MAIN FEATURES

SOUTH AUSTRALIA

South Australia's estimated resident population at 30 June 1997 was 1,479,806, an increase of 5,553 (0.4%) since 1996, and 33,507 (2.3%) since 1991.

The population of the Adelaide Statistical Division (SD) was 1,083,074 or 73.2% of the total population for the State, an increase of 3,962 persons (0.4%) over the 1996 figure. Since 1991, the population of the Adelaide SD has increased by 25,913 persons (2.5%).

CHILDREN (UNDER 15 YEARS)

The number of children in 1997 was 297,975, a decrease of 1,540 (-0.5%) since 1996. The proportion of the State's population aged under 15 years has continued to decline. Children represented 20.7% of the State's population in 1991, 20.3% in 1996 and 20.1% in 1997.

Adelaide SD had the lowest proportion of children (19.1%) of all statistical divisions in South Australia. The SLAs with the lowest proportion of children within the Adelaide SD were Adelaide (5.6%) and Kensington and Norwood (10.4%), while the SLAs with the highest proportion of children were Munno Para (27.4%) and Willunga (24.4%).

Outside the Adelaide SD, the Northern SD (24.0%) had the highest proportion of children in the resident population. The SLA of Roxby Downs had the highest proportion of children (30.3%), while Port Broughton (17.0%) had the lowest.

THE AGED (65 YEARS AND OVER)

There were 209,121 aged persons resident in South Australia at 30 June 1997, an increase of 2,484 persons (1.2%) since 1996 and 22,398 persons (12.0%) since 1991. The size of South Australia's aged population is increasing at a higher rate than the population as a whole. Persons aged 65 years and over constituted 14.1% of the South Australian population in 1997, compared to 14.0% in 1996 and 12.9% in 1991. Of the State's aged population, 90,869 (43.5%) were aged 75 years and over.

Persons aged 65 years or more accounted for 14.3% of the Adelaide SD population. Northern SD had the lowest proportion of aged persons (11.3%) of all the statistical divisions in South Australia, while Yorke and Lower North SD had the highest (18.6%). Within the Adelaide SD, the SLAs with the lowest proportions of person aged 65 years and over were Happy Valley (6.6%) and Munno Para (6.9%). The SLAs with the highest proportions of persons aged 65 years and over within the Adelaide SD were Brighton (26.7%) and Glenelg (24.4%).

Outside the Adelaide SD, Roxby Downs (1.1%) had the lowest proportion of persons aged 65 and over, while Victor Harbour (29.4%) had the highest.

SEX RATIO

At 30 June 1997, there were 731,919 males and 747,887 females resident in South Australia, giving an overall sex ratio (number of males per 100 females) of 97.9. In 1996, the sex ratio for the State was also 97.9, while in 1991 it was 98.5. Females outnumber males in the Adelaide SD (sex ratio 96.0), while the Rest of the State has more males than females (sex ratio 103.2).

In South Australia, male children outnumber female children, with the sex ratio being 105.6. The sex ratio for children has remained fairly stable since 1991. In the older age group, females continue to outnumber males. In 1997, the sex ratio for the population aged 65 years and over was 76.1, compared with 76.0 in 1996 and 74.6 in 1991.

EXPLANATORY NOTES

INTRODUCTION

- 1** This publication contains preliminary estimates of the resident population by age and sex in statistical local areas (SLAs) in South Australia at 30 June 1997.
- 2** The estimated resident population (ERP) is the official ABS estimate of the Australian population.

METHODOLOGY

- 3** The total population of each SLA is based on results of the 1996 Population Census and calculated for post-census dates by a linear regression model which uses independent indicators of population change such as dwelling approvals, licensed drivers and medicare enrolments. These inter-censal estimates of the resident population are revised each time a population census is taken.
- 4** The age and sex estimates were prepared using the cohort component method. Post-censal age distributions were obtained by advancing the age and sex estimates for 30 June 1996 to the next age, subtracting deaths and adding births and net estimated inter-regional and overseas migration. Inter-regional and overseas migration was estimated from analysis of arrivals and departures data and individual SLA profiles derived from the 1996 Census. More details can be provided by the ABS South Australian Office.
- 5** After each Census final estimates for the preceding inter-censal period are calculated by incorporating an additional adjustment (intercensal discrepancy) to ensure that the total inter-censal increase at each age agrees with the difference between the estimated resident population at the two respective census dates.
- 6** A detailed explanation of the concept of estimated resident population, as adopted by the Australian Bureau of Statistics (ABS) for official population estimates, is contained in the *ABS Information Paper: Population Estimates: Concepts, Sources and Methods* (Cat. no. 3228.0).

GEOGRAPHIC BOUNDARIES

- 7** The geographic areas used in this publication are defined in the *Australian Standard Geographical Classification, 1996 Edition* (Cat. no. 1216.0). The SLAs shown in this publication equate directly with local government areas except for Enfield which is split into two SLAs, Part A and Part B.
- 8** The SLA population estimates in this publication are calculated on SLA boundaries at 30 June 1997 which are identical to those at 30 June 1996.

RELIABILITY

- 9** All SLA estimates are shown to the nearest person, although accuracy to this level is not claimed and should not be assumed.

DATA ON FLOPPY DISK

- 10** The data in this publication are also available on floppy disk.

11 The ABS compiles and publishes *Population Projections for Australia, States and Territories* (Cat. no. 3222.0).
