SUMMARY OF FINDINGS

POPULATION AT 30 JUNE 1999

The estimated resident population (ERP) in Victoria was 4,712,200, an increase of 57,200 (1.2%) since 1998 and 224,600 (5.0%) in the five years since 1994.

The population (ERP) for the Melbourne Statistical Division (MSD) was 3,417,200, an increase of 50,200 (1.5%) since 1998 and 204,200 (6.4%) since 1994.

AGE STRUCTURE


The age distribution of the Victorian population is significantly concentrated around the age range of 20–44 years. During the 12 months to 30 June 1999, the largest increase was in the 50–54 years age group which increased by 10,000 (3.5%). The highest growth rate was in the 85-years-or-older age group (4,100 or 6.9%) followed by the 75–79 years age group with growth of 7,700 (6.4%).

The number of older persons (65 years and over) increased by 10,300 (1.8%) in the 12 months. As a proportion of the population, older persons have increased from 12.2% in 1994 to 12.7% in 1999.

The number of children (aged under 15 years) in Victoria has remained stable during the 12 months to 30 June 1999. As a proportion of the population, children have decreased from 21.0% of the total in 1994 to 20.1% in 1999.

The median age of Victorians has continued to rise from 33.6 years in 1994 to 34.9 years in 1998 and 35.1 years in 1999. This is slightly higher than the median age for all Australians (34.9 years).

Under 15 years

The number of children was estimated to be 948,400 which represented 20.1% of Victoria's population.

Within the MSD, the highest proportions of children were found in Knox (C) — South (29.6%), Casey (C) — Cranbourne (28.8%), Hume (C) — Craigieburn (28.5%), Frankston (C) — East (28.3%), Melton (S) — East (28.3%) and Wyndham (C) — North-West (28.1%). The lowest proportions were in the inner city areas of Melbourne (C) — S'bank-D'lands (6.9%), Melbourne (C) — Inner (7.7%), Stonnington (C) — Prahran (8.9%), Melbourne (C) — Remainder (9.3%), Port Phillip (C) — St Kilda (9.6%) and Port Phillip (C) — West (10.8%).

Outside the MSD, the highest proportions of children were found in Moorabool (S) — Ballan (27.3%), Mitchell (S) — South (26.9%), Macedon Ranges (S) — Romsey (26.6%), Swan Hill (RC) — Robinvale (26.4%) and Gr. Bendigo (C) — S'saye (26.3%). The lowest proportions were in Geelong (16.4%), Geelong West (17.9%), Bass Coast (S) — Phillip Island (18.1%), Ballarat (C) — Central (18.4%), Gr. Bendigo (C) — Inner East (18.5%) and Newtown (18.5%).

15–64 years

The number of persons aged 15–64 years was estimated to be 3,165,300 which represented 67.2% of Victoria's population.

Within the MSD, the area with the highest proportion of persons aged 15–64 years was Melbourne (C) — S'bank-D'lands (89.5%), Melbourne (C) — Inner (85.9%) followed by Melbourne (C) — Remainder (81.2%), Port Phillip (C) — St Kilda (78.6%), Yarra (C) — Richmond (78.6%) and Yarra (C) — North (78.3%). The lowest proportion of this age group was in Mornington P'sula (S) — South (55.4%).

Outside the MSD, the proportion of the population in this age group was lower, 63.4% compared to 68.6% in the MSD. The lowest proportions were found in Queenscliffe (B) (54.4%), Yarriambiack (S) — North (54.6%), Bass Coast (S) — Phillip Island (56.0%) and Glenelg (S) — North (57.0%). The highest proportion in this age group was in Greater Geelong (C) — Pt C. (74.1%).



65–84 years

The number of persons aged 65–84 was estimated to be 534,900 which represented 11.4% of Victoria's population.


Within the MSD, the highest proportions were found in Mornington P'sula (S) — South (25.2%), Moreland (C) — North (17.9%), Glen Eira (C) — South (16.6%), Boroondara (C) — Camberwell N. (16.0%) and Bayside (C) — South (15.9%). Newer areas in the outer parts of Melbourne had the lowest proportion of this age group, the lowest being Melton (S) — East (2.3%), Hume (C) — Craigieburn (3.0%), Melbourne (C) — S'bank-D'ands (3.5%), Knox (C) — South (3.8%) and Nillumbik (S) — South-West (4.0%).

Outside the MSD, the highest proportions were found in Bass Coast (S) — Phillip Island (24.0%), Queenscliffe (B) (22.4%), Bass Coast (S) — Bal. (20.4%), Yarriambiack (S) — South (20.0%), Central Goldfields (S) — M'borough (19.2%) and Buloke (S) — South (19.2%). The lowest proportions were located in LaTrobe (S) — Bal. (5.3%), Macedon Ranges (S) — Romsey (6.0%) and Greater Geelong (C) — Pt. C (6.1%).

85 years and over

The number of persons aged 85 years and over in Victoria was estimated to be 63,600 making up 1.4% of its population.

Within the MSD, the highest proportions were found in Bayside (C) — Brighton (2.9%), Boroondara (C) — Camberwell S. (2.6%), Boroondara (C) — Kew (2.6%), Boroondara (C) — Camberwell N. (2.4%) and Mornington P'sula (S) — South (2.4%). The lowest proportions were found in Melbourne (C) — S'bank-D'ands (0.1%), Hume (C) Craigieburn (0.2%), Knox (C) — South (0.2%) and Melton (S) — East (0.2%).

Outside the MSD, the highest proportions were found in Queenscliffe (B) (4.0%), Wangaratta (RC) — North (3.9%) and Mount Alexander (S) — C'maine (3.1%). The lowest proportions were in Wellington (S) — Rosedale (0.3%), Golden Plains (S) — North-West (0.5%), Wellington (S) — Avon (0.5%) and LaTrobe (S) — Bal (0.5%).

EXPLANATORY NOTES

INTRODUCTION

- 1** This publication contains preliminary estimated resident population by age and sex of Statistical Local Areas (SLAs), Statistical Subdivisions (SSDs) and Statistical Divisions (SDs) of Victoria at 30 June 1999.
- 2** The estimated resident population is compiled according to the place of usual residence of the population.

METHODOLOGY

- 3** The estimated resident population of an area is the estimate of the number of persons who usually reside in that area, irrespective of where they were on the date of the estimate.
- 4** The total population of each SLA is based on results of the 1996 Census of Population and Housing data and calculated for intercensal years by a linear regression model. The model uses independent indicators of population change, such as occupied dwellings and Medicare enrolments.
- 5** The age and sex estimates were obtained using the demographic cohort component method. Estimates for 1999 were updated from 1998 using SLA population estimates by age and sex at June 1998, recorded births and deaths during the year 1998–99 and the total population estimates at 30 June 1999. The total population growth for an SLA during 1998–99 was split into natural increase and net migration components, the latter being the difference between the total growth and natural increase during 1998–99. Age–sex estimates of natural increase were obtained from vital registrations (i.e. births and deaths), and those for net migration were derived as follows:
 - the net migration component was subdivided into internal arrivals and departures and overseas arrivals and departures, and proportionate age–sex distributions were allocated to each of these subdivisions for each SLA.
 - SLA specific migration profiles (the proportionate age–sex distributions) for inter SLA arrival, inter-SLA departure and overseas arrival to each SLA were obtained from the 1996 Census data on usual residence one year prior to the Census data, and
 - age–sex migration profiles for overseas departures were based on an average of overseas departures from the State/Territory which incorporated the SLA as recorded on passenger cards completed by incoming and outgoing travellers for the Department of Immigration and Multicultural Affairs.
- 6** A detailed explanation of the concept of estimated resident population, as adopted by the Australian Bureau of Statistics (ABS) for official population estimates, is contained in the *ABS Information Paper: Demographic Estimates, Concepts, Sources and Methods* (Cat. no. 3228.0).

7 Population figures over 1,000 in the text of this publication are rounded to the nearest hundred, and figures less than 1,000 are rounded to the nearest 10.

While unrounded figures are provided in tables, accuracy to the last digit is not claimed and should not be assumed.








STATISTICAL LOCAL AREAS WHOLE STATE




STATISTICAL LOCAL AREAS WHOLE STATE *continued*




STATISTICAL LOCAL AREAS ENLARGEMENT 1
