## TOURIST ACCOMMODATION, NEW SOUTH WALES SEPTEMBER QUARTER 1994

### MAIN FEATURES

SEPTEMBER QUARTER 1994  
COMPARED WITH  
SEPTEMBER QUARTER 1993

#### HOTELS, MOTELS AND GUEST HOUSES

- Rooms available decreased by 0.8 per cent from 57,357 to 56,891 while bed spaces decreased slightly from 165,569 to 165,191.
- Room nights occupied increased by 7.4 per cent from 2,784,747 to 2,990,687 overall, ranging from the largest increases of 11.4 per cent for Sydney Statistical Division and 10.8 per cent for the South Eastern Statistical Division through to a decrease for Murray Statistical Division of 3.5 per cent.
- The room occupancy rate overall rose from 52.8 per cent to 57.2 per cent, with Sydney Statistical Division recording an 8.1 percentage point increase to 65.0 per cent.
- Guest nights increased by 8.9 per cent from 4,937,612 to 5,379,099 and the bed occupancy rate increased from 32.4 per cent to 35.4 per cent.
- Guest arrivals increased by 7.6 per cent from 2,728,390 to 2,937,077 while the average length of stay remained stable at 1.8 days overall, ranging from 2.3 days for star grade 5 establishments to 1.7 days for star grade 2 and 3 establishments.
- Takings from accommodation increased by 13.8 per cent from \$229.5m to \$261.0m and average takings per room night occupied increased from \$82 to \$87.

#### HOLIDAY FLATS, UNITS AND HOUSES

- The number of units, etc. available for short-term letting increased by 0.9 per cent from 10,325 to 10,423 while unit nights occupied increased by 5.5 per cent from 362,430 to 382,250.
- The unit occupancy rate increased from 38.2 per cent to 40.0 per cent.
- Unit lettings increased by 11.2 per cent from 62,109 to 69,042 while the average length of stay decreased from 5.8 days to 5.5 days.
- Accommodation takings increased by 6.6 per cent from \$20.2m to \$21.6m while the average takings per unit night occupied remained at \$56.

#### CARAVAN PARKS

- Capacity available decreased by 0.6 per cent from 95,684 to 95,095 powered and unpowered sites and cabins, etc.
- Long-term residents occupied 15,703 sites (16.5 per cent), while 23,128 sites (24.3 per cent) were permanently reserved but only casually occupied by their tenants and an average of 9,078 sites (9.5 per cent) were occupied by other short-term guests.
- Site nights occupied increased by 1.3 per cent from 4,350,441 to 4,407,654 and the site occupancy rate rose by 1.0 percentage points to 50.4 per cent.
- Takings from accommodation rose by 4.3 per cent from \$36.6m to \$38.1m with the average takings per site night occupied rising from \$8 to \$9.


#### VISITOR HOSTELS

- Bed spaces available increased by 10.8 per cent from 4,825 to 5,346 while guest nights increased by 18.2 per cent from 205,389 to 242,739.
- The bed occupancy rate rose from 46.3 per cent to 49.4 per cent.
- Guest arrivals increased from 60,120 to 68,327 while the average length of stay rose from 3.4 days to 3.6 days.
- Accommodation takings increased by 23.5 per cent from \$2.5m to \$3.1m at an average tariff of \$13 per guest night.



NEW SOUTH WALES**




**MONTHLY OCCUPANCY RATES,

## EXPLANATORY NOTES

---

**INTRODUCTION**

**1** This publication contains data for New South Wales from a quarterly survey of tourist accommodation establishments. The period covered by the latest survey is the 3 months ended 30 September 1994.

**SCOPE**

**2** Tourist accommodation establishments currently included in the survey comprise two groups:

- Establishments which provide predominantly short-term accommodation (i.e. for periods of less than 2 months) to the general public. These include:

*Hotels, motels and guest houses, with facilities* being hotels licensed to operate a public bar and motels, private hotels and guest houses all of which provide a bath (or shower) and toilet in most guest rooms and have breakfast available for guests.

NOTE: From December quarter 1993, hotel, motel and guest house establishments with fewer than five rooms have been formally excluded from the scope of this statistical collection. This change in scope resulted in the exclusion of 20 establishments which in the September quarter 1993 Survey aggregates for New South Wales represented 1.1 per cent of hotel, motel and guest house establishments but accounted for only 0.1 per cent of accommodation capacity, occupancy and takings.

*Holiday flats, units and houses* (excluding establishments predominantly operated on a time share basis) which are operated by owners or managers who have sole letting rights to at least five flats, units or houses or by real estate agents for short-term letting. They are mainly self-contained in terms of cooking, bath (or shower) and toilet facilities and do not have breakfast available for guests. Data for holiday flats, units and houses include short-term owner occupation as well as paying guest occupation.

*Visitor hostels* which provide accommodation to visitors on a bed basis (rather than by the room). This category does not include establishments providing charity type accommodation (e.g. Salvation Army hostels) nor hotels, motels and guest houses without in-room facilities which provide accommodation on a per room basis.

- *Caravan parks* which provide either predominantly short-term (i.e. for periods of less than 2 months) or predominantly long-term (i.e. for periods of 2 months or more) accommodation to the general public and which provide powered sites for caravans and toilet, shower and laundry facilities for guests.

**3** Data collected and published for each type of establishment (other than holiday flats, units and houses) include both long-term and short-term guests at these establishments.

**4** Establishments which provide more than one type of accommodation (e.g. a motel with attached caravan park) are treated as two or more separate establishments. However, self-contained units, flats, cabins, etc. attached to hotels, motels or to caravan parks are included in the capacity for those establishments and not treated as separate holiday flat, unit or house establishments.

**DEFINITIONS**

**5** *Number of establishments.* For hotels, motels and guest houses, caravan parks and visitor hostels, the number of establishments within the scope of the survey which operated for any part of the survey period, or which closed temporarily for the quarter for seasonal reasons.

**6** *Number of letting entities.* For holiday flats, units and houses, the number of owners, managers or real estate agents within the scope of the survey who operated for any part of the survey period.

**7** Capacity in terms of *Guest rooms, Bed spaces, Holiday units or Caravan park sites, etc.* is the maximum number available to accommodate paying guests during the survey period. Capacity closed temporarily for seasonal reasons is included.

**8** *Bed spaces.* Three-quarter beds are counted as one bed space; double beds as two bed spaces. Cots are excluded.

**9** *Total caravan park capacity* comprises *On-site vans, Other powered sites, Unpowered sites and Cabins, etc.*

## EXPLANATORY NOTES —continued

### DEFINITIONS —continued

**10 Room nights available.** The number of guest rooms available multiplied by the number of days for which they were available during the survey period. Includes operating periods only for establishments closing (other than for seasonal reasons) or opening during the survey period.

**11 Occupancy** in terms of *Room nights*, *Unit nights* or *Site nights occupied* refers to the total number of nights each guest room, holiday unit or caravan park site, etc. was occupied during the survey period.

NOTE: From September quarter 1992, caravan park sites, etc. permanently reserved for 2 months or more at the end of the survey period but only casually occupied by their tenants have been recorded continuously as *Site nights occupied* irrespective of whether the tenants of individual sites were in residence on any particular night. (See also paragraph 14 below). Previously, usage of these sites was recorded as *Site nights occupied* only when their tenants were in the park. Total site occupancy rates from September quarter 1992 are therefore not comparable with those from previous quarters.

**12 Occupancy** in terms of *Guest nights* refers to the total number of nights each paying guest stayed during the survey period.

**13 Sites occupied by long-term guests.** The total number of sites, etc. occupied at the end of the survey period by guests who have stayed continuously for 2 months or more.

**14 Other sites permanently reserved.** The total number of powered and unpowered sites, on-site vans and cabins, etc. continuously let for 2 months or more by the end of the survey period to tenants who occupy the sites only on a casual or sporadic basis. Separate data for this item are available only from September quarter 1992.

**15 Occupancy rates** represent occupancy expressed as a percentage of total capacity available during the survey period — e.g.

*Room occupancy rate (%)* for the period =

*Room nights occupied*

*(Guest rooms)* × *(No. of days in the period)* × 100

providing that, for establishments closing (other than for seasonal reasons) or opening during the period, the denominator of the above expression includes only operating periods.

**16 Guest arrivals.** The total number of paying guests counted only on the first night they stayed at the accommodation establishment.

**17 Unit lettings.** The total number of times a holiday flat, unit or house was occupied by a new tenant, counted only on the first night it was occupied by the new tenant.

**18 Average length of stay** is expressed in number of days and is calculated:

- for hotels, motels and guest houses and for visitor hostels, by dividing *Guest nights* by *Guest arrivals* and
- for holiday flats, units and houses, by dividing *Unit nights occupied* by *Unit lettings*.

**19 Takings from accommodation.** Revenue received from the provision of accommodation. Takings from meals are excluded. Takings from accommodation for each month generally represent the takings received during that month. Where payments are received in advance of, or after, the provision of accommodation to guests, the monthly figure for takings from accommodation may not necessarily bear a direct relationship to the number of guests accommodated during the month. Rental and storage fees paid to caravan parks for the keeping of private vans in parks are included in the takings of the month they are received.

**20 Star grading.** The grading of hotels and motels with facilities based on the classification system used by members of the Australian Automobile Association (AAA). The gradings are allocated according to a points system based on the amenities and facilities available to guests. Details of the grading scheme are contained in the RACV-RAASA members' publication *Accommodation Australia*, or the individual tour guides produced by members of the AAA. For the purpose of classifying establishments to a star

grading in this publication, 'half' star gradings are ignored (e.g. a two and a half star grading has been shown as two star).

**AUSTRALIAN STANDARD GEOGRAPHICAL CLASSIFICATION**

**21 Employment.** The number of persons working at accommodation establishments at the end of the survey period (including working proprietors and those working on other than accommodation activities).

**22.** Statistics presented in this publication have been classified according to the Australian Standard Geographical Classification (ASGC), Edition 2.4. This classification incorporates a number of hierarchic structures of geographic areas. The appropriate spatial units of the main structure of the ASGC used in this publication are defined as follows.

*Statistical Local Areas (SLAs)* are in most cases either identical with, or have been aggregated to, the previously published whole or part legal Local Government Areas (LGAs) as defined under the (State) *Local Government Act 1919* and comprising cities (C) and, from 1 July 1994, areas (A) to replace previous municipalities (M) and shires (S). In other cases, they are identical to each previously published unincorporated area. In aggregate, SLAs cover the whole of the State without gaps or overlaps. In some cases, legal LGAs overlap Statistical Subdivision boundaries and therefore comprise two SLAs (Part A and Part B) or three SLAs in the case of Cabonne (A) (Part A, Part B and Part C).

*Statistical Subdivisions (SSDs)*. These consist of one or more SLAs and form the intermediate size spatial unit for the presentation of regional data.

*Statistical Divisions (SDs)*. These consist of one or more SSDs. The divisions are designed to be relatively homogeneous regions characterised by identifiable social and economic units within the region, under the unifying influence of one or more major towns or cities.

**23** The ABS may make available on request certain unpublished tourist accommodation statistics. In particular, small geographic area and other tabulations are available for various accommodation types in a time series format. A charge may be made for this information.


