distribution

The median age of the total Indigenous population was 20 years and of the total Australian population, 33 years. The median age for Indigenous males was 18 and females 21. The same figures for the total Australian population were 33 and 34 years respectively.

State and Territory population changes

The 1996 Census count by place of usual residence for Indigenous people was 352,970, an increase of 33% from the 1991 Census. This compares with an increase of 5% in the corresponding usual residence census count for non-Indigenous Australians.

The increases in the census counts of Indigenous people were largest in the eastern States and the Australian Capital Territory.

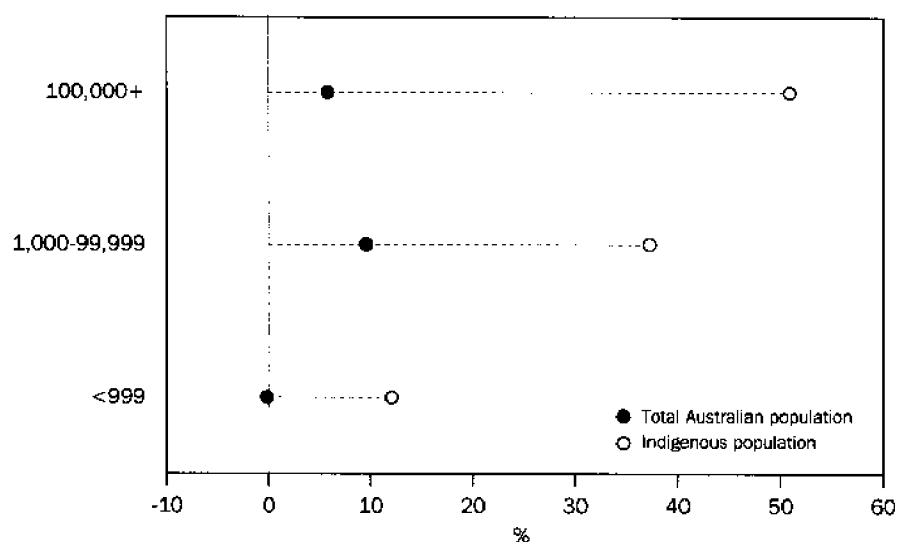

Regional populations

Increases in the counts of Indigenous people between 1991 and 1996 were greatest in metropolitan and large urban centres, where they averaged more than 50%. Increases were less marked in small rural centres (13% on average). In all areas average increases were much larger for counts of the Indigenous than total Australian population.

Regional populations *continued* This has had a marked impact on the apparent urban/rural Indigenous population distribution, with the proportion of the Indigenous count in rural areas declining from more than 32% in 1991 to less than 24% in 1996. This compares with a much smaller change for the total Australian population, from 14.8% to 14% over the same period.

The metropolitan and urban-based AREGs have generally had higher populations of Indigenous people than other AREGs. The changes between 1991 and 1996 have exaggerated this effect, with 9 of the more urban AREGs (Sydney, Coffs Harbour, Brisbane, Townsville, Cairns, Adelaide, Perth, Hobart, and Darwin) now accounting for almost half (48%) of the Indigenous population, (see table 6).

Category movement There are three main reasons why the increase in the Indigenous population between 1991 and 1996 is larger than that of the total population. These are:

- the higher fertility of Indigenous women;
- many children of Indigenous origin have one rather than two parents of Indigenous origin; and
- the occurrence of category movement, that is, different responses to the Indigenous origin question being recorded in successive censuses.

It is estimated that the first two of the above factors each account for about one-quarter of the excess increase in the size of the Indigenous compared with the total population between 1991 and 1996.

The remaining half of the increase is due to category movement, which reflects the combined results of greater willingness by Indigenous people to nominate their Indigenous origins at census time and more effective census collection by the ABS.

The importance of category movement varied among States and Territories. For example, the usual residence count for the Indigenous population of New South Wales increased by 45% between 1991 and 1996; the major part of this increase can be attributed to category movement. In contrast, in the Northern Territory, category movement has been a less significant, perhaps even a negligible factor in the 16% increase between 1991 and 1996. Most of the increase in the Northern Territory can be attributed to natural increase.

EXPLANATORY NOTES

CONSISTENCY OF RESPONSES TO INDIGENOUS ORIGIN QUESTIONS

1 As part of checking how many people were missed in the Census of Population and Housing a survey is conducted after the Census. This is the Post-Enumeration Survey (PES).

2 The 1996 PES was not conducted in remote Aboriginal communities. However, some Indigenous people are included in the PES, as Indigenous households in urban areas have the same chance as other households to be in the PES. Table E1 compares the responses of people in the PES to the Indigenous origin question in both the PES and the Census. Most people in the PES (98%) answered the Indigenous origin questions in the PES and the Census in the same way. However, of the 1,360 PES respondents who reported Indigenous origin in the PES, 115 (8%) had not reported Indigenous origin in the Census. Conversely, 237 (16%) people who said they were non-Indigenous in the PES had said they were Indigenous in the Census. Despite inconsistency on the part of some individuals, however, the proportion of PES respondents who identified themselves as Indigenous in the PES (1.8% of those who gave a response) was similar to the proportion of PES respondents who had identified themselves as Indigenous in the Census (1.7% of those responding). The information in table E1 should be treated with caution as the relatively small sample size makes interpretation difficult and the PES was not conducted in remote areas. Furthermore, the different collection methods of the Census (generally self-enumeration) and PES (personal interview) may also have had an effect.

ERP METHODOLOGY

Method of estimation

3 ERP figures are the official population figures. They are produced by modifying the usual resident census count by a number of adjustments. A summary of these adjustments as they apply to the Indigenous population for a State or Territory is presented in table E2. The process for estimating the population beyond the census date involves the same adjustments as for the adjustment from 6 August 1996 back to 30 June 1996.

- Non-response to Indigenous status **4** It is assumed that some people who do not answer the Indigenous status question are actually of Indigenous origin. Non-respondents were therefore allocated to being of Indigenous origin according to the ratio of the Indigenous response to the total stated responses of the population. This allocation was made separately for males and females for each SLA.
- Net census undercount **5** At each census, some people are counted twice and some people are missed. More people are missed than double-counted. The proportion of the population overall that is missed from the Census is called the net undercount. The net undercount for the total population is estimated by comparing census results for some households with the results from the survey held three weeks after the Census.
- 6** The 1996 PES was not designed to produce a separate estimate of the undercount for the Indigenous population. Thus, the census counts of the Indigenous population were adjusted by 1.7% which is the net undercount rate for the total population.
- Mis-statement of age **7** The Indigenous population aged 'zero' (i.e. infants less than 1 year old) for some States reported in the Census was lower than the corresponding births during the financial year 1995-96. Adjustments were made to correct for this discrepancy.

EXPLANATORY NOTES *continued*

Category movement and population projection **8** Category movement between 'Indigenous' and 'non-Indigenous' is not taken into account in the estimation procedure for any one point in time. It appears that more people have moved into the 'Indigenous' category than moved out of that category from the 1991 to 1996 Census. Population estimates and projections produced after the 1991 Census did not take category movement into account. Thus the current estimates, based on 1996 Census data are different to the previously published 1996 estimates based on 1991 Census data. Table E3 shows 1991-based and 1996-based estimates for 1996. The difference between 1991-base and 1996-base is 16.6%, almost all of which can be attributed to net movement into the 'Indigenous' category between 1991 and 1996.

Births and deaths **9** High quality births and deaths data are not yet available for Indigenous people in all States and Territories. As a result, other sources of births and deaths information are used in estimating the Indigenous population. Deaths information was based on age-specific death rates (Gray 1990; Gray & Tesfaghiorghis 1993). Births information was based on life tables.

Migration **10** There are two types of migration data used in producing population estimates — interstate and overseas. Rates of migration interstate and overseas for Indigenous people are very small. It is assumed in these estimates that there is nil net migration of Indigenous people between States and Territories and between Australia and overseas.

EXPLANATORY NOTES *continued*

- Comparison of current and previous methods **11** Indigenous population estimates have been published twice before by the ABS (1994, 1996a). Previous estimation methodologies have also adjusted the number of males to account for a lower than expected number of Indigenous young adult males compared with females counted at the Census. This adjustment was not made for the 1996 estimates.
- Other Territories **12** Estimates for Jervis Bay Territory are included in the estimates for Australia. The 21 people counted as Indigenous in the 1996 Census, who were usually resident in Cocos (Keeling) and Christmas Islands, are excluded from these estimates.
- Revisions **13** These estimates are experimental and subject to revision following further analysis of census data. In 1998, new Indigenous ERP estimates will be available by AREG and States and Territories based on updated life tables.
- Census characteristics data **14** Information about census characteristics, for example labour force status and educational attainment, are not adjusted for underenumeration or the other factors discussed above. Thus, users should be careful when using census characteristics and ERP together. Table E4 allows users to compare the unadjusted Census usual residence count with the ERP.

DATA PRESENTATION CONSIDERATIONS

- Random adjustment **15** Table cells containing small values are randomly adjusted or suppressed to avoid releasing information about particular individuals, families, or households. The effects of these adjustments are statistically insignificant, but can result in components not adding to totals.
- Rounding **16** On occasions, there are apparent discrepancies in tables between percentages and the numbers from which they are derived. This can be caused by rounding.
