MAIN FEATURES

QUEENSLAND

The estimated resident population of Queensland increased by 1.9% during 1996-97 to 3,401,232 persons. Population growth in Queensland has slowed over the last 2 years with a total increase of 62,542 persons in 1996-97, the smallest increase since 1990-91.

STATISTICAL DIVISIONS

Moreton Statistical Division recorded the highest population growth rate (3.4%) followed by Far North Statistical Division (2.3%). The Brisbane Statistical Division grew at 1.9% which was the average for the State. The three western statistical divisions of South West, Central West and North West, which account for 58% of the State's total area, each lost population.

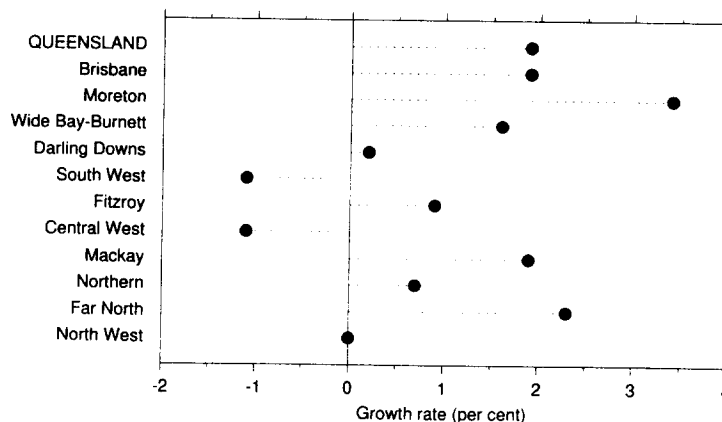
LOCAL GOVERNMENT AREAS

In terms of percentage change, the five fastest growing local government areas (LGAs) in 1997 were the Shires of Miriam Vale (5.4%), Noosa (4.5%), Kolan (4.3%), Mornington (3.9%) and Croydon (3.8%). In absolute terms the fastest-growing local government areas (LGAs) were mainly located in south-east Queensland. The City of Brisbane again recorded the largest annual increase with 13,862 persons. LGAs surrounding Brisbane City continued to grow quickly with large increases recorded in Caboolture Shire (3,553), Redland Shire (2,930), Pine Rivers Shire (2,781) and Logan City (2,073). South of Brisbane, Gold Coast City experienced the second largest LGA population increase in the State with growth of 13,109 persons. North of Brisbane the Sunshine Coast LGAs continued to grow quickly with the largest increase at Maroochy Shire (3,836) followed by Caloundra City (1,843) and Noosa Shire (1,636).

STATISTICAL LOCAL AREAS

In terms of percentage change over the 12 months to 30 June 1997, 45 statistical local areas (SLAs) were estimated to have had population growth of over 5%. Of these fast growing SLAs, there were only two outside south-east Queensland—Douglas (a suburb of Townsville) and Miriam Vale Shire. Of the remaining SLAs with over 5% population growth, 25 were in Brisbane City, 13 were in Gold Coast City, two were in Noosa Shire and one in each of Caboolture Shire, Pine Rivers Shire and Redland Shire.

EXPLANATORY NOTES

INTRODUCTION

1 This publication contains the estimates of the age and sex distribution of the resident population of statistical divisions, statistical subdivisions, statistical local areas (SLAs), legal local government areas and statistical districts in Queensland at 30 June 1997.

METHODOLOGY

2 The estimated resident population (ERP) as at 30 June 1996 for each SLA was calculated by adjusting the 1996 usual residence census counts for under-enumeration and adding the number of residents temporarily overseas at the census date. Persons who did not state their usual residence on the census form and persons counted in the Off-shore Areas and Migratory Statistical Division were proportionately allocated across all the SLAs in the State.

3 As the 1996 census was held on 6 August, a further adjustment was made to obtain the ERP at 30 June 1996. This involved subtracting the increase in population of each SLA, due to the natural increase and net migration between 1 July and 6 August, from the 6 August 1996 population estimate.

4 For intercensal years, the ERP for each SLA is calculated using a linear regression model. Independent indicators of population change currently used in this model are dwelling approvals, Medicare enrolments and family allowance recipients. These intercensal estimates of the resident population are revised each time a population census is taken.

5 The 1992 population figures in this publication have been revised based on the 1996 census. The revised 1992, 1993, 1994 and 1995 population estimates will be published in *Population Growth and Distribution* (2035.0) in May 1998 and are now available from Information Inquiries.

6 A detailed explanation of the concept of estimated resident population, as adopted by the Australian Bureau of Statistics (ABS) for official population estimates, is contained in the ABS Information Paper: *Population Estimates: Concepts, Sources and Methods* (3228.0)

RELIABILITY

7 Estimates are shown to the nearest unit, however, accuracy to this level is not claimed and should not be assumed.

GEOGRAPHIC BOUNDARIES

8 The geographic areas used in this publication are defined in the *Australian Standard Geographical Classification, 1996 Edition* (1216.0).

DEFINITIONS

9 Legal local government areas (LGAs), as defined under the *Local Government Act 1993*, are spatial units which represent the geographical areas of incorporated local government councils, such as cities (C), towns (T) and shires (S).

10 *Statistical local areas* are the smallest spatial units for which the estimates of resident population are presented. They correspond to either

EXPLANATORY NOTES *continued*

LGAs or to suburbs in certain LGAs. Some LGAs are split into two parts, with each part forming a separate SLA. The unincorporated area of Queensland also forms a SLA. In aggregate, SLAs cover the whole of the State without gaps or overlaps.

11 *Statistical subdivisions* consist of one or more SLAs.

12 *Statistical divisions*, which are groupings of SLAs, are designed to be reasonable homogeneous regions characterised by identifiable social and economic units within the region. The Brisbane Statistical Division comprises the Cities of Brisbane, Logan and Redcliffe, the Shires of Pine Rivers and Redland, parts of Gold Coast and Ipswich Cities and parts of Beaudesert and Caboolture Shires.

13 *Statistical districts* have been defined around selected urban areas to provide comparable statistics over a period of time. These districts which are intended to contain the anticipated urban spread for at least 20 years, are generally defined as having a population of 25,000 or more and experiencing urban growth beyond the LGA boundaries.

POPULATION PROJECTIONS

14 The ABS compiles and publishes *Population Projections for Australia, States and Territories* (3222.0). The ABS can prepare ad hoc population projections. Further details regarding the population projections service may be obtained from Information Inquiries at Brisbane (07) 3222 6351.
