

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

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## MAIN FEATURES

- The Estimated Resident Population (ERP) of Western Australia at 30 June 1996 was 1,765,256. This is an increase of 129,189 persons or 7.90% from 30 June 1991.
- The proportion of the State population residing in the Perth Statistical Division was 73.4% at 30 June 1996. This figure has risen from 72.7% at 30 June 1991 and prior to this had risen slowly from 68.2% in 1971.
- The South West Statistical Division has the second highest ERP after the Perth Statistical Division, and is followed by the Central and the South-Eastern Statistical Divisions.
- Since 30 June 1991 the South West Statistical Division has grown by 14.78%, compared with growth of 9.83% and 8.94% in the Kimberley and Perth Statistical Divisions, respectively.
- In the five years since 30 June 1991, the Pilbara and Upper Great Southern Statistical Divisions have fallen in population by 13.16% and 6.44%, respectively.

**1993-94 to 1995-96**




### PERTH STATISTICAL DIVISION

- Between 30 June 1991 and 30 June 1996 the ERP of the Perth Statistical Division increased by 106,330 persons to 1,295,092 an increase of 8.94%.
- In the five years since 30 June 1991, four Statistical Local Areas (SLAs) experienced growth in excess of 30%. The SLA of Wanneroo - North-West experienced the strongest growth, with a rate of 204.90%, and was followed by the SLA of Wanneroo - Central Coastal (53.84%), the City of Rockingham (39.43%) and the Shire of Swan (30.90%).

- The two most populated Local Government Areas (LGAs) in Western Australia are the City of Wanneroo with 213,368 residents and the City of Stirling (182,461 residents). The third most populated LGA in the Perth Statistical Division is the City of Melville with 93,942 persons.


**GROWTH RATE - ESTIMATED RESIDENT POPULATION

#### REST OF THE STATE

- Between 30 June 1991 and 30 June 1996 the ERP of the Rest of the State increased by 22,859 to 470,164, an increase of 5.11%.
- The South West Statistical Division continues to remain the dominant statistical division outside the Perth Statistical Division. Since 30 June 1991 its population has grown from 145,730 to 167,274, an increase of 21,544 persons or 14.78%.
- In the past five years six SLAs have experienced growth in excess of 30%. The Shire of Wiluna's population increased by 194.92%, and was followed by the City of Mandurah (38.45%), and the Shires of Greenough (32.59%), Menzies (32.09%), Toodyay (31.57%) and Augusta-Margaret River (30.36%).


**GROWTH RATE - ESTIMATED RESIDENT POPULATION**

**AGE AND SEX OF ERP IN  
WESTERN AUSTRALIA**

- There were 887,577 males and 877,679 females in Western Australia as at 30 June 1996.
- Males outnumber females in all Statistical Divisions except Perth where there are 10,050 more females.
- The Statistical Divisions which have the greatest percentage of males are the mining areas of Pilbara (55.14%) and South Eastern (54.64%).
- Females outnumber males in all age groups over 64 years of age and make up 55.81% of the population aged 65 years and over.
- The median age of Western Australia's population has gradually increased from 30.09 years in 1986 to 33.05 years as at 30 June 1991. The median age of males was 32.50 years and females, 33.62 years.
- As at 30 June 1996 there are 1,189,048 persons of working age (15 - 64) in Western Australia, and 882,354 of them reside in the Perth Statistical Division. Males account for 50.86% of the population of working age.
- There are 576,208 persons of dependent age (0 - 14 and 65+) in Western Australia, comprising 392,858 aged between 0 and 14 years and 183,350 aged 65 and over.
- The Pilbara and Kimberley Statistical Divisions have the greatest proportion of "young dependents", with 28.76% and 29.44%, respectively. They also have the lowest proportion of "old dependents", with 1.85% and 4.37%, respectively.
- The South West and Lower Great Southern Statistical Divisions have the greatest proportion of "old dependents", with 12.37% and 12.12%, respectively.

## **EXPLANATORY NOTES**

### **INTRODUCTION**

- 1** This publication presents the estimates of the resident population of Western Australia by age and sex at 30 June 1996. Data have been compiled for Statistical Divisions, Subdivisions and Statistical Local Areas (SLAs). Estimates of SLA populations at 30 June 1991 are included for comparison.

### **METHODOLOGY**

- 2** The estimated resident populations (ERP) contained in this publication are the official Australian population estimates. They are derived from the 1991 and 1996 Censuses of Population and Housing. A detailed explanation of the conceptual basis is given in the ABS Information Paper entitled *Demographic Estimates: Concepts, Sources and Methods* (Catalogue Number 3228.0) issued on 23 June 1995.
- 3** The Census of Population and Housing place of enumeration figures are based on counts of persons at their actual location on Census night and include persons enumerated at their usual place of residence, persons usually resident elsewhere in Australia and overseas visitors temporarily in Australia.
- 4** A Post Enumeration Survey is conducted after each Census to determine the under-enumeration and calculate undercount rates. These rates take into account differences in undercount according to a person's age, sex and geographic location.
- 5** The estimated resident population for each SLA was derived by making the following adjustments:
  - a**) Census counts on a place of usual residence basis are obtained by counting each person in their stated SLA of usual residence rather than where they were counted on Census night. Overseas visitors are excluded from these counts.
  - b**) The usual residence Census counts are then adjusted for Census under-enumeration by applying undercount rates derived from the Post Enumeration Survey.
  - c**) Australian residents temporarily overseas on Census night, excluded from Census counts, are added back into the population. Estimates of Australians temporarily overseas on Census night are obtained from passenger card data for persons returning to Australia in the year following the Census.
  - d**) The above adjustments were used to derive the estimated resident populations for each SLA on the Census nights, 6 August 1991 and 6 August 1996. The ERP for each SLA for 30 June 1996 was derived by adjusting for natural increase and net migration between 1 July and 6 August.

### **USUAL RESIDENCE NOT STATED**

- 6** In the 1991 and 1996 Censuses those persons in Western Australia for whom the SLA of usual residence was not stated were distributed proportionally to all SLAs in the State. In previous Censuses they were allocated to the SLA in which they were enumerated.

### **AREA STATISTICS**

- 7** ABS area statistics are classified according to the *Australian Standard Geographical Classification, 1996 Edition* (Catalogue Number 1216.0). Figures previously published for local government areas, statistical sub-divisions and divisions are directly comparable with this classification. The Cities of Perth, Fremantle, Stirling and Wanneroo comprise a number of SLAs. However estimates for individual SLAs were not compiled for these areas prior to 1986.

**BOUNDARY AND NAME CHANGES**

- 8** SLAs are marked (C) for City, (T) for Town or (S) for Shire. The names and designations are as they existed at 30 June 1996.
- 9** A new edition of the Australian Standard Geographical Classification came into effect on 1 July 1996. The changes to the area classification have been incorporated in these estimates for 30 June 1996, which are based on the 1996 Census of Population and Housing (which used the 1996 Edition of the classification).
- 10** The City of Wanneroo has been split into five statistical local areas: Central Coastal, North-East, North-West, South-East and South-West. The internal boundaries delineating the three statistical local areas in the City of Stirling were revised to form three new statistical local areas. Two areas retained their names of Central and South-Eastern and the other was named Coastal. The internal boundary delineating the two statistical local areas in the City of Fremantle was redrawn, moving one mainly residential block from Fremantle (C) - Inner to Fremantle (C) - Remainder.
- 11** The Town of Victoria Park was transferred from the Central Metropolitan SSD to the South East Metropolitan SSD in the Perth Statistical Division.
- 12** The Shire of Ngaanyatjarraku was transferred from the Carnegie SSD in the Central Statistical Division to the Lefroy SSD in the South Eastern Statistical Division.

**REVISIONS**

- 13** The ERP for intercensal years are being revised to take account of the intercensal discrepancy for each SLA. The revisions will be available later this year.

**RELIABILITY**

- 14** Although estimates are calculated and presented to the nearest whole number, accuracy to this level is not claimed and should not be assumed.


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
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
