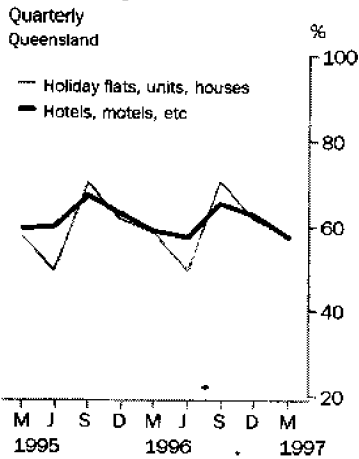

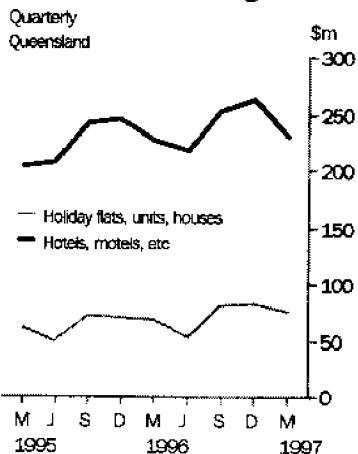

MARCH QTR KEY POINTS

MIXED RESULTS IN OCCUPANCY RATES

- Demand in terms of room nights occupied in hotels, motels and guest houses increased by 0.8% while the number of rooms available increased by 4.2% in March quarter 1997 compared with March quarter 1996. The room occupancy rate therefore fell by 1.4 percentage points to 57.3%. Similarly, for holiday flats, units and houses, unit nights occupied rose by 2.8% while supply increased by 6.0%, resulting in a 1.2 percentage point fall in the occupancy rate to 57.3%.
- In contrast, a 15.3% increase in bed spaces available in visitor hostels (typically backpacker establishments) was matched by increased demand and the bed occupancy rate at 48.0% was almost unchanged. For caravan parks, both capacity available and the site occupancy rate at 41.0% were almost unchanged.

TAKINGS FROM ACCOMMODATION

- Takings from accommodation increased in aggregate for each establishment type in March quarter 1997 compared with March quarter 1996. Average takings were unchanged at \$100 per room night occupied in hotels, motels and guest houses and at \$13 per guest night in visitor hostels. Average takings rose, however, from \$69 to \$74 per night occupied in holiday flats, units and houses and from \$11 to \$12 per caravan park site night.

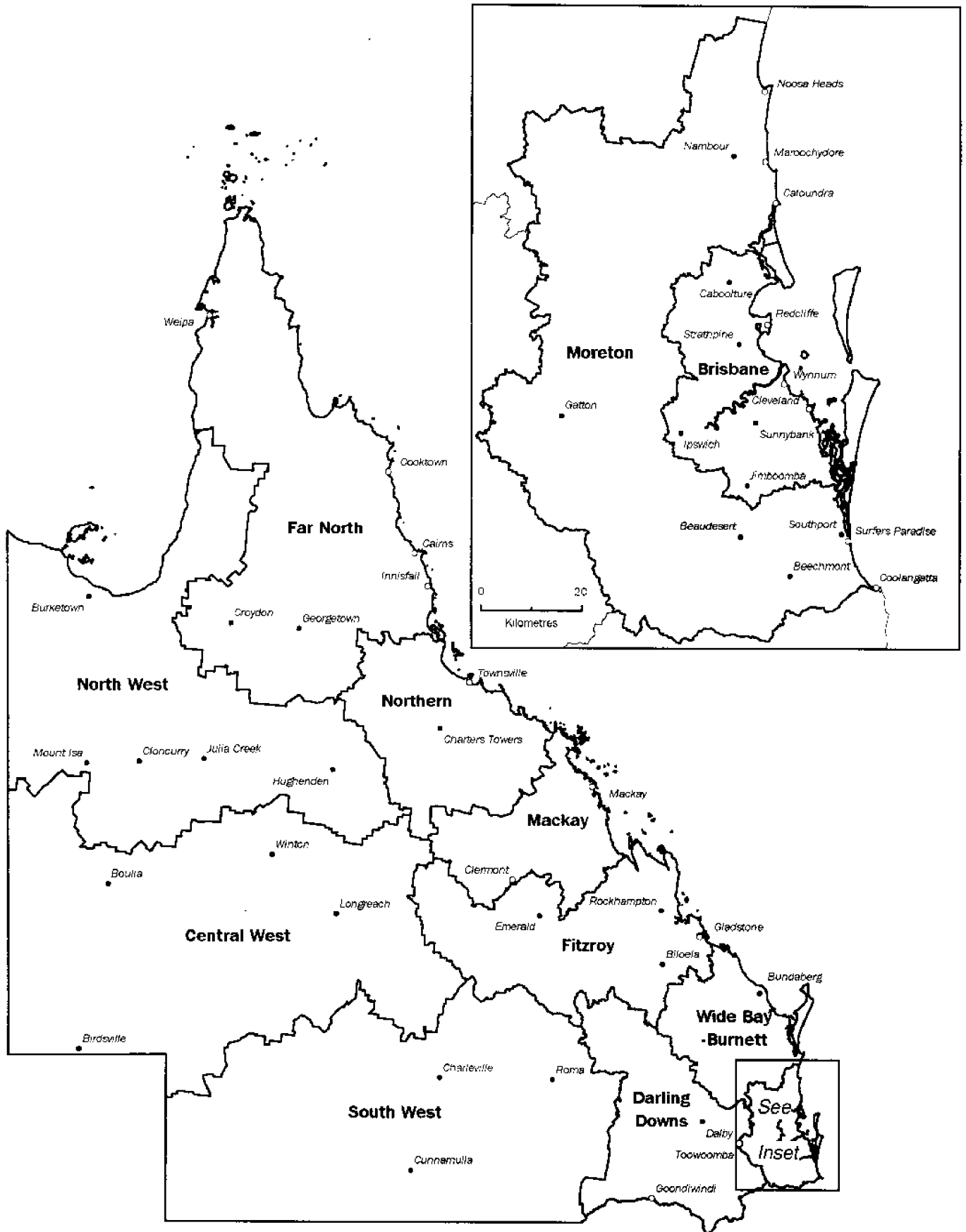

EXPLANATORY NOTES

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INTRODUCTION

1 This publication contains data for Queensland from a quarterly survey of tourist accommodation establishments.

SCOPE

2 Tourist accommodation establishments currently included in the survey comprise two groups:

- Establishments which provide predominantly short-term accommodation (i.e. for periods of less than 2 months) to the general public. These include:
 - *Hotels, motels and guest houses, with facilities* being hotels licensed to operate a public bar and motels, private hotels and guest houses all of which provide a bath (or shower) and toilet in most guest rooms and have breakfast available for guests. NOTE: From December quarter 1993, hotel, motel and guest house establishments with fewer than five rooms have been formally excluded from the scope of this statistical collection.
 - *Holiday flats, units and houses* (excluding establishments predominantly operated on a time share basis) which are operated by owners, managers or real estate agents who have sole letting rights to at least five flats, units or houses for short-term letting. They are mainly self-contained in terms of cooking, bath (or shower) and toilet facilities and do not have breakfast available for guests. Data for holiday flats, units and houses include short-term owner occupation as well as paying guest occupation.
 - *Visitor hostels* which provide accommodation to visitors on a bed basis (rather than by the room). This category does not include establishments providing charity type accommodation (e.g. Salvation Army hostels) nor hotels, motels and guest houses without in-room facilities which provide accommodation on a per room basis.
 - *Caravan parks* which provide either predominantly short-term (i.e. for periods of less than 2 months) or predominantly long-term (i.e. for periods of 2 months or more) accommodation to the general public and which provide powered sites for caravans and toilet, shower and laundry facilities for guests.

3 Data collected and published for each type of establishment (other than holiday flats, units and houses) include both long-term and short-term guests at these establishments.

4 Establishments which provide more than one type of accommodation (e.g. a motel with attached caravan park) are treated as two or more separate establishments. However, self-contained units, flats, cabins, etc. attached to hotels, motels or to caravan parks are included in the capacity for those establishments and not treated as separate holiday flat, unit or house establishments.

AUSTRALIAN STANDARD GEOGRAPHICAL CLASSIFICATION

5 Statistics presented in this publication have been classified according to the Australian Standard Geographical Classification (ASGC), Edition 1996. This classification incorporates a number of hierarchic structures of geographic areas. The appropriate spatial units of the main structure of the ASGC used in this publication are defined as follows.

STATISTICAL LOCAL AREAS (SLAs) are the smallest types of spatial units in the ASGC for which tourist accommodation data are presented. They correspond either to legal Local Government Areas (LGAs) as defined under the Local Government Act 1936 or to suburbs in certain urban LGAs. Some LGAs are split into two or more parts, with each part forming a separate SLA. In all instances, LGA data can be derived by aggregating SLAs. The unincorporated area of Queensland also forms a SLA. In aggregate, SLAs cover the whole of the State without gaps or overlaps.

EXPLANATORY NOTES

AUSTRALIAN STANDARD
GEOGRAPHICAL CLASSIFICATION
continued

STATISTICAL SUBDIVISIONS (SSDs) consist of one or more SLAs and form the intermediate size spatial unit for the presentation of regional data.

STATISTICAL DIVISIONS (SDs) which consist of one or more SSDs are designed to be relatively homogeneous regions characterised by identifiable social and economic units within the region, under the unifying influence of one or more major towns or cities. The Brisbane Statistical Division comprises the Cities of Brisbane, Logan and Redcliffe and parts of the cities of Gold Coast and Ipswich, the Shires of Pine Rivers and Redland and parts of the Shires of Beaudesert and Caboolture.

STATISTICAL DISTRICTS have been defined around selected urban areas to provide comparable statistics over a period of time. These districts, which are intended to contain the anticipated urban spread for at least 20 years, are generally defined as having a population of 25,000 or more and experiencing urban growth beyond the LGA boundaries.

UNPUBLISHED STATISTICS

6 The ABS may make available on request certain unpublished tourist accommodation statistics. A charge may be made for this information.

GLOSSARY

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Other sites permanently reserved	The total number of powered and unpowered sites, on-site vans and cabins, etc. continuously let for 2 months or more by the end of the survey period to tenants who occupy the sites only on a casual or sporadic basis. Separate data for this item are available only from September quarter 1992.
Room nights available	The number of guest rooms available multiplied by the number of days for which they were available during the survey period. For establishments closing (other than for seasonal reasons) or opening during the survey period, operating periods are included.
Sites occupied by long-term guests	The total number of sites, etc. occupied at the end of the survey period by guests who have stayed continuously for 2 months or more.
Star grading	The grading of hotels and motels with facilities based on the classification system used by members of the Australian Automobile Association (AAA). The gradings are allocated according to a points system based on the amenities and facilities available to guests. Details of the grading scheme are contained in the RACV-RAASA members' publication <i>Accommodation Australia</i> , or the individual tour guides produced by members of the AAA. For the purpose of classifying establishments to a star grading in this publication, 'half' star gradings are ignored (e.g. a two and a half star grading has been shown as two star).
Takings from accommodation	Revenue received from the provision of accommodation. Takings from meals are excluded. Takings from accommodation for each month generally represent the takings received during that month. Where payments are received in advance of, or after, the provision of accommodation to guests, the monthly figure for takings from accommodation may not necessarily bear a direct relationship to the number of guests accommodated during the month. Rental and storage fees paid to caravan parks for the keeping of private vans in parks are included in the takings of the month they are received.
Unit lettings	The total number of times a holiday flat, unit or house was occupied by a new tenant, counted only on the first night it was occupied by the new tenant.
