Consequently, they supersede estimates from 30 June 1996 which were previously published and based on the 1991 Census results.

SUMMARY OF FINDINGS

ESTIMATED RESIDENT POPULATION

The estimated resident population of NSW at 30 June 1996 was 6,204,728, which represented an increase of 305,997 between 1991 and 1996. The average annual growth rate for this period was 1.0%, which was lower than the Australian average annual growth rate (1.2%).

The population of Sydney Statistical Division (SD) was 3,881,136, or 62.6% of the total population for the State. Between 1991 and 1996 the population of Sydney SD increased by 208,281. The local government areas (LGAs) in Sydney SD which experienced the highest average annual percentage growth were Sydney (13.7%), Camden (7.1%), Liverpool (4.2%), Wyong (2.7%), South Sydney (2.5%), Hawkesbury (2.2%) and Gosford (2.2%). The LGAs of Hunters Hill (-0.3%), Marrickville (-0.2%), Ku-ring-gai (-0.2%) and Botany Bay (-0.1%) experienced the highest average annual percentage losses.


Across the remainder of NSW, the coastal statistical divisions of Richmond-Tweed (2.2%), Mid-North Coast (1.7%), Illawarra (1.3%) and South Eastern (1.2%) showed the highest average annual percentage growth. The LGAs with the most significant average annual percentage growth during the 1991 to 1996 period were Tweed (3.7%), Byron (3.3%), Port Stephens (3.0%), Hastings (3.0%) and Ballina (2.8%).

AGE DISTRIBUTION

The established trend of the ageing of the State's population continues. In 1986, older people (those aged 65 years or more) constituted 11.0% of the NSW population, compared to 11.9% in 1991 and 12.6% in 1996.

While the proportion of older residents in NSW continues to increase, the proportion of children (persons aged less than 15 years) in NSW continues to diminish. In 1986 the proportion of children resident in NSW was 22.8%, in 1991 it was 21.6% and in 1996 it was 21.1%.

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
CHILDREN (UNDER 15 YEARS)

At 30 June 1996, there were 1,311,888 children residing in NSW — 671,959 males and 639,929 females.

Sydney SD maintained its position of having the lowest proportion of children (20.2% of the estimated resident population) of all the statistical divisions in NSW. The lowest proportions of children within Sydney SD were in Sydney (7.5%), South Sydney (8.9%) and North Sydney (8.9%). Within Sydney SD the highest proportions of children were located in the outlying LGAs of Campbelltown (28.7%), Wollondilly (27.1%), Penrith (26.2%) and Blacktown (26.0%).

Outside Sydney SD, North Western SD (25.3%) and Murrumbidgee SD (24.2%) continued to have the highest proportions of children, while Hunter SD (21.6%) and Far West SD (21.6%) had the lowest proportion of children in their resident population.

OLDER PEOPLE (65 YEARS OR MORE)

At 30 June 1996, there were an estimated 782,191 older residents in NSW — 338,477 males and 443,714 females.

Older people represented 11.8% of the population of Sydney SD. The LGAs with the highest proportions of older people within Sydney SD were Hunters Hill (18.8%), Wyong (18.1%), Gosford (17.2%), Hurstville (16.3%), Rockdale (16.3%), Drummoyne (16.1%), Kogarah (16.0%) and Manly (16.0%). The lowest proportions of older people were found in Campbelltown (5.2%), Penrith (6.2%) and Blacktown (6.7%).


Outside Sydney SD, the proportion of older people was 14.0%, which was above the State figure of 12.6%. The statistical divisions with the highest proportions of older people were Mid-North Coast (16.7%) and Richmond-Tweed (16.0%). The statistical divisions with the lowest proportions were North Western (11.5%) and Murrumbidgee (12.1%).

Of the State's 782,191 older people, 321,403 (41.1%) were aged 75 years or more. This proportion has increased since 1986 when 37.4% were aged 75 years or more.

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Older people: proportion of population in statistical divisions, NSW, at 30 June




SEX RATIO

Females continue to outnumber males in the older age groups. In 1996 the number of females aged 65 years or more was 443,714 and the number of males aged 65 years or more was 338,477. This represents a ratio of about 1.3 females for every male.

This ratio becomes greater when older age groups are examined. In 1996 there were about 1.6 females aged 75 years or more for every male aged 75 years or more. Although high, this ratio has decreased in recent years. In 1986, there were about 1.8 females aged 75 years or more for every male aged 75 years or more, and in 1991 the ratio was about 1.7.

EXPLANATORY NOTES

ESTIMATED RESIDENT POPULATION

- 1** The *Estimated Resident Population (ERP)* of an area (State, Statistical Local Area, etc.) is the estimate of the number of persons who usually reside in that area irrespective of where they were at the date of the estimate.
- 2** Detailed explanation of the concept of estimated resident population, as adopted by the Australian Bureau of Statistics (ABS) for official population estimates, is contained in the ABS Information Paper *Population Estimates: Concepts, Sources and Methods* (Cat. no. 3228.0).

METHOD

- 3** The estimated resident population of an area at census date is based on the Census Count (place of actual location) for the area with adjustments made by:
 - Excluding all visitors who normally reside elsewhere (ie overseas or in another area within Australia);
 - Including residents of the area who were counted in another area within Australia;
 - Adjusting for census under-enumeration as measured by the post enumeration survey.
 - Adjustments at the SLA level were calculated separately for the Sydney SD and Balance of NSW, taking into account differences in underenumeration by age, sex and birthplace —Australian born/Overseas-born; —
 - Including residents of the area who were temporarily overseas (ie for less than twelve months) on census night.
 - Due to the census being held on 6 August 1996 further adjustments have been made for births, deaths and net migration for the period 30 June to 6 August 1996 resulting in an estimated resident population figure at 30 June 1996.

STATISTICAL AREAS OF NSW

- 4** This publication contains data presented according to the Australian Standard Geographical Classification (ASGC) and incorporating changes brought about by the (State) *Local Government Act 1993* to the titles of local government areas (LGAs). Under this classification, statistical areas are defined as follows:
 - *Statistical Local Areas (SLAs)*. These geographical areas are, in almost all cases, identical with, or have been formed from a division of, whole local government areas (LGAs) as defined under the (State) *Local Government Act 1993* and comprising cities (C) and areas (A)—prior to this Act these areas were known as cities (C), municipalities (M) and shires (S). In other cases, they represent areas which are unincorporated under the Act. In aggregate, SLAs cover the whole of the State without gaps or overlaps. In some cases LGAs overlap statistical subdivision boundaries and therefore comprise two SLAs (Part A and Part B) or three SLAs in the case of Cabonne (A) (Part A, Part B and Part C). Separate estimates for these LGAs are shown in Table 2.
 - *Statistical Subdivisions (SSDs)*. These consist of one or more SLAs and form the intermediate size spatial unit for the presentation of regional data.
 - *Statistical Divisions (SDs)*. These consist of one or more SSDs. Where SSDs are not shown, SLAs are ordered alphabetically within SDs. The divisions are designed to be relatively homogeneous regions characterised by identifiable social and economic units within the region, under the unifying influence of one or more major towns or cities.

EXPLANATORY NOTES *continued*

5 Further information concerning statistical areas is contained in the publication *Regional Statistics, New South Wales* (Cat. no. 1304.1) and in the publication *Australian Standard Geographical Classification* (Cat. no. 1216.0).

BOUNDARY CHANGES

6 A list of name changes, amalgamations and boundary changes of SLAs and other statistical areas of NSW, from 1 July 1995 to 30 June 1996, is contained in the Appendix.

ROUNDING

7 Estimates for each age and sex category are shown to the nearest unit without rounding; accuracy to this level is not claimed and should not be assumed. This procedure is consistent with 1987 to 1995 age and sex estimates, and is applied because rounding of small cells could result in substantial year to year fluctuations owing to the rounding process rather than an actual population change.

8 Population estimates in previous publications have been rounded as follows:

- All areas in Sydney SD have been rounded to the nearest 50 persons;
- For the remainder of NSW, the SLA and subdivision totals have been rounded to the nearest 10 persons;
- Statistical division totals have been rounded to the nearest 50 persons.
- The State total has been rounded to the nearest 100 persons.
