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SUMMARY OF FINDINGS

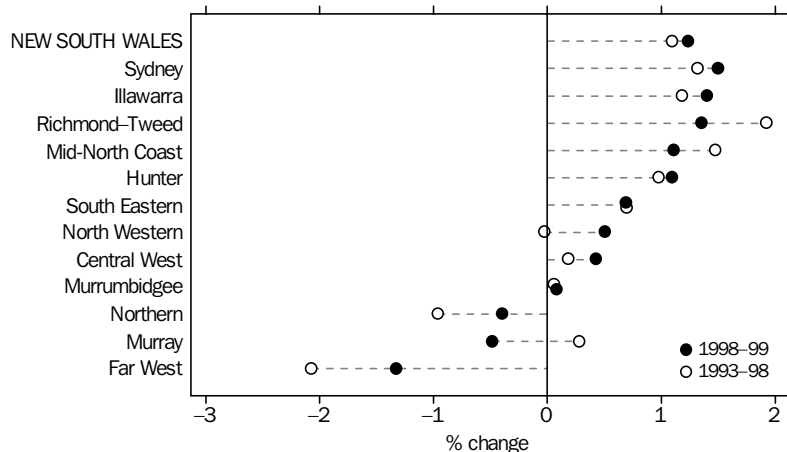
ESTIMATED RESIDENT POPULATION

The estimated resident population of NSW at 30 June 1999 was 6,411,680, which represented an increase of 78,165 persons above the 1998 estimates. The average annual growth rate for NSW was 1.2%, compared with 1.3% for Australia.

The Statistical Divisions (SDs) of NSW which experienced positive annual growth during 1998–99 were Sydney (1.5%), Illawarra (1.4%), Richmond–Tweed (1.4%), Mid-North Coast (1.1%), Hunter (1.1%), South Eastern (0.7%), North Western (0.5%) and Central West (0.4%). In contrast, the SDs of Far West (–1.3%), Murray (–0.5%) and Northern (–0.4%) experienced negative growth during that period.

Graph F1 shows whether the percentage change in population over the last twelve months has been greater or lesser than the average annual change over the previous five years. The largest differences occurred in the SDs of Murray, Far West and Richmond–Tweed.

The population of Sydney SD in June 1999 was 4,041,381, which was 59,740 more people than in 1998, and this represented 63.0% of the total NSW population. The ten fastest growing Statistical Local Areas (SLAs) in Sydney SD during 1998–99 were Sydney—Inner (17.5%), Sydney—Remainder (13.6%), Camden (6.5%), Willoughby (4.8%), Liverpool (4.7%), Hunter's Hill (4.5%), Concord (2.9%), Baulkham Hills (2.7%), Wyong (2.7%) and Blacktown (2.7%). The SLAs which experienced net losses were Botany Bay (–1.5%), Canterbury (–0.3%) and Leichhardt (–0.1%).

The Greater Metropolitan Region (GMR) is a planning region used by the NSW Department of Urban Affairs and Planning that includes the SDs of Sydney, Hunter and Illawarra. In June 1999, the population of the GMR was 4,999,672, which was 1.4% higher than in 1998, and 6.9% higher than in 1994. During 1998–99, the fastest growing SLA in the GMR was Sydney—Remainder (17.5%), whilst the SLA with the largest negative growth was Merriwa (–3.2%).

SUMMARY OF FINDINGS *continued*

The majority of SLAs (80%) with larger populations of 10,000 persons or more experienced positive annual growth during 1998–99, while many smaller SLAs (69%) with populations of less than 10,000 persons experienced negative annual growth. Table F2 below shows the fastest and slowest growing SLAs in each SD during 1998–99.

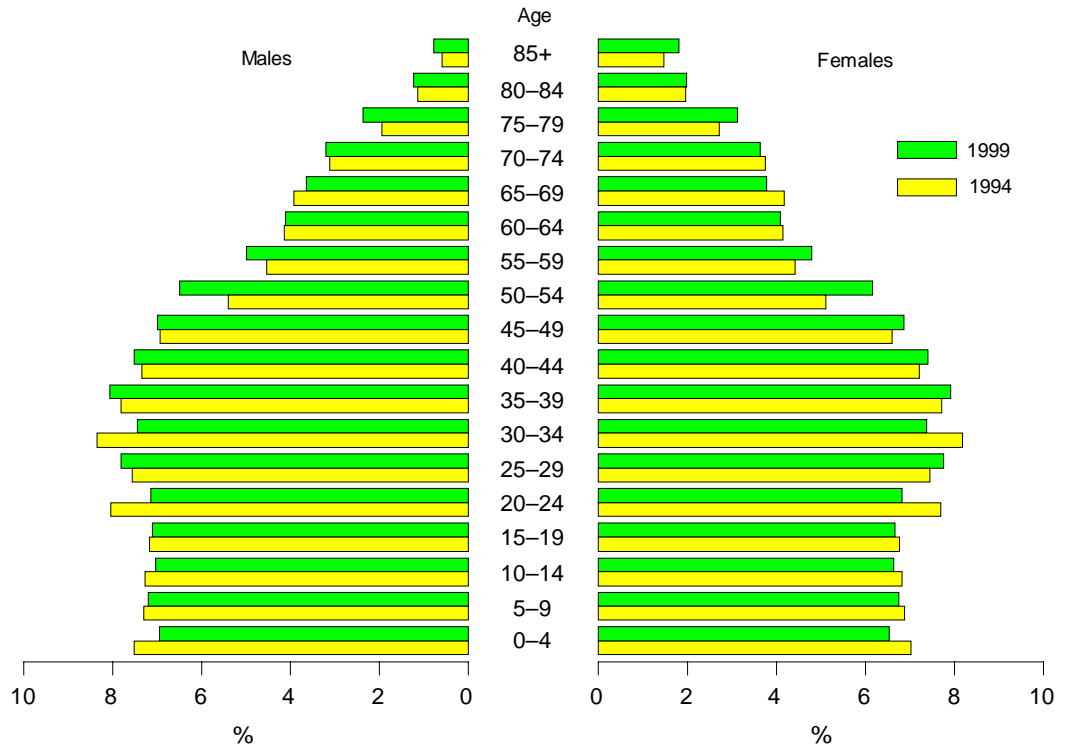

AGE DISTRIBUTION

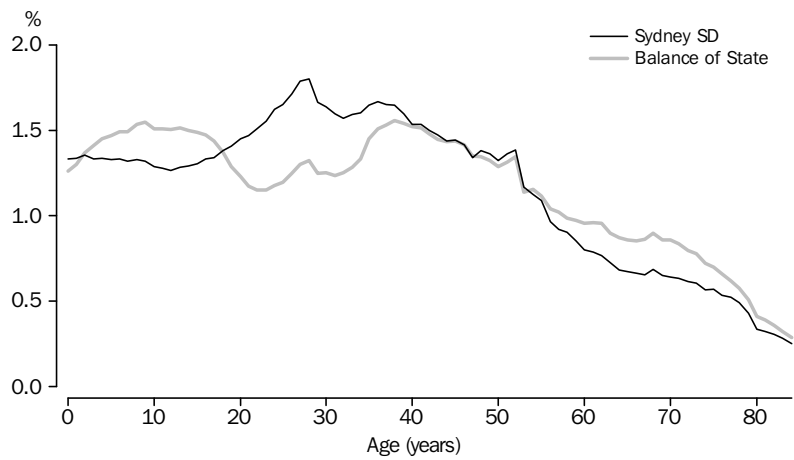
The twelve month period to June 1999 saw the continued ageing of the population of NSW. In June 1999, people aged 65 years or more constituted 12.8% of the NSW population, compared to 12.4% in 1994. While the proportion of older residents in NSW continues to increase, the proportion of younger people continues to decline. In June 1999 the proportion of children aged under 15 years in NSW was 20.5%, compared to 21.4% in 1994.

The age distribution of the population varies throughout NSW. As shown by Graph F4 below, Sydney SD has a lower proportion of children and a higher proportion of young adults, compared to the Balance of State. Sydney SD also had a lower proportion of people aged 55 years and over compared to the Balance of State.

MEDIAN AGE

The median age of the population is the age at which half the population is younger than that age, and half the population is older. The median age of the NSW population in June 1999 was 34.6 years for males and 36.0 years for females. In comparison, the median age of all Australian males and females was, respectively, 34.2 years and 35.6 years. Since 1994, the median age of males and females in NSW has increased by 1.0 year and 0.8 years respectively.

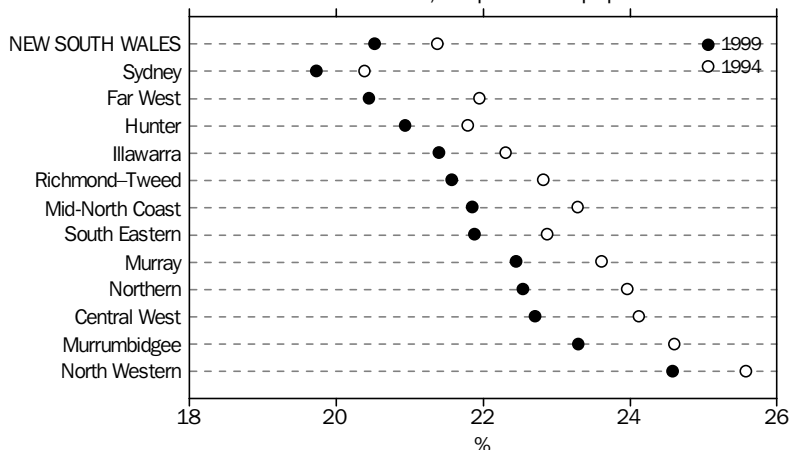
In June 1999, males in Mid-North Coast SD had the highest median age (39.0 years), while those of Murrumbidgee SD had the lowest (33.5 years). Among females, Mid-North Coast SD had the highest median age (40.0 years) while Murrumbidgee SD had the lowest (34.8 years).

POPULATION AGED UNDER 15 YEARS

In June 1999, there were 1,316,439 children in NSW, representing 20.5% of the State's population. This was lower than the proportion of children at the Australian level (20.7%). Graph F5 below shows that the proportion of children in all SDs declined between 1994 and 1999. In June 1999, Sydney SD had the lowest proportion of children (19.7%) of all the SDs in NSW. Within Sydney SD, the SLAs with the lowest proportion of children were Sydney—Remainder (7.8%), Sydney—Inner (8.1%), South Sydney (8.5%), North Sydney (9.4%) and Leichhardt (12.4%). The SLAs within Sydney SD with the highest proportion of children were Campbelltown (26.6%), Wollondilly (25.4%), Camden (25.2%), Blacktown (25.1%) and Penrith (24.9%).

Outside of Sydney SD, all SDs in NSW except Far West SD had a higher proportion of children when compared to the total NSW level. The SLAs, outside of Sydney SD, with the lowest proportion of children aged under 15 years were Newcastle—Inner (8.8%), Unincorporated Far West (15.7%), Newcastle—Remainder (17.6%), Bingara (17.9%) and Evans—Pt B (18.1%). The SLAs with the highest proportion of children were Brewarrina (30.7%), Cobar (28.0%), Bourke (27.3%), Carrathool (26.6%) and Hume (26.3%).

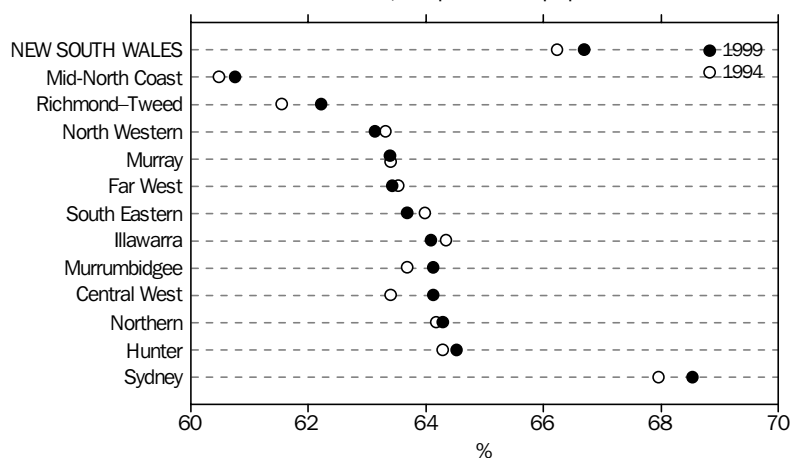
POPULATION AGED 15–64 YEARS

People aged 15–64 years made up 66.7% of the resident population of NSW, compared to 67.1% Australia-wide. Graph F6 shows that the SDs of Sydney, Richmond-Tweed and Central West have experienced the greatest change in the proportion of their population aged 15–64 years.

In June 1999, people aged 15–64 years made up 68.5% of the population in Sydney SD. In all other SDs however, the proportion of the population in this age group was lower than the total NSW level. Within Sydney SD, the SLAs with the lowest proportion in this age group were Wyong (59.8%), Gosford (61.5%), Bankstown (64.7%), Blue Mountains (65.5%) and Hurstville (65.8%). The SLAs with the highest proportion in this age group were Sydney—Remainder (86.8%), Sydney—Inner (83.4%), South Sydney (81.4%), North Sydney (78.7%) and Leichhardt (77.7%).

Outside Sydney SD, the SLAs with the lowest proportion of 15–64 year olds were Great Lakes (56.3%), Tweed—Pt A (57.8%), Eurobodalla (58.2%), Hastings (58.4%) and Nambucca (58.5%). The SLAs with the highest proportion of people aged 15–64 years, outside Sydney SD, were Newcastle—Inner (79.2%), Unincorporated Far West (76.2%), Yarrowlumla—Pt A (71.6%), Evans—Pt B (71.5%) and Yarrowlumla—Pt B (70.8%).

POPULATION AGED 65 YEARS AND OVER

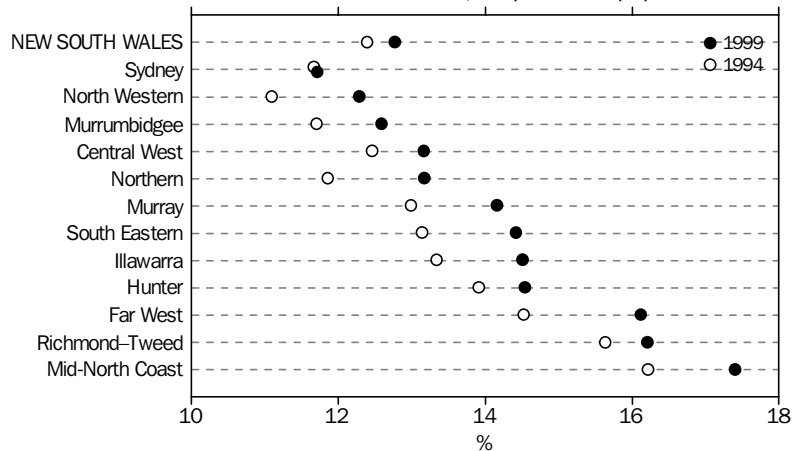
In June 1999, there were an estimated 818,900 people aged 65 years and over in NSW, representing 12.8% of the population. This was higher than the proportion of people aged 65 years and over at the Australian level (12.2%). Graph F7 shows that for all SDs except Sydney SD, the proportion of people aged 65 years and over showed a large increase between 1994 and 1999.

Older people represented 11.7% of the population in Sydney SD. The SLAs with the lowest proportions of older people were Sydney—Remainder (5.3%), Campbelltown (5.7%), Penrith (6.5%), Liverpool (6.9%) and Blacktown (7.1%). The highest proportions of older people within Sydney SD were found in the SLAs of Wyong (18.0%), Gosford (17.0%), Hunter's Hill (16.3%), Hurstville (16.0%) and Rockdale (15.9%).

Nine of the eleven SDs outside Sydney SD had a higher proportion of people aged 65 years and over when compared to the total NSW level. Outside of Sydney SD, the SLAs with the lowest proportion of people in this age group were Yarrawlumla—Pt A (6.2%), Cobar (7.8%), Bourke (8.0%), Yarrawlumla—Pt B (8.1%) and Unincorporated Far West (8.1%). The SLAs with the highest proportion of people aged 65 years and over, outside Sydney SD, were Great Lakes (24.8%), Tweed—Pt A (23.8%), Eurobodalla (22.1%), Barraba (21.5%) and Maclean (21.2%).

F7 POPULATION AGED 65 YEARS AND OVER, Proportion of population in SDs—at 30 June



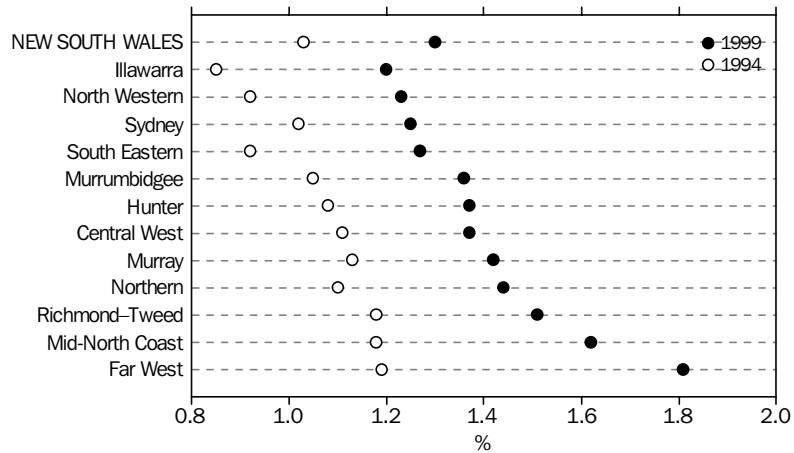
POPULATION AGED 85 YEARS AND OVER

Graph F8 shows that the proportion of the population aged 85 years and over is increasing. Their size and the distribution of this population may be of particular interest to planners as this age group requires greater support from social and medical services. In NSW in June 1999, 1.3% of the population was aged 85 years and over, an increase from 1.0% in 1994. In June 1999, the SLAs in Sydney SD with the lowest proportion of people aged 85 years and over were Campbelltown (0.4%), Sydney—Remainder (0.5%), Penrith (0.5%), Blacktown (0.5%) and Liverpool (0.6%). The SLAs in Sydney SD with the greatest proportion of their population aged 85 years or over were Hunter's Hill (3.4%), Mosman (2.2%), Lane Cove (2.1%), Ashfield (2.1%) and Waverley (2.1%).

Outside of Sydney SD, the SLAs with the lowest proportion of people in this age group were Yarrawlumla—Pt A (0.4%), Walgett (0.4%), Dumaresq (0.5%), Hume (0.5%) and Mulwaree (0.6%). In contrast, the SLAs with the highest proportion of people aged 85 years and over were Windouran (3.7%), Lord Howe Island (3.7%), Barraba (3.0%), Inverell—Pt B (2.7%) and Yarrawlumla—Pt B (2.3%).

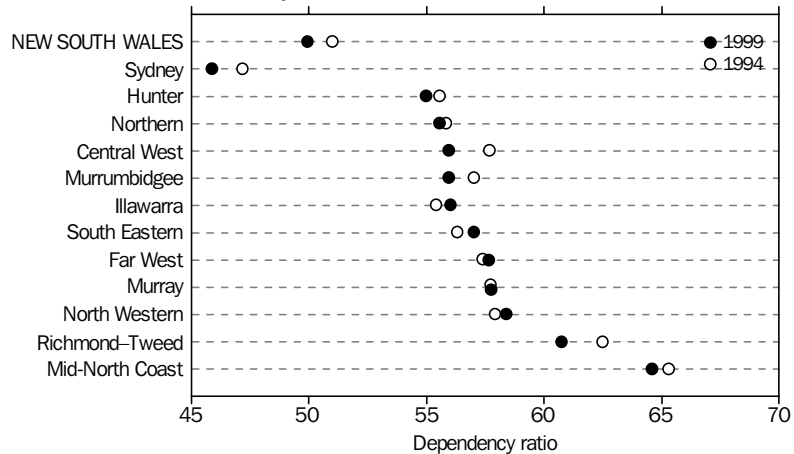
F8 POPULATION AGED 85 YEARS AND OVER, Proportion of population in SDs—at 30 June



DEPENDENCY RATIO

In NSW the dependency ratio at June 1999 was 49.9, compared to 51.0 in 1994 (See graph F9). At June 1999, the dependency ratio at the Australian level was 49.1. The dependency ratio is a measure of the 'independent' population aged 15–64 years in comparison to the 'dependent' population aged under 15 years and 65 years and over. A reduced value for the dependency ratio indicates that there is more population of working age to support the population of non-working age. The decrease in the dependency ratio in the last five years is a consequence of faster growth in the population aged 15–64 years, compared to the population aged under 15 years and 65 years and over.

F9 DEPENDENCY RATIO, By SD—at 30 June

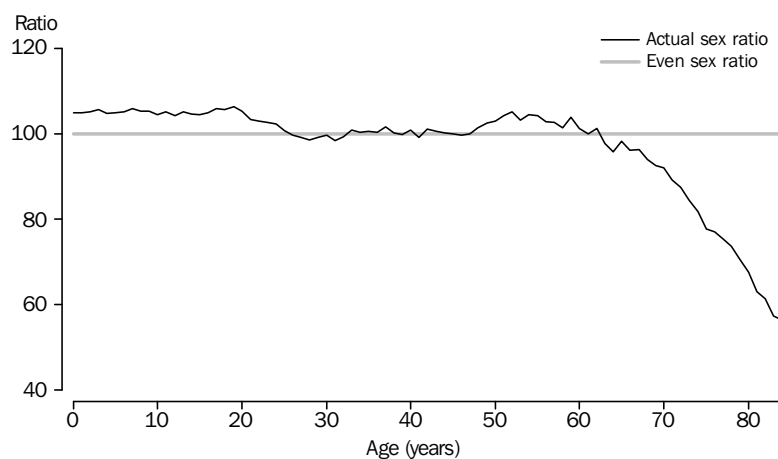

SEX RATIO

At June 1999, the sex ratio for NSW was 98.8 males for every 100 females, compared to 99.1 males per 100 females Australia-wide. However, due to the longer life expectancy of females, the sex ratio decreased with age. Amongst people aged 65 years and over, the sex ratio was 77.6 males for every 100 females, while for those aged 85 years and over it was 42.8 males for every 100 females (See graph F10).

The sex ratio of males to females varied across NSW. Sydney SD and the coastal SDs had a lower number of males than females in 1999, while for the majority of the inland SDs the reverse was true. In 1999, Richmond–Tweed SD (97.5 males per 100 females) had the lowest sex ratio while North Western SD (102.4 males per 100 females) had the highest.

EXPLANATORY NOTES

INTRODUCTION

1 This publication contains preliminary estimates at June 1999 of the resident population by age and sex in Statistical Local Areas (SLAs) of New South Wales.

ESTIMATED RESIDENT POPULATION

2 The estimated resident population (ERP) is the official Australian Bureau of Statistics (ABS) estimate of the Australian population.

3 The ERP of an area (State, Statistical Local Area, etc.) is the estimate of the number of persons who usually reside in that area irrespective of where they were at the date of the estimate.

METHODOLOGY

4 The total population of each SLA is based on results of the 1996 Census of Population and Housing. Post-Census population estimates are calculated with a linear regression model which uses independent indicators of population change such as dwelling approvals and Medicare enrolments. However, as no direct measure of population movement at statistical local areas is available, the indicators may give an incomplete picture. Therefore, it should be noted that all intercensal estimates will be subject to revision when final results are available from the 2001 Census.

5 Post-censal estimates of the age and sex distributions of SLA populations are made by updating the age/sex profile at the Census using annual births (by sex), deaths (by age and sex) and a derived age and sex profile of migration. While annual data on births by sex and deaths by age and sex are available for each SLA, data on migration into and out of SLAs for post-censal years are not available, and have to be derived indirectly.

6 After each Census, final estimates for the preceding intercensal period are calculated by incorporating an adjustment (intercensal discrepancy) to ensure that the total intercensal increase at each age agrees with the difference between the estimated resident population at the two respective census dates.

7 A detailed explanation of the concept of, and of method of calculating, the ERP is contained in the ABS Information Paper *Population Estimates: Concepts, Sources and Methods* (Cat. no. 3228.0).

STATISTICAL AREAS OF NSW

8 This publication contains data presented according to the Australian Standard Geographical Classification (ASGC) and incorporating changes brought about by the (State) *Local Government Act 1993* to the titles of local government areas (LGAs). Under this classification, statistical areas are defined as follows:

EXPLANATORY NOTES *continued*

- *Statistical Local Areas (SLAs)*. These geographical areas are, in almost all cases, identical with, or have been formed from a division of, whole local government areas (LGAs) as defined under the (State) *Local Government Act 1993* and comprising cities (C) and areas (A)—prior to this Act these areas were known as cities (C), municipalities (M) and shires (S). In other cases, they represent areas which are unincorporated under the Act. In aggregate, SLAs cover the whole of the State without gaps or overlaps. In some cases LGAs overlap statistical subdivision boundaries and therefore comprise two SLAs (Part A and Part B) or three SLAs in the case of Cabonne (A) (Part A, Part B and Part C). Separate estimates for these LGAs are shown in table 2.
- *Statistical Subdivisions (SSDs)*. These consist of one or more SLAs and form the intermediate size spatial unit for the presentation of regional data.
- *Statistical Divisions (SDs)*. These consist of one or more SSDs. Where SSDs are not shown, SLAs are ordered alphabetically within SDs. The divisions are designed to be relatively homogeneous regions characterised by identifiable social and economic units within the region, under the unifying influence of one or more major towns or cities.

9 Further information concerning statistical areas is contained in the publication *Regional Statistics, New South Wales* (Cat. no. 1304.1) and in the publication *Australian Standard Geographical Classification* (Cat. no. 1216.0).

BOUNDARY CHANGES

10 A list of name changes, amalgamations and boundary changes of SLAs and other statistical areas of NSW, from 1 July 1998 to 30 June 1999, is contained in the Appendix.

ROUNDING

11 Estimates for each age and sex category are shown to the nearest unit without rounding, although **accuracy to this level is not claimed and should not be assumed**. This procedure is consistent with 1987 to 1996 age and sex estimates, and is applied because rounding of small cells could result in substantial year to year fluctuations owing to the rounding process rather than an actual population change.

12 Population estimates in previous publications have been rounded as follows:

- All areas in Sydney SD have been rounded to the nearest 50 persons;
- For the remainder of NSW, the SLA and subdivision totals have been rounded to the nearest 10 persons;
- Statistical division totals have been rounded to the nearest 50 persons.
- The State total has been rounded to the nearest 100 persons.

DATA ON FLOPPY DISK

13 The data contained in this publication are also available on floppy disk.

UNPUBLISHED STATISTICS

14 In some cases, the ABS can also make available information which is not published. This information may be made available in one or more of the following forms: floppy disk, microfiche, photocopy, computer printout, clerically-extracted tabulation. Generally, a charge is made for providing unpublished information. Inquiries should be made as shown in the inquiries section at the front of this publication.

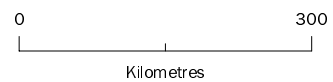
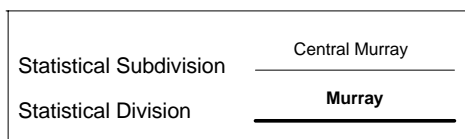

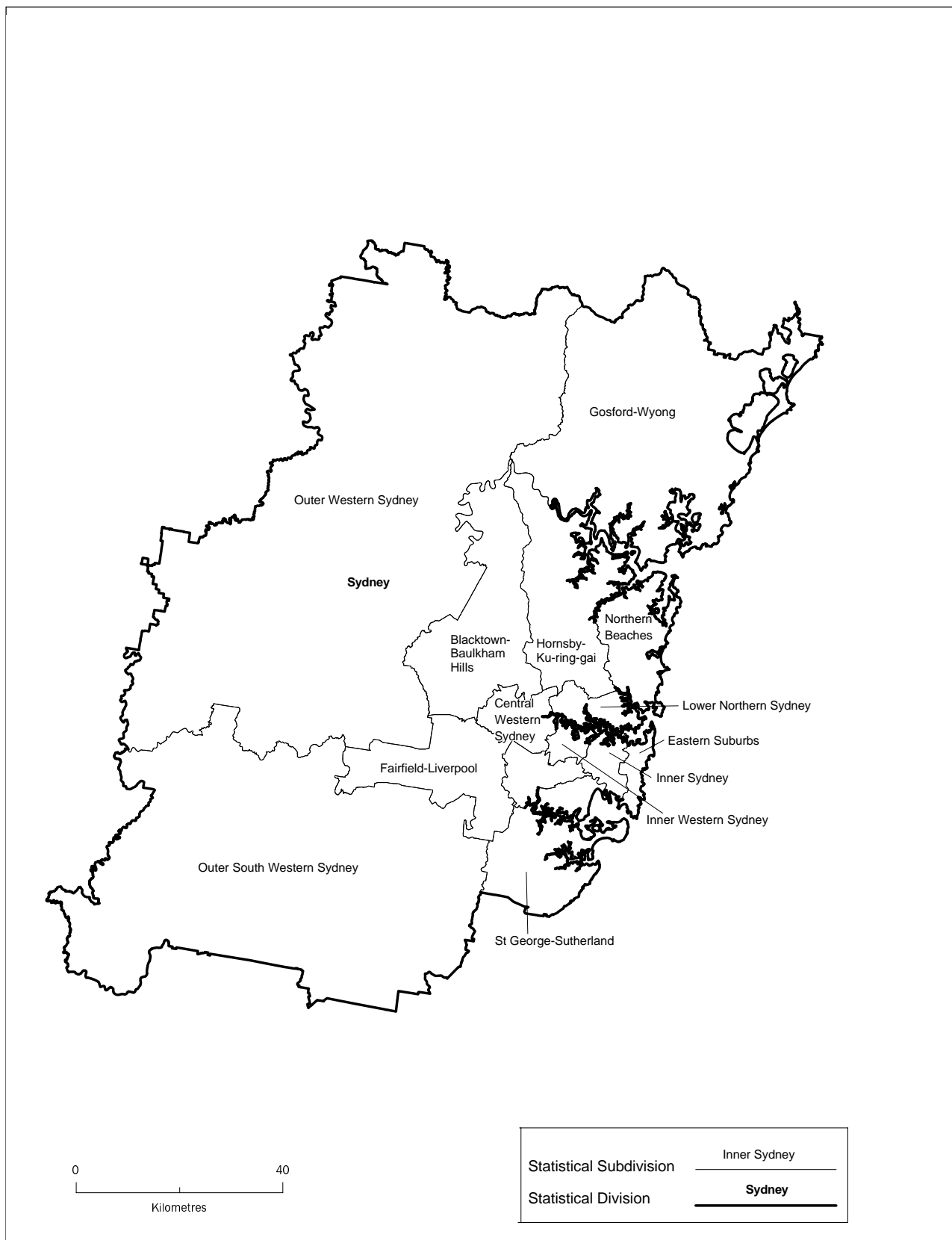

SDs AND SSDs IN NSW

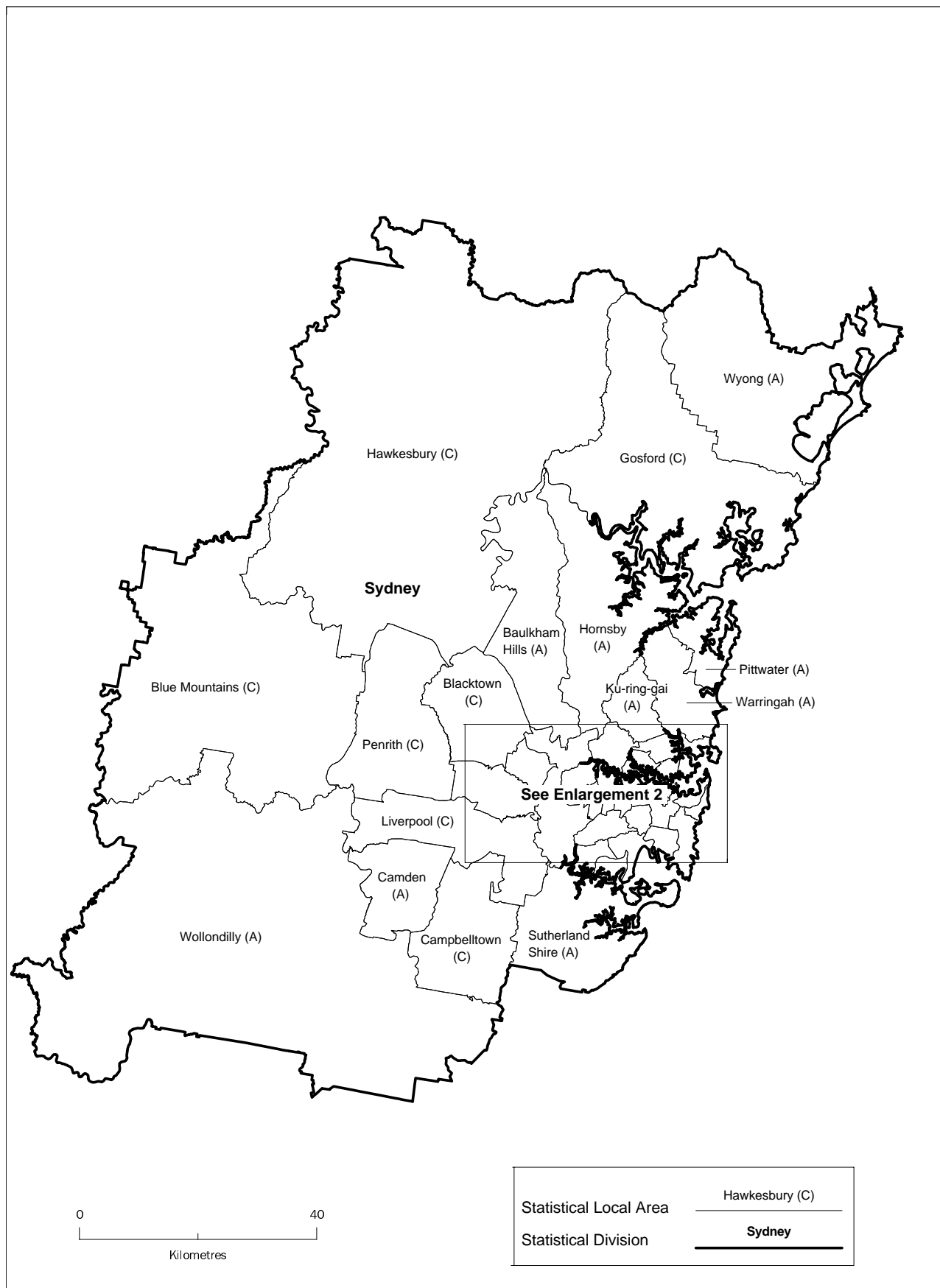

SLAs IN SYDNEY SD

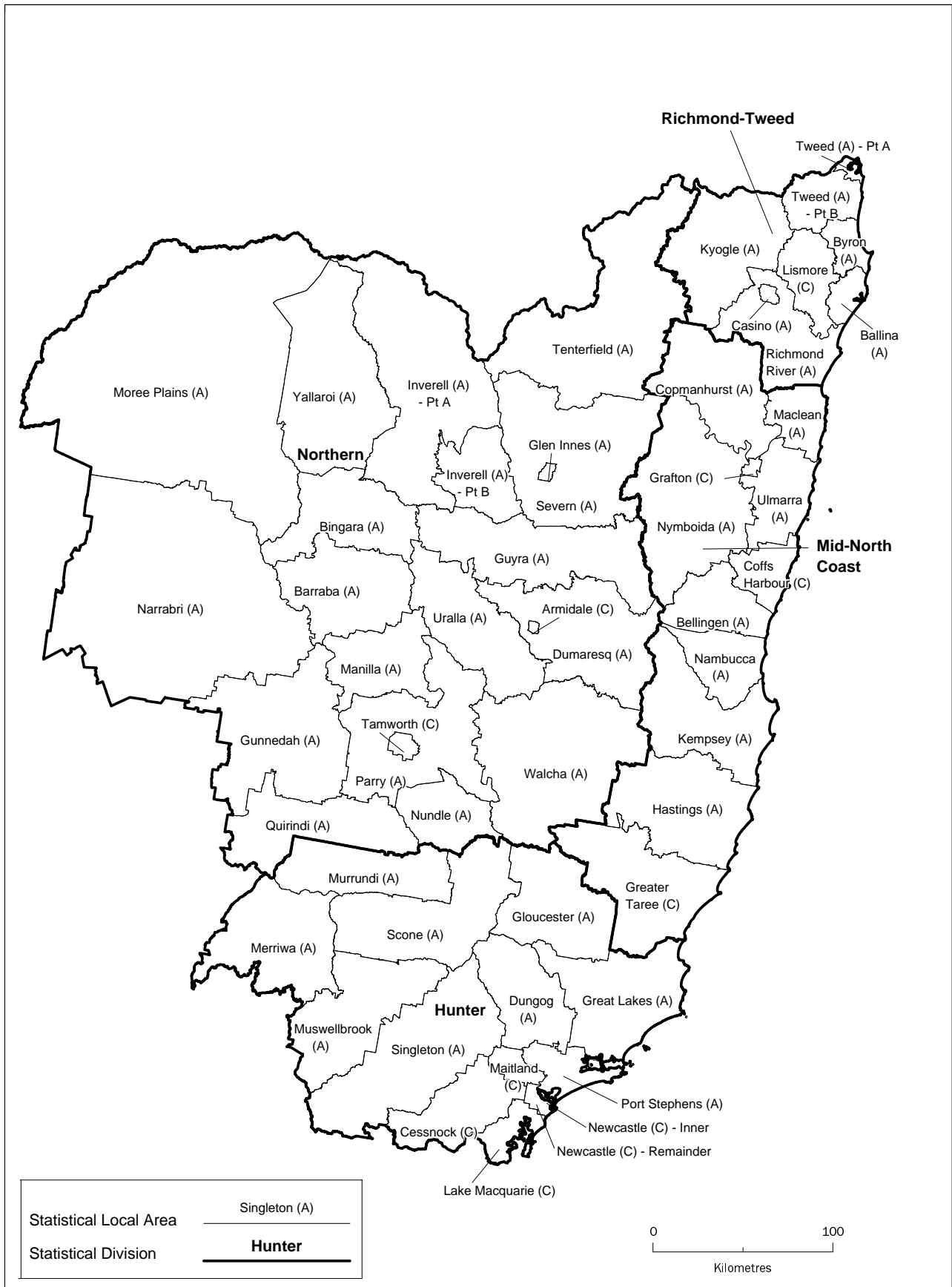

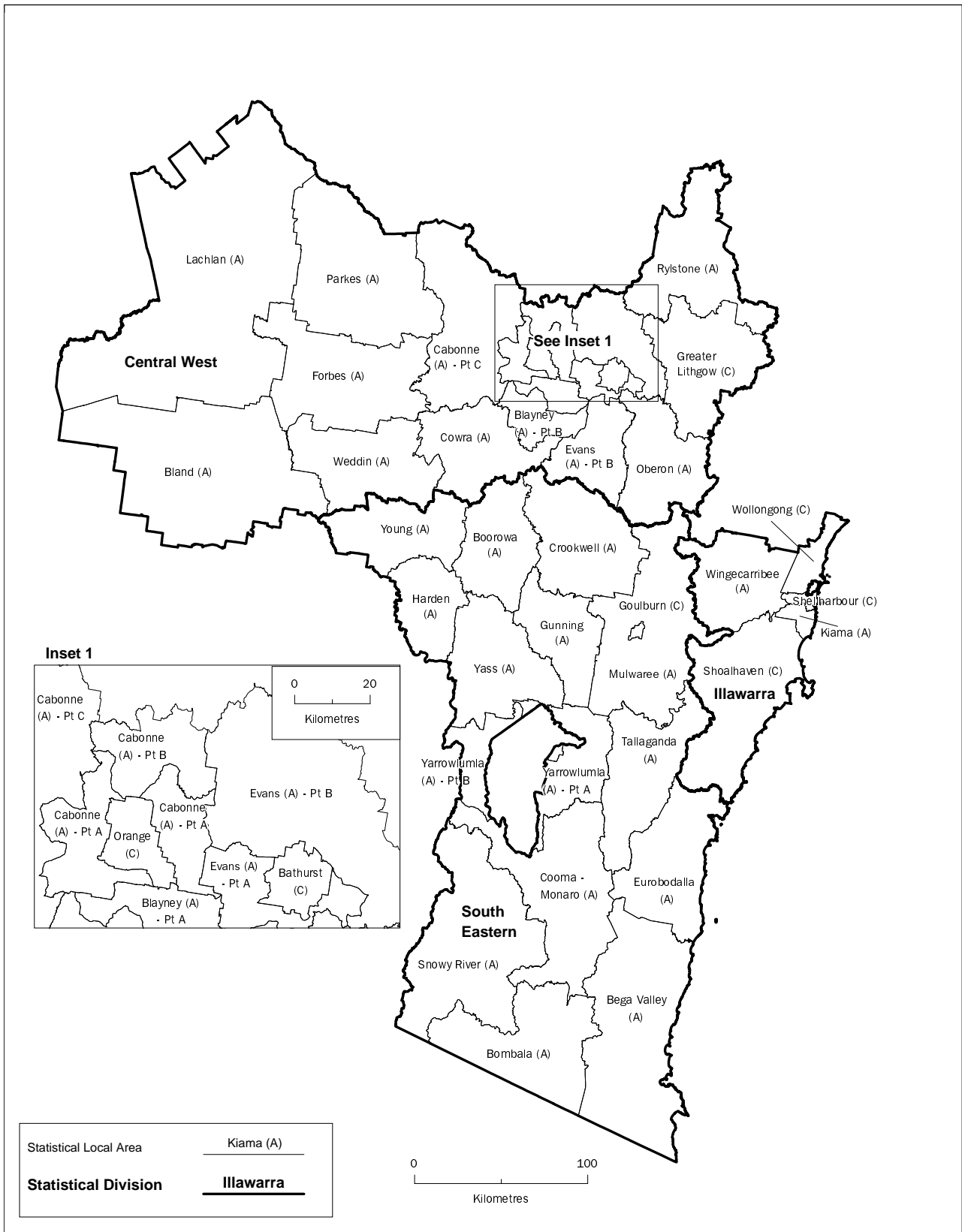

SLAs IN HUNTER, RICHMOND-TWEED AND MID-NORTH COAST SDs

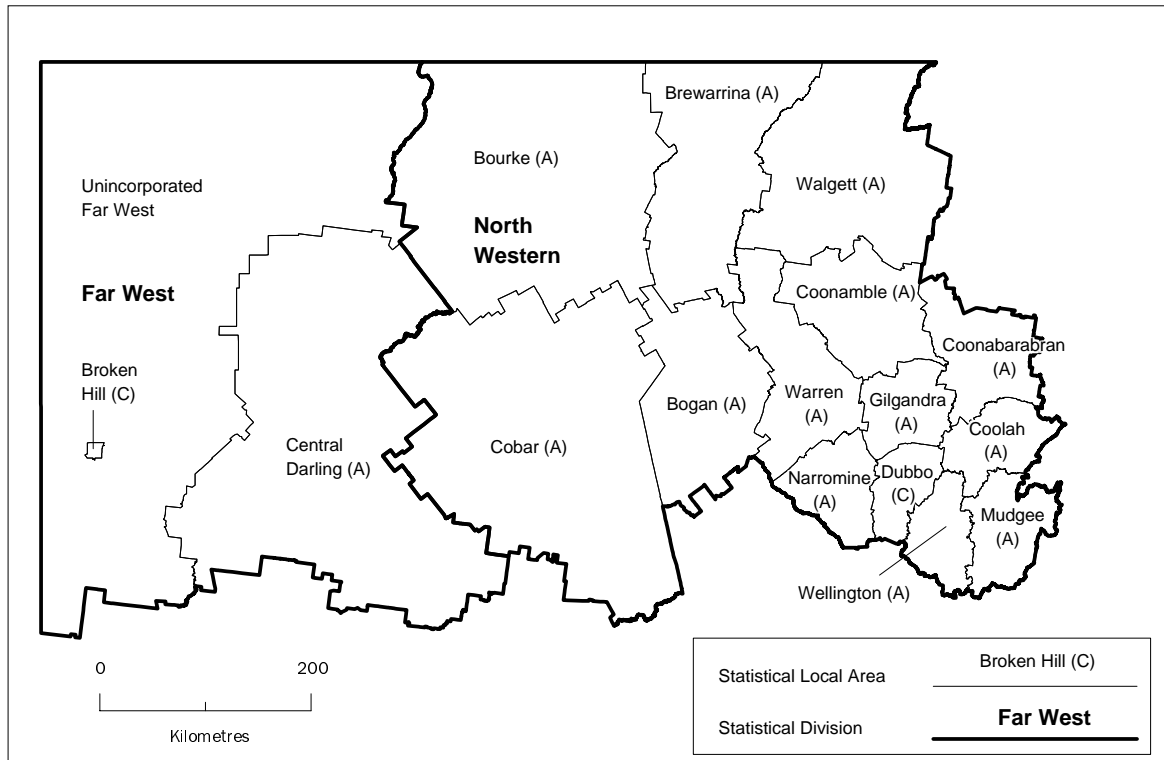

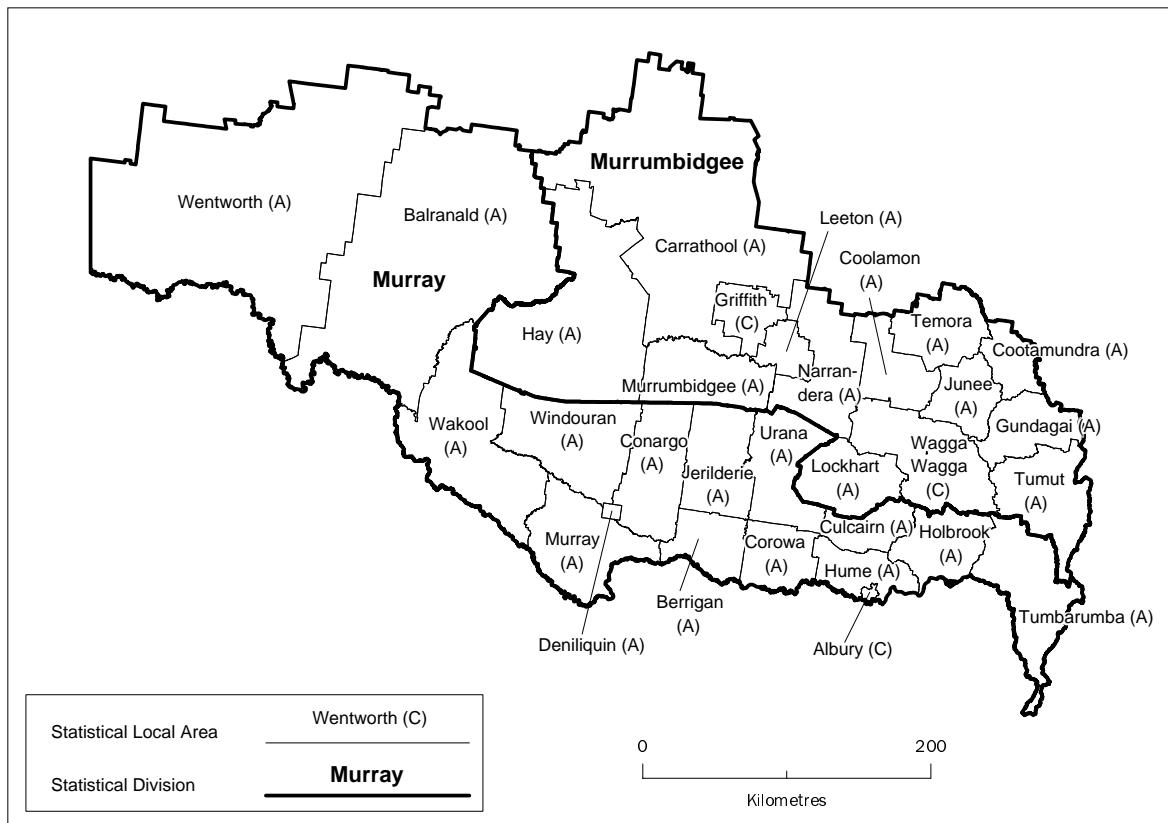
SLAs IN ILLAWARRA, CENTRAL WEST AND SOUTH EASTERN SDs
