MAIN FEATURES

MARCH QUARTER 1995
COMPARED WITH
MARCH QUARTER 1994

HOTELS, MOTELS AND GUEST HOUSES

- Rooms available decreased by 0.1 per cent from 29,988 to 29,971 and bed spaces decreased by 0.1 per cent to 82,580.
- Room nights occupied increased by 9.8 per cent to 1,506,936 and the room occupancy rate increased from 50.9 per cent to 55.9 per cent.
- By star grading, the highest room occupancy rate at 77.1 per cent was achieved by five star rated establishments compared with rates of 72.5 per cent for four star establishments and 54.2 per cent for three star establishments.
- Guest nights increased by 8.8 per cent to 2,549,140 and the bed occupancy rate increased from 31.5 per cent to 34.3 per cent.
- Guest arrivals at hotels, motels and guest houses increased by 7.6 per cent to 1,349,998 while the average length of stay was unchanged at 1.9 days.
- Takings from accommodation increased by 14.2 per cent from \$115.5m to \$131.9m while average takings per room night occupied increased from \$84 to \$88.

HOLIDAY FLATS, UNITS AND HOUSES

- The number of units, etc. available for short-term letting increased by 4.8 per cent from 3,571 to 3,744 while unit nights occupied increased by 12.3 per cent to 173,125.
- The unit occupancy rate increased from 49.0 per cent to 51.4 per cent.
- Unit lettings increased from 36,560 to 36,690 while the average length of stay increased from 4.2 days to 4.7 days.
- Accommodation takings increased by 20.6 per cent from \$11.4m to \$13.7m and average takings per unit night occupied increased from \$74 to \$79.

CARAVAN PARKS

- Capacity available decreased by 0.8 per cent from 67,647 to 67,118 powered and unpowered sites and cabins, etc. while site nights occupied increased by 1.4 per cent to 2,822,474.
- The site occupancy rate rose by 1.0 percentage point to 46.7 per cent.
- Long-term residents occupied 6,517 sites, etc. (9.7 per cent), while 15,733 sites (23.4 per cent) were permanently reserved but only casually occupied by their tenants and an average of 9,111 sites (13.6 per cent) were occupied by other short-term guests.
- Accommodation takings increased by 3.3 per cent from \$23.3m to \$24.1m with average takings per site night occupied increasing from \$8 to \$9.

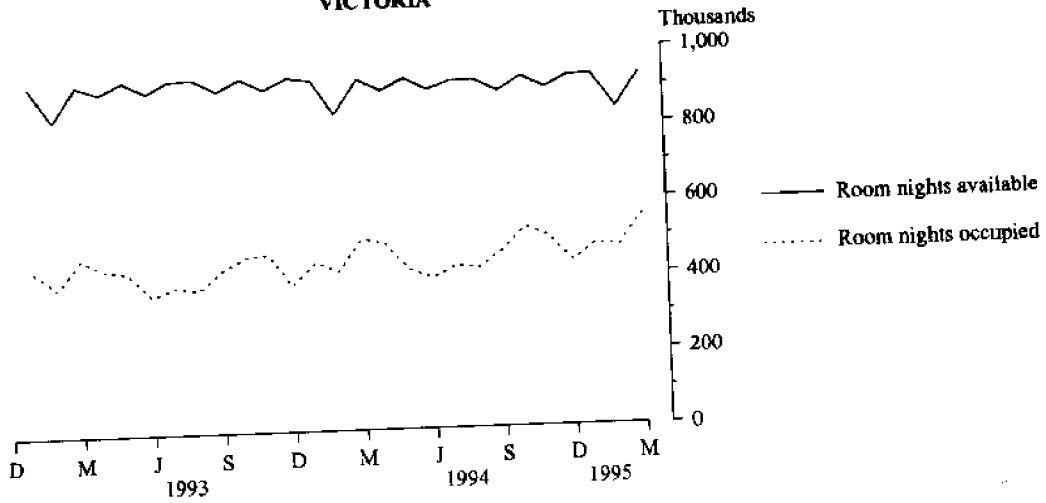
VISITOR HOSTELS

- Bed spaces available increased by 9.1 per cent from 2,789 to 3,043.
- Guest nights occupied rose by 10.0 per cent to 129,425 and the bed occupancy rate increased from 46.9 per cent to 47.3 per cent.
- Guest arrivals increased from 47,108 to 53,025 while the average length of stay decreased from 2.5 days to 2.4 days.
- Accommodation takings rose by 10.6 per cent from \$1.5m to \$1.7m while average takings per guest night were unchanged at \$13.

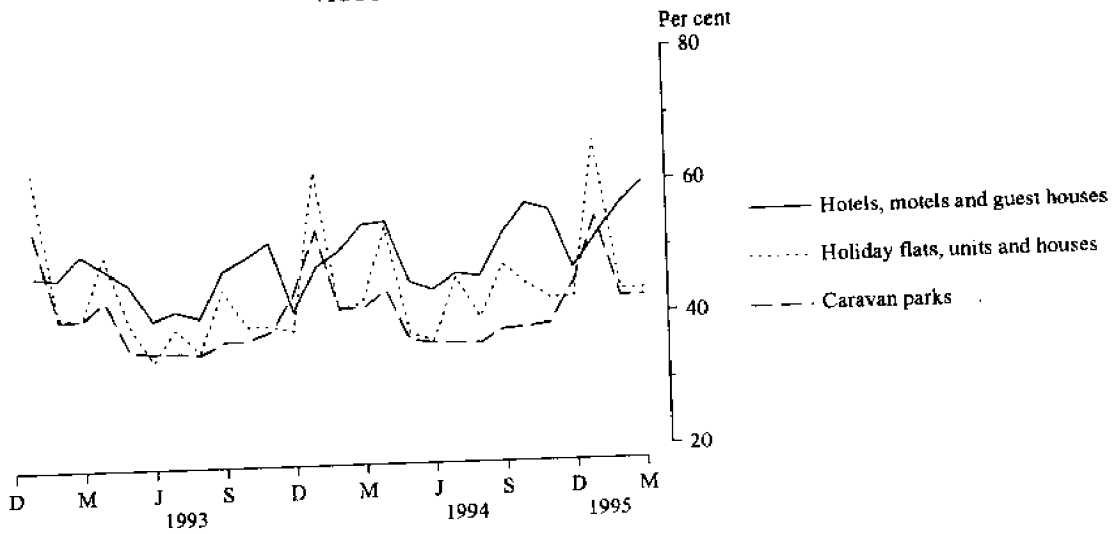

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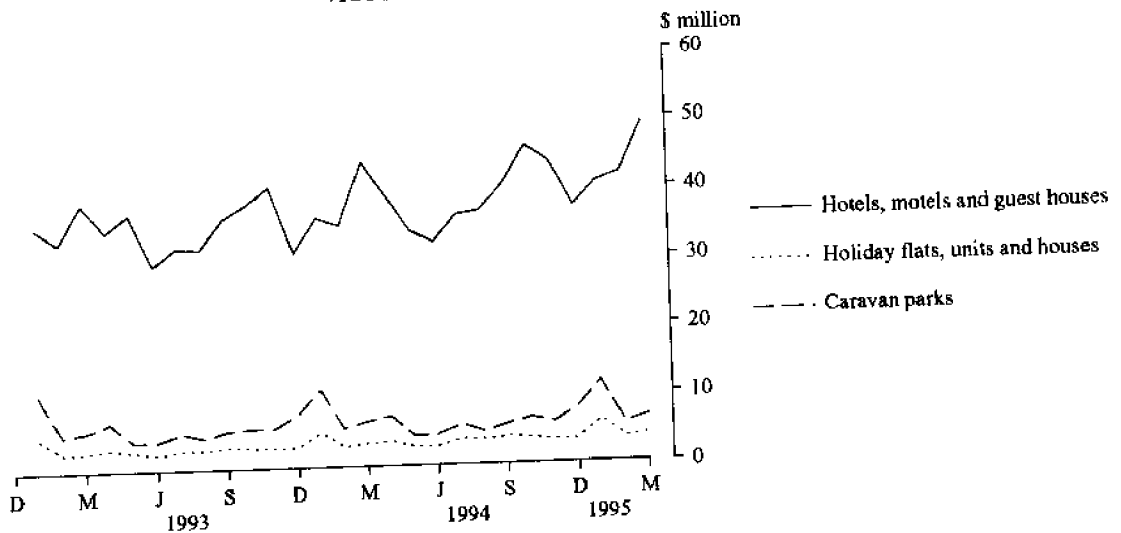
**MONTHLY ROOM NIGHTS AVAILABLE AND OCCUPIED:

EXPLANATORY NOTES

- *****
- INTRODUCTION** **1** This publication contains data for Victoria from a quarterly survey of tourist accommodation establishments. The period covered by the latest survey is the 3 months ended 31 March 1995.
- SCOPE** **2** Tourist accommodation establishments currently included in the survey comprise two groups:
- Establishments which provide predominantly short-term accommodation (i.e. for periods of less than 2 months) to the general public. These include:
 - Hotels, motels and guest houses, with facilities* being hotels licensed to operate a public bar and motels, private hotels and guest houses all of which provide a bath (or shower) and toilet in most guest rooms and have breakfast available for guests.
 - NOTE: From December quarter 1993, hotel, motel and guest house establishments with fewer than five rooms have been formally excluded from the scope of this statistical collection. This change in scope resulted in the exclusion of 23 establishments which in the September quarter 1993 Survey aggregates for Victoria represented 2.2 per cent of hotel, motel and guest house establishments but accounted for only 0.2 per cent of accommodation capacity and less than 0.1 per cent of occupancy and takings.
 - Holiday flats, units and houses* (excluding establishments predominantly operated on a time share basis) which are operated by owners or managers who have sole letting rights to at least five flats, units or houses or by real estate agents for short-term letting. They are mainly self-contained in terms of cooking, bath (or shower) and toilet facilities and do not have breakfast available for guests. Data for holiday flats, units and houses include short-term owner occupation as well as paying guest occupation.
 - Visitor hostels* which provide accommodation to visitors on a bed basis (rather than by the room). This category does not include establishments providing charity type accommodation (e.g. Salvation Army hostels) nor hotels, motels and guest houses without in-room facilities which provide accommodation on a per room basis.
 - *Caravan parks* which provide either predominantly short-term (i.e. for periods of less than 2 months) or predominantly long-term (i.e. for periods of 2 months or more) accommodation to the general public and which provide powered sites for caravans and toilet, shower and laundry facilities for guests.
- 3** Data collected and published for each type of establishment (other than holiday flats, units and houses) include both long-term and short-term guests at these establishments.
- 4** Establishments which provide more than one type of accommodation (e.g. a motel with attached caravan park) are treated as two or more separate establishments. However, self-contained units, flats, cabins, etc. attached to hotels, motels or to caravan parks are included in the capacity for those establishments and not treated as separate holiday flat, unit or house establishments.
- DEFINITIONS**
- 5** *Number of establishments.* For hotels, motels and guest houses, caravan parks and visitor hostels, the number of establishments within the scope of the survey which operated for any part of the survey period, or which closed temporarily for the quarter for seasonal reasons.
- 6** *Number of letting entities.* For holiday flats, units and houses, the number of owners, managers or real estate agents within the scope of the survey who operated for any part of the survey period.
- 7** Capacity in terms of *Guest rooms, Bed spaces, Holiday units* or *Caravan park sites, etc.* is the maximum number available to accommodate paying guests during the survey period. Capacity closed temporarily for seasonal reasons is included.
- 8** *Bed spaces.* Three-quarter beds are counted as one bed space; double beds as two bed spaces. Cots are excluded.

9 *Total caravan park capacity* comprises *On-site vans*, *Other powered sites*, *Unpowered sites* and *Cabins*, etc.

10 *Room nights available*. The number of guest rooms available multiplied by the number of days for which they were available during the survey period. Includes operating periods only for establishments closing (other than for seasonal reasons) or opening during the survey period.

11 Occupancy in terms of *Room nights*, *Unit nights* or *Site nights occupied* refers to the total number of nights each guest room, holiday unit or caravan park site, etc. was occupied during the survey period.

NOTE: From September quarter 1988, caravan park sites, etc. permanently reserved for 2 months or more at the end of the survey period but only casually occupied by their tenants have been recorded continuously as *Site nights occupied* irrespective of whether the tenants of individual sites were in residence on any particular night. (See also paragraph 14 below). Previously, usage of these sites was recorded as *Site nights occupied* only when their tenants were in the park. Total site occupancy rates from September quarter 1988 are therefore not comparable with those from previous quarters.

12 Occupancy in terms of *Guest nights* refers to the total number of nights each paying guest stayed during the survey period.

13 *Sites occupied by long-term guests*. The total number of sites, etc. occupied at the end of the survey period by guests who have stayed continuously for 2 months or more.

14 *Other sites permanently reserved*. The total number of powered and unpowered sites, on-site vans and cabins, etc. continuously let for 2 months or more by the end of the survey period to tenants who occupy the sites only on a casual or sporadic basis. Separate data for this item are available only from September quarter 1992.

15 *Occupancy rates* represent occupancy expressed as a percentage of total capacity available during the survey period—e.g.

$$\text{Room occupancy rate (\% for the period)} = \frac{\text{Room nights occupied}}{(\text{Guest rooms}) \times (\text{No. of days in the period})} \times 100$$

providing that, for establishments closing (other than for seasonal reasons) or opening during the period, the denominator of the above expression includes only operating periods.

16 *Guest arrivals*. The total number of paying guests counted only on the first night they stayed at the accommodation establishment.

17 *Unit lettings*. The total number of times a holiday flat, unit or house was occupied by a new tenant, counted only on the first night it was occupied by the new tenant.

18 *Average length of stay* is expressed in number of days and calculated:

- for hotels, motels and guest houses and for visitor hostels, by dividing *Guest nights* by *Guest arrivals* and
- for holiday flats, units and houses, by dividing *Unit nights occupied* by *Unit lettings*.

19 *Takings from accommodation*. Revenue received from the provision of accommodation. Takings from meals are excluded. Takings from accommodation for each month generally represent the takings received during that month. Where payments are received in advance of, or after, the provision of accommodation to guests, the monthly figure for takings from accommodation may not necessarily bear a direct relationship to the number of guests accommodated during the month. Rental and storage fees paid to caravan parks for the keeping of private vans in parks are included in the takings of the month they are received.

EXPLANATORY NOTES—continued

DEFINITIONS --continued

20 *Star grading.* The grading of hotels and motels with facilities based on the classification system used by members of the Australian Automobile Association (AAA). The gradings are allocated according to a points system based on the amenities and facilities available to guests. Details of the grading scheme are contained in the RACV-RAASA members' publication *Accommodation Australia*, or the individual tour guides produced by members of the AAA. For the purpose of classifying establishments to a star grading in this publication, 'half' star gradings are ignored (e.g. a two and a half star grading has been shown as two star).

21 *Employment.* The number of persons working at accommodation establishments at the end of the survey period (including working proprietors and those working on other than accommodation activities).

GEOGRAPHICAL
CLASSIFICATION

22 Statistics presented in this publication have been classified according to the Australian Standard Geographical Classification (ASGC), Edition 2.4. This classification incorporates a number of hierarchic structures of geographic areas. The appropriate spatial units of the main structure of the ASGC used in this publication are defined as follows.

Statistical Local Areas (SLAs) are in most cases either identical with, or have been aggregated to, the previously published whole or part legal Local Government Areas (LGAs) comprising boroughs (B), cities (C), municipalities (M), rural cities (RC), shires (S) and towns (T). In aggregate, SLAs cover the whole of the State without gaps or overlaps. In some cases, legal LGAs overlap Statistical Division or Subdivision boundaries and therefore comprise two SLAs (e.g. Part A and Part B).

Statistical Subdivisions (SSDs). These consist of one or more SLAs and form the intermediate size spatial unit for the presentation of regional data.

Statistical Divisions (SDs). These consist of one or more SSDs. Where SSDs are not shown for statistical purposes, statistical local areas are shown ordered alphabetically within statistical divisions. The Divisions are designed to be relatively homogeneous regions characterised by identifiable social and economic units within the region, under the unifying influence of one or more major towns or cities.

Statistical Districts. To provide comparable statistics over a period of time, Statistical Districts have been defined around selected urban centres, with a population of 25,000 or more, experiencing urban growth beyond the legal local government area boundaries. Those districts are intended to contain the anticipated urban spread over the next 20 years.

NOTE: As from 1 July 1994, substantial changes have been made to Local Government Area boundaries in the Statistical Divisions of Barwon, Central Highlands and Loddon-Campaspe respectively. While the geographic boundaries of the Statistical Divisions are unchanged, the changes as they affect Statistical Subdivisions, Local Government Areas and Statistical Local Areas are substantial and are detailed on pages 30 to 31.

The Australian Standard Geographical Classification (ASGC) Edition 2.4, effective from 1 July 1994, reflects substantial changes made to Local Government Area (LGA) boundaries in the Statistical Divisions of Barwon, Central Highlands and Loddon-Campaspe respectively. The changes include amalgamations, boundary changes and creations of new LGAs. While the geographic boundaries of the Statistical Divisions are unchanged, the changes as they affect Statistical Subdivisions, Local Government Areas and Statistical Local Areas are detailed below.

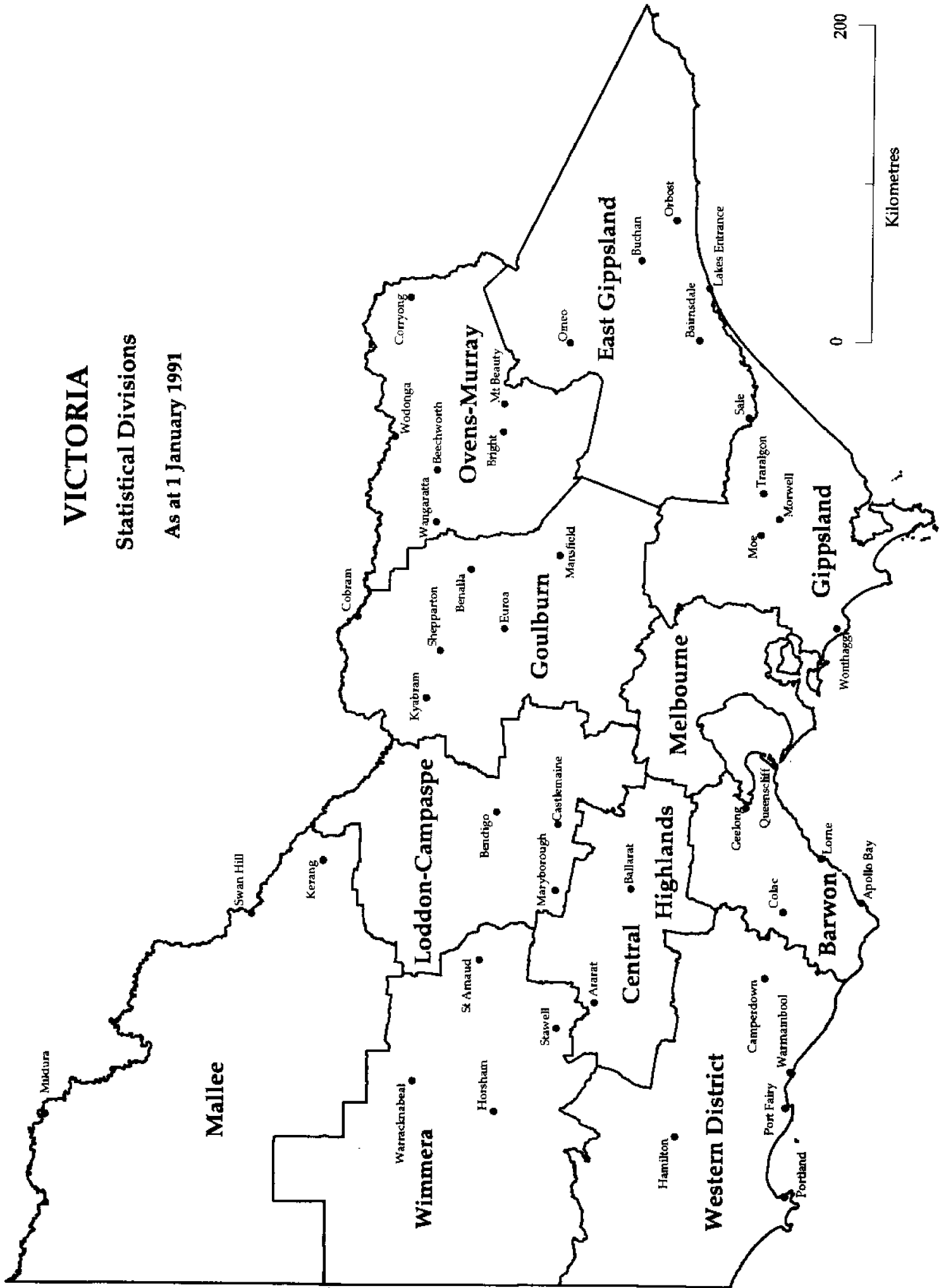

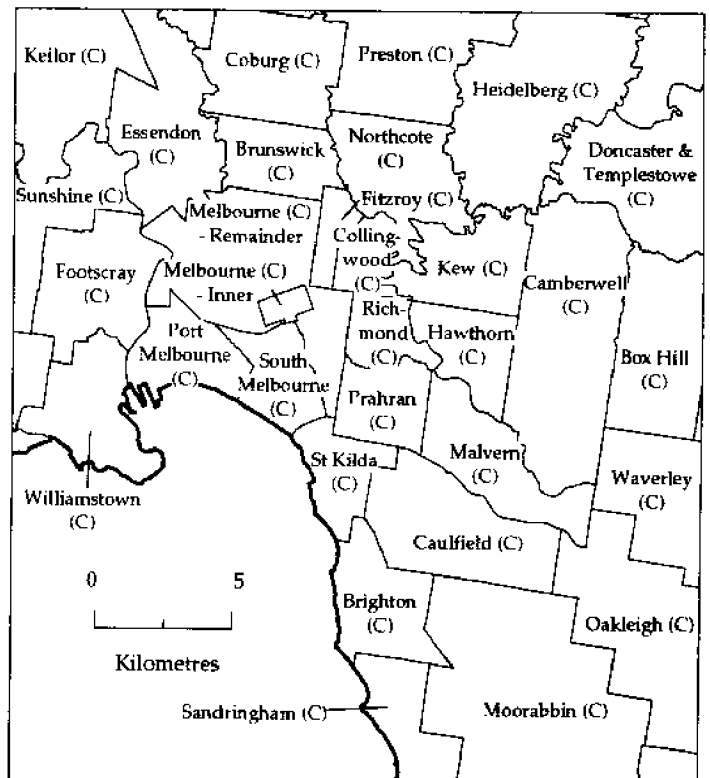
