

MAIN FEATURES

JUNE QUARTER 1994

COMPARED WITH

JUNE QUARTER 1993

HOTELS, MOTELS AND GUEST HOUSES

- Rooms available increased by 0.6 per cent from 39,965 to 40,211 and bed spaces increased by 0.9 per cent to 122,473.
- Room nights occupied increased by 6.1 per cent from 2,075,894 to 2,201,853 overall with licensed hotels recording an increase of 8.0 per cent and motels and guest houses an increase of 4.5 per cent.
- The room occupancy rate overall rose from 57.1 per cent to 60.2 per cent, with Cairns City, Brisbane City and Gold Coast City recording 72.4 per cent, 72.0 per cent and 65.1 per cent, respectively. For five star rated establishments, the room occupancy rate was 73.2 per cent compared with 66.2 per cent for four star rated establishments and 60.4 per cent for three star rated establishments.
- Guest nights increased by 6.6 per cent from 3,799,254 to 4,049,059 and the bed occupancy rate increased from 34.4 per cent to 36.3 per cent.
- Guest arrivals increased by 7.0 per cent from 1,619,290 to 1,732,664 while the average length of stay was unchanged at 2.3 days. For five star rated establishments, average length of stay decreased from 3.4 days to 3.2 days and, for four star rated establishments, decreased from 2.8 days to 2.6 days.
- Takings from accommodation increased by 13.8 per cent from \$167.3m to \$190.5m while average takings per room night occupied increased from \$81 to \$87.

HOLIDAY FLATS, UNITS AND HOUSES

- The number of units, etc. available for short-term letting increased by 5.5 per cent from 15,802 to 16,672 while unit nights occupied increased by 5.7 per cent from 726,634 to 767,957.
- The unit occupancy rate increased from 50.5 per cent to 50.7 per cent.
- Unit lettings increased by 9.0 per cent from 117,300 to 127,802 but average length of stay decreased from 6.2 days to 6.0 days.
- Accommodation takings increased by 11.9 per cent from \$38.2m to \$42.8m and the average takings per unit night occupied increased from \$53 to \$56.

CARAVAN PARKS

- Caravan park capacity available decreased by 0.6 per cent from 55,486 to 55,159 powered and unpowered sites and cabins, etc. of which 16,744 sites, etc. (30.4 per cent) were occupied by long-term residents, 1,211 sites (2.2 per cent) were permanently reserved but only casually occupied by their tenants and an average of 8,071 sites (14.6 per cent) were occupied by other short-term guests.
- Site nights occupied increased by 0.1 per cent from 2,365,309 to 2,368,394 and the site occupancy rate increased from 46.9 per cent to 47.3 per cent.
- Takings from accommodation rose by 3.8 per cent from \$23.7m to \$24.6m.


VISITOR HOSTELS

- Bed spaces available increased by 3.6 per cent from 7,548 to 7,822 while guest nights sold increased by 3.7 per cent from 329,278 to 341,404.
- The bed occupancy rate increased marginally from 47.9 per cent to 48.0 per cent.
- Guest arrivals increased by 1.9 per cent from 123,535 to 125,871 while average length of stay was unchanged at 2.7 days.
- Accommodation takings increased by 2.1 per cent from \$3.8m to \$3.9m with average takings per guest night at \$11.




**MONTHLY ROOM NIGHTS AVAILABLE AND OCCUPIED:

EXPLANATORY NOTES

***** INTRODUCTION	<p>1 This publication contains data for Queensland from a quarterly survey of tourist accommodation establishments. The period covered by the latest survey is the 3 months ended 30 June 1994.</p>
SCOPE	<p>2 Tourist accommodation establishments currently included in the survey comprise two groups:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Establishments which provide predominantly short-term accommodation (i.e. for periods of less than 2 months) to the general public. These include: <p style="padding-left: 20px;"><i>Hotels, motels and guest houses, with facilities</i> being hotels licensed to operate a public bar and motels, private hotels and guest houses, all of which provide a bath (or shower) and toilet in most guest rooms and have breakfast available for guests.</p> <p style="padding-left: 20px;">NOTE: From December quarter 1993, hotel, motel and guest house establishments with fewer than five rooms have been formally excluded from the scope of this statistical collection. This change in scope resulted in the exclusion of 21 establishments which in the September quarter 1993 Survey aggregates represented 1.9 per cent of hotel, motel and guest house establishments but accounted for only 0.2 per cent of accommodation capacity and less than 0.1 percent of occupancy and takings.</p> <p style="padding-left: 20px;"><i>Holiday flats, units and houses</i> (excluding establishments predominantly operated on a time share basis) which are operated by owners or managers who have sole letting rights to at least five flats, units or houses or by real estate agents for short-term letting. They are mainly self-contained in terms of cooking, bath (or shower) and toilet facilities and do not have breakfast available for guests. Data for holiday flats, units and houses include short-term owner occupation as well as paying guest occupation.</p> <p style="padding-left: 20px;"><i>Visitor hostels</i> which provide accommodation to visitors on a bed basis (rather than by the room). This category does not include establishments providing charity type accommodation (e.g. Salvation Army hostels) nor hotels, motels and guest houses without in-room facilities which provide accommodation on a per room basis.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>Caravan parks</i> providing either predominantly short-term (i.e. for periods of less than 2 months) or predominantly long-term (i.e. for periods of 2 months or more) accommodation to the general public and which provide powered sites for caravans and toilet, shower and laundry facilities for guests. <p>3 Data collected and published for each type of establishment (other than holiday flats, units and houses) include both long-term and short-term guests at these establishments.</p> <p>4 Establishments providing more than one type of accommodation (e.g. a motel with attached caravan park) are treated as two or more separate establishments. However, self-contained units, flats, cabins, etc. attached to hotels, motels or to caravan parks are included in the capacity for those establishments and not treated as separate holiday flat, unit or house establishments.</p>
DEFINITIONS	<p>5 <i>Number of establishments.</i> For hotels, motels and guest houses, caravan parks and visitor hostels, the number of establishments within the scope of the survey which operated for any part of the survey period, or which closed temporarily for the quarter for seasonal reasons.</p> <p>6 <i>Number of letting entities.</i> For holiday flats, units and houses, the number of owners, managers or real estate agents within the scope of the survey who operated for any part of the survey period.</p> <p>7 Capacity in terms of <i>Guest rooms, Bed spaces, Holiday units or Caravan park sites, etc.</i> is the maximum number available to accommodate paying guests during the survey period. Capacity closed temporarily for seasonal reasons is included.</p> <p>8 <i>Bed spaces.</i> Three-quarter beds are counted as one bed space; double beds as two bed spaces. Cots are excluded.</p> <p>9 <i>Total caravan park capacity</i> comprises <i>On-site vans, Other powered sites, Unpowered sites and Cabins, etc.</i></p>

DEFINITIONS—*continued*

10 Room nights available. The number of guest rooms available multiplied by the number of days for which they were available during the survey period. Includes operating periods only for establishments closing (other than for seasonal reasons) or opening during the survey period.

11 Occupancy in terms of *Room nights*, *Unit nights* or *Site nights occupied* refers to the total number of nights each guest room, holiday unit or caravan park site, etc. was occupied during the survey period.

NOTE: From September quarter 1992, caravan park sites, etc. permanently reserved for 2 months or more at the end of the survey period but only casually occupied by their tenants have been recorded continuously as *Site nights occupied* irrespective of whether the tenants of individual sites were in residence on any particular night. (See also paragraph 14 below). Previously, usage of these sites was recorded as *Site nights occupied* only when their tenants were in the park. Total site occupancy rates from September quarter 1992 are therefore not comparable with those from previous quarters.

12 Occupancy in terms of *Guest nights* refers to the total number of nights each paying guest stayed during the survey period.

13 Sites occupied by long-term guests. The total number of sites, etc. occupied at the end of the survey period by guests who have stayed continuously for 2 months or more.

14 Other sites permanently reserved. The total number of powered and unpowered sites, on-site vans and cabins, etc. continuously let for 2 months or more by the end of the survey period to tenants who occupy the sites only on a casual or sporadic basis. Separate data for this item are available only from September quarter 1992.

15 Occupancy rates represent occupancy expressed as a percentage of total capacity available during the survey period—e.g.

Room occupancy rate (%) for the period =

$$\frac{\text{Room nights occupied}}{(\text{Guest rooms}) \times (\text{No. of days in the period})} \times 100$$

providing that, for establishments closing (other than for seasonal reasons) or opening during the period, the denominator of the above expression includes only operating periods.

16 Guest arrivals. The total number of paying guests counted only on the first night they stayed at the accommodation establishment.

17 Unit lettings. The total number of times a holiday flat, unit or house was occupied by a new tenant, counted only on the first night it was occupied by the new tenant.

18 Average length of stay is expressed in number of days and is calculated:

- for hotels, motels and guest houses and for visitor hostels, by dividing *Guest nights* by *Guest arrivals* and
- for holiday flats, units and houses, by dividing *Unit nights occupied* by *Unit lettings*.

19 Takings from accommodation. Revenue received from the provision of accommodation. Takings from meals are excluded. Takings from accommodation for each month generally represent the takings received during that month. Where payments are received in advance of, or after, the provision of accommodation to guests, the monthly figure for takings from accommodation may not necessarily bear a direct relationship to the number of guests accommodated during the month. Rental and storage fees paid to caravan parks for the keeping of private vans in parks are included in the takings of the month they are received.

20 Star grading. The grading of hotels and motels with facilities based on the classification system used by members of the Australian Automobile Association (AAA). The gradings are allocated according to a points system based on the amenities and facilities available to guests. Details of the grading scheme are contained in the RACV-RAASA members' publication *Accommodation Australia*, or the individual tour guides produced by members of the AAA. For the purpose of classifying establishments to a star grading in this publication, 'half' star gradings are ignored (e.g. a two and a half star grading has been shown as two star).

21 *Employment.* The number of persons working at accommodation establishments at the end of the survey period (including working proprietors and those working on other than accommodation activities).

22. Statistics presented in this publication have been classified according to the Australian Standard Geographical Classification (ASGC), Edition 2.3. This classification incorporates a number of hierarchic structures of geographic areas. The appropriate spatial units of the main structure of the ASGC used in this publication are defined as follows.

Statistical Local Areas (SLAs) are the smallest types of spatial units in the ASGC for which tourist accommodation data are presented. They correspond either to legal local government areas (LGAs) as defined under the *Local Government Act 1936* or to suburbs in certain urban LGAs. Some LGAs are split into two or more parts, with each part forming a separate SLA. In all instances, LGA data can be derived by aggregating SLAs. The unincorporated area of Queensland also forms a SLA. In aggregate, SLAs cover the whole of the State without gaps or overlaps.

Statistical Subdivisions (SSDs) consist of one or more SLAs and form the intermediate size spatial unit for the presentation of regional data.

Statistical Divisions (SDs), which consist of one or more SSDs, are designed to be relatively homogeneous regions characterised by identifiable social and economic units within the region, under the unifying influence of one or more major towns or cities. The Brisbane Statistical Division comprises the Cities of Brisbane, Ipswich, Logan and Redcliffe, the Shires of Pine Rivers and Redland and parts of the Shires of Albert, Beaudesert, Caboolture, and Moreton.

Statistical districts have been defined around selected urban areas to provide comparable statistics over a period of time. These districts, which are intended to contain the anticipated urban spread for at least 20 years, are generally defined as having a population of 25,000 or more and experiencing urban growth beyond the LGA boundaries.

For more detailed information, refer to the ASGC (1216.0).

UNPUBLISHED STATISTICS

23 The ABS may make available on request certain unpublished tourist accommodation statistics. In particular, small geographical area and other tabulations are available for various accommodation types in a time series format. A charge may be made for this information.


