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MAIN FEATURES

SOUTH AUSTRALIA

South Australia's estimated resident population at 30 June 1999 was 1,493,100, an increase of 6,700 (0.4%) since 1998, and 26,900 (1.8%) since 1994.

The population of the Adelaide Statistical Division (SD) was 1,092,900 or 73.2% of the total population for the State, an increase of 5,100 persons (0.5%) over the 1998 figure. Since 1994, the population of the Adelaide SD has increased by 21,200 persons (2.0%).

CHILDREN (UNDER 15 YEARS)

The number of children in 1999 was 293,900, a decrease of 2,300 (–0.8%) since 1998. The proportion of the State's population aged under 15 years has continued to decline. Children represented 20.5% of the State's population in 1994, 19.9% in 1998 and 19.7% in 1999.

Adelaide SD had the lowest proportion of children (18.7%) of all statistical divisions in South Australia. The SLAs with the lowest proportion of children within the Adelaide SD were Adelaide (5.4%) and Holdfast Bay—North (12.1%), while Playford—West Central (28.0%) replaced Salisbury—Inner North (27.8%) as the SLA with the highest proportion of children.

Outside the Adelaide SD, the Northern SD (23.5%) had the highest proportion of children in the resident population. The SLA of Roxby Downs (30.7%) had the highest proportion of children, while Victor Harbor (16.7%) had the lowest.

THE AGED (65 YEARS AND OVER)

There were 214,400 aged persons resident in South Australia at 30 June 1999, an increase of 2,700 persons (1.3%) since 1998 and 14,800 persons (7.4%) since 1994. The size of South Australia's aged population is increasing at a higher rate than the population as a whole. Persons aged 65 years and over constituted 14.4% of the South Australian population in 1999, compared to 14.2% in 1998 and 13.6% in 1994. Of the State's aged population, 23,400 (10.9%) were aged 85 years and over.

Persons aged 65 years or more accounted for 14.5% of the Adelaide SD population. Within the Adelaide SD, the SLAs with the lowest proportions of person aged 65 years and over were Tea Tree Gully—North (4.9%) and Salisbury—Balance (5.1%). The SLAs with the highest proportions of persons aged 65 years and over within the Adelaide SD were Holdfast Bay—South (25.6%) and Holdfast Bay—North (24.9%).

Outside the Adelaide SD, the Yorke and Lower North SD (19.0%) had the highest proportion of aged persons. The SLA of Roxby Downs (1.1%) had the lowest proportion of persons aged 65 and over, while Victor Harbor (29.0%) had the highest.

SEX RATIO

At 30 June 1999, there were 738,300 males and 754,700 females resident in South Australia, giving an overall sex ratio (number of males per 100 females) of 97.8. In 1998, the sex ratio for the State was 97.8, while in 1994 it was 98.1. Females outnumber males in the Adelaide SD (sex ratio 96.0), while the Rest of the State has more males than females (sex ratio 102.9).

In South Australia, male children outnumber female children, with the sex ratio being 105.3. The sex ratio for children has remained fairly stable since 1994. In the older age group, females continue to outnumber males. In 1999, the sex ratio for the population aged 65 years and over was 76.8, compared with 76.6 in 1998 and 75.4 in 1994.

EXPLANATORY NOTES

INTRODUCTION

- 1** This publication contains preliminary estimates of the resident population by age and sex in statistical local areas (SLAs) in South Australia at 30 June 1999.
- 2** The estimated resident population (ERP) is the official ABS estimate of the Australian population.

METHODOLOGY

- 3** The total population of each SLA is based on results of the 1996 Population Census and calculated for post-census dates by a linear regression model which uses independent indicators of population change such as dwelling approvals, licensed drivers and medicare enrolments. These intercensal estimates of the resident population are revised each time a population census is taken.
- 4** The age and sex estimates were prepared using the cohort component method. Post-censal age distributions were obtained by advancing the age and sex estimates for 30 June 1996 to the next age, subtracting deaths and adding births and net estimated inter-regional and overseas migration. Inter-regional and overseas migration was estimated from analysis of arrivals and departures data and individual SLA profiles derived from the 1996 Census. More details can be provided by the ABS South Australian Office.
- 5** After each Census final estimates for the preceding intercensal period are calculated by incorporating an additional adjustment (intercensal discrepancy) to ensure that the total intercensal increase at each age agrees with the difference between the estimated resident population at the two respective census dates.
- 6** A detailed explanation of the concept of estimated resident population, as adopted by the ABS for official population estimates, is contained in the ABS Information Paper: *Population Estimates: Concepts, Sources and Methods* (Cat. no. 3228.0).

GEOGRAPHIC BOUNDARIES

- 7** The geographic areas used in this publication are defined in the *Australian Standard Geographical Classification, 1999 Edition* (Cat. no. 1216.0).

RELIABILITY

- 8** All SLA estimates are shown to the nearest person, although accuracy to this level is not claimed and should not be assumed.

ELECTRONIC DATA

- 9** The data in this publication are also available electronically.

POPULATION PROJECTIONS

- 10** The ABS compiles and publishes *Population Projections for Australia, States and Territories* (Cat. no. 3222.0).
- 11** The ABS as part of its Statistical Consultancy Service can prepare ad hoc population projections at the SLA or higher level. The projections are based on the latest ERP by age and sex. Clients can supply their own assumptions or approve the use of ABS formulated assumptions.
