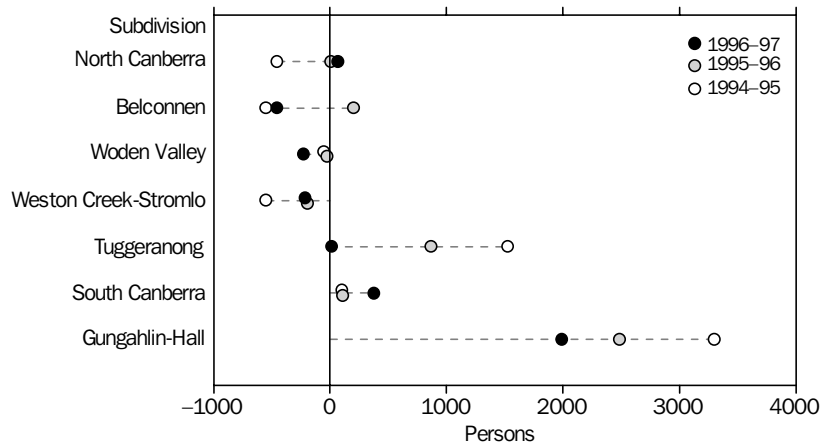
# SUMMARY OF FINDINGS

## TOTAL POPULATION

The estimated resident population (ERP) of the Australian Capital Territory (ACT) as at 30 June 1997 was 309,800, an increase of 1,500 since June 1996. The growth rate for 1996–97 was 0.5%, compared with a growth rate of 1.1% for the previous financial year. The rate of growth for 1996–97 was the lowest ever recorded since 1943.

Population growth varied considerably between subdivisions in 1996–97. As a result of the development of new suburbs of Ngunnawal, Nicholls, Palmerston and Amaroo, Gungahlin-Hall recorded the largest population increase (up 2,000 persons or 15.7%). South Canberra (up 380 persons or 1.7%), North Canberra (up 70 persons or 0.2%) and Tuggeranong (up 15 persons) showed small positive growth. There was some population decline in population with Belconnen (down 460 persons or 0.5%) recording the largest decrease in 1996–97. For Belconnen, families with teenagers or younger children tended to moved out of these subdivisions, possibly to newly developed areas in the ACT or interstate, but this outward movement was mostly offset by people in their twenties and fifties moving into Belconnen.

## AGE

The median age of the population (where half are older and half younger) of the ACT at 30 June 1997 was 31.6 years, an increase of 6.2 years in the last 20 years, 3.2 years in the last 10 years and 0.3 years since 30 June 1996. However, the ACT has a much younger population than for Australia as a whole, being 2.7 years lower than the Australian median age of 34.3 years. The highest median age among the subdivisions was in South Canberra (36.8 years), followed by Woden Valley (36.6 years), Weston Creek-Stromlo (36.2 years), North Canberra (32.2 years), Belconnen (31.2 years), Tuggeranong (29.0 years) and Gungahlin-Hall (27.6 years).

The population of the ACT is continuing to age, following the national trend. Over the last five years there has been a small decline in the population aged 0–14 years (decreased 2%), whereas the population aged 15–64 years has increased by 6% and the number of people aged 65 years and over has increased by 22%.

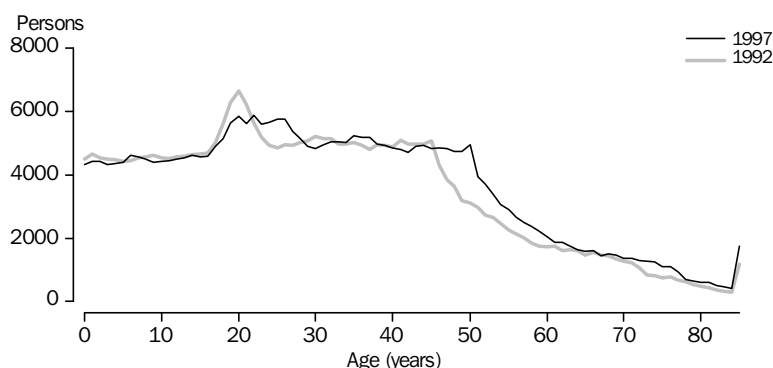
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### AGE *continued*

In the ACT the peak ages are in the late teens to mid 20s and fewer people aged over 50 years of age. This largely reflects the number of students who move to the ACT to undertake tertiary education. The size of each age group decreases dramatically after age 50.

In 1992 the large birth cohort of people born in 1971–72 was boosted by this influx of students to form a very dominant peak of 19–21 year olds. In 1997 the peak ages were spread over a wider range of ages, the largest single ages being 22 year olds followed by 20 and 25 year olds. The dominant peak in 1992 had declined because some of the peak age 20 year olds in 1992 (aged 25 years old in 1997) had moved away from the ACT after completing their studies.

POPULATION BY AGE

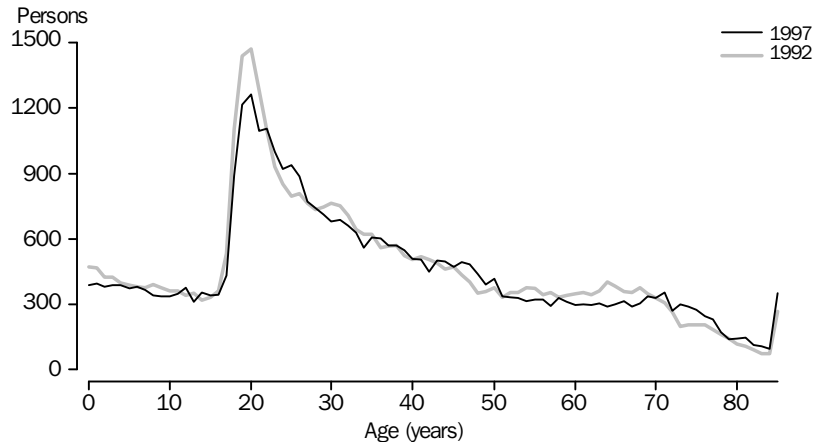


### POPULATION BY AGE IN SUBDIVISIONS

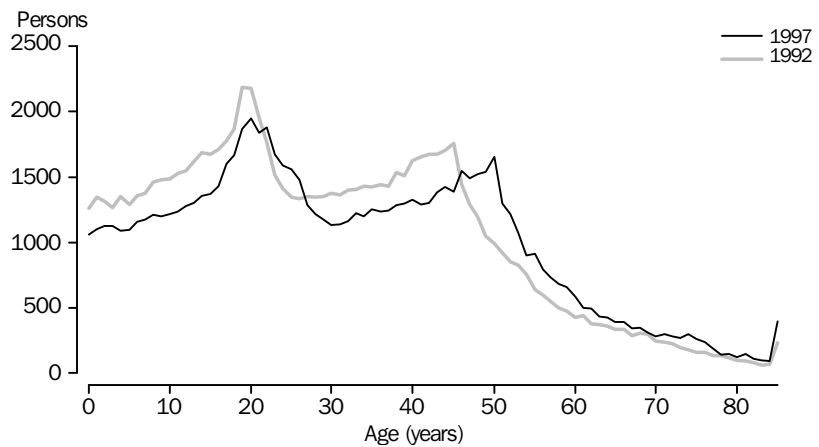
The age of the population in each subdivision varied considerably in 1997. There was a peak in the age structure in North Canberra, from age 18 to the mid 20s. This is primarily due to the high number of university students resident in Acton and surrounding suburbs and military personnel in Duntroon. A large proportion of Belconnen's population is also adolescents or young adults, illustrating the influence of the university and athletes at the AIS as well as the aging of the families in this subdivision who moved in when many of the suburbs were established in the early 1970s (the peak age groups were 19–22 years olds and 46–50 years olds). Woden Valley's age structure is much more evenly spread than the other subdivisions. Like Belconnen, Weston Creek-Stromlo's population were older families, but unlike Belconnen, there were more people aged 48–50 years in this subdivision than there were adolescents or young adults (as it does not have the influence of any university or sport-related campuses in the subdivision). Tuggeranong also has a similar double peak, but with much younger families, the peaks were at younger ages. The more established subdivision of South Canberra has many people in their 20s and 30s, but relatively few children, as well as a high proportion of older people. Like Tuggeranong, the newly developed Gungahlin-Hall subdivision is mostly populated with young families, but unlike Tuggeranong, this subdivision also has a large proportion of young adults who have not yet had children.

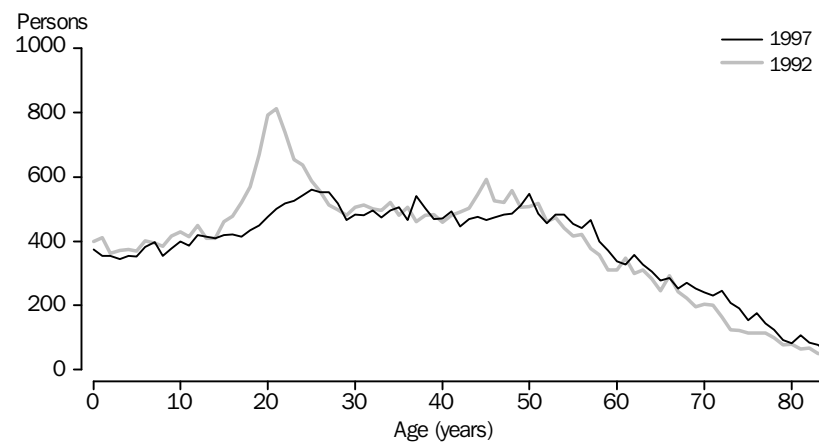
AGE OF POPULATION—NORTH CANBERRA SUBDIVISION



AGE OF POPULATION—BELCONNEN SUBDIVISION

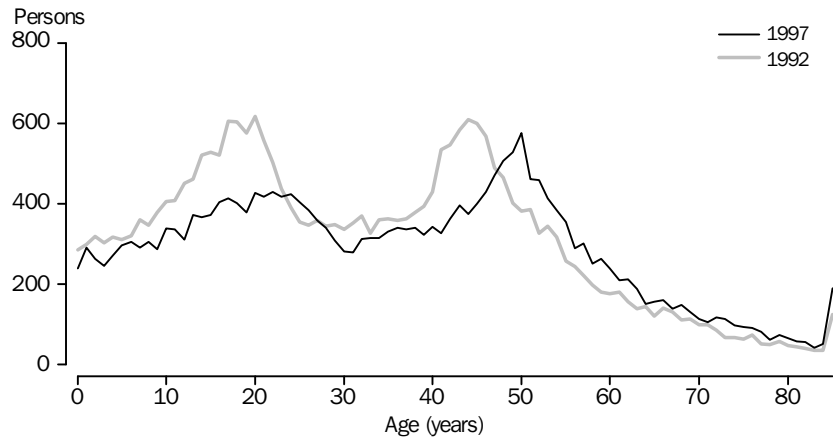


AGE OF POPULATION—WODEN VALLEY SUBDIVISION

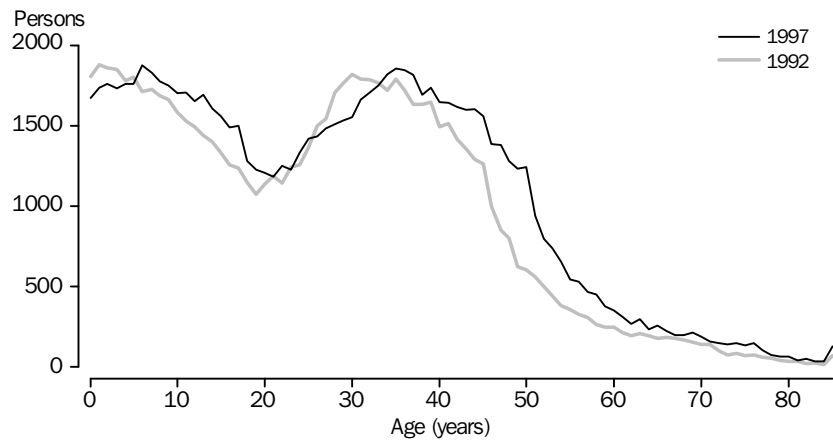

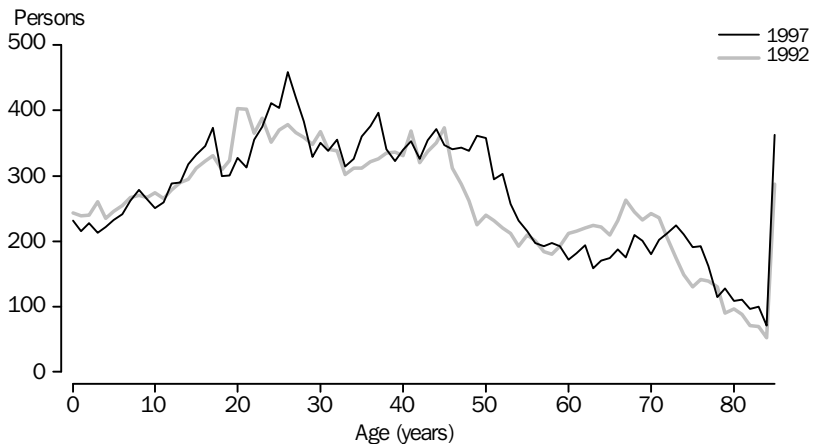
AGE OF POPULATION—WESTON CREEK-STROMLO SUBDIVISION



AGE OF POPULATION—TUGGERANONG SUBDIVISION

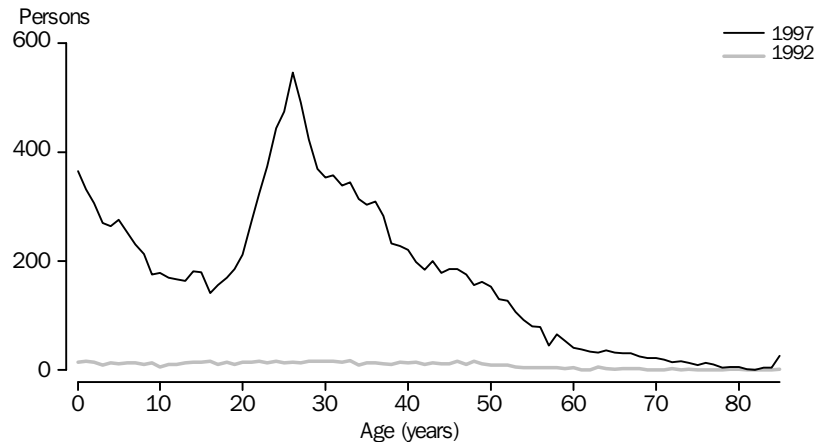


AGE OF POPULATION—SOUTH CANBERRA SUBDIVISION

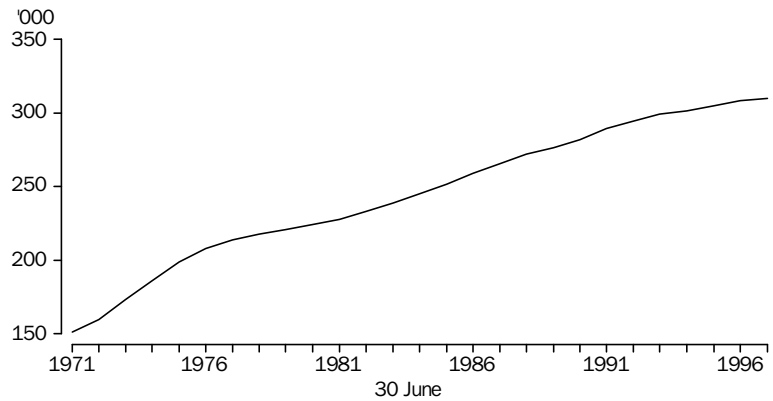

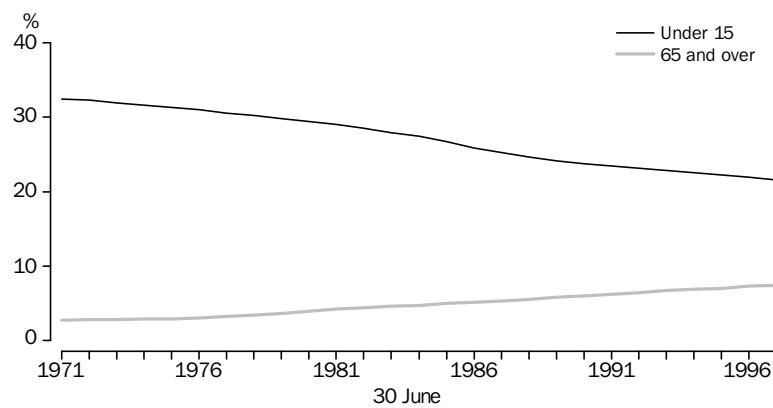
AGE OF POPULATION—GUNGAHLIN-HALL SUBDIVISION

# ANALYSIS

## POPULATION AGED UNDER 15 YEARS

The population aged 0–14 years was 66,800 or 21.6% of the population of the ACT as at 30 June 1997, compared with 65,400 persons (30.6%) 20 years ago. As the following map shows, the largest proportions of the population aged under 15 years were concentrated mostly in Tuggeranong, North Belconnen and Gungahlin. Low proportions were recorded in the inner north or inner south as well as inner Belconnen where students and young working adults without children tend to live.

The suburbs with the highest proportion of children aged 0–14 years were all in the recently developed subdivision of Tuggeranong. These included Gilmore (35.7%), Conder (35.0%), Macarthur (34.3%), and Chisholm and Richardson (both 34.1%). The lowest proportions of the population under 15 years were in Acton (0.8%), due to the large student population in this suburb, and Phillip (5.1%), related to the large young adult population living in medium to high density dwellings in this suburb.

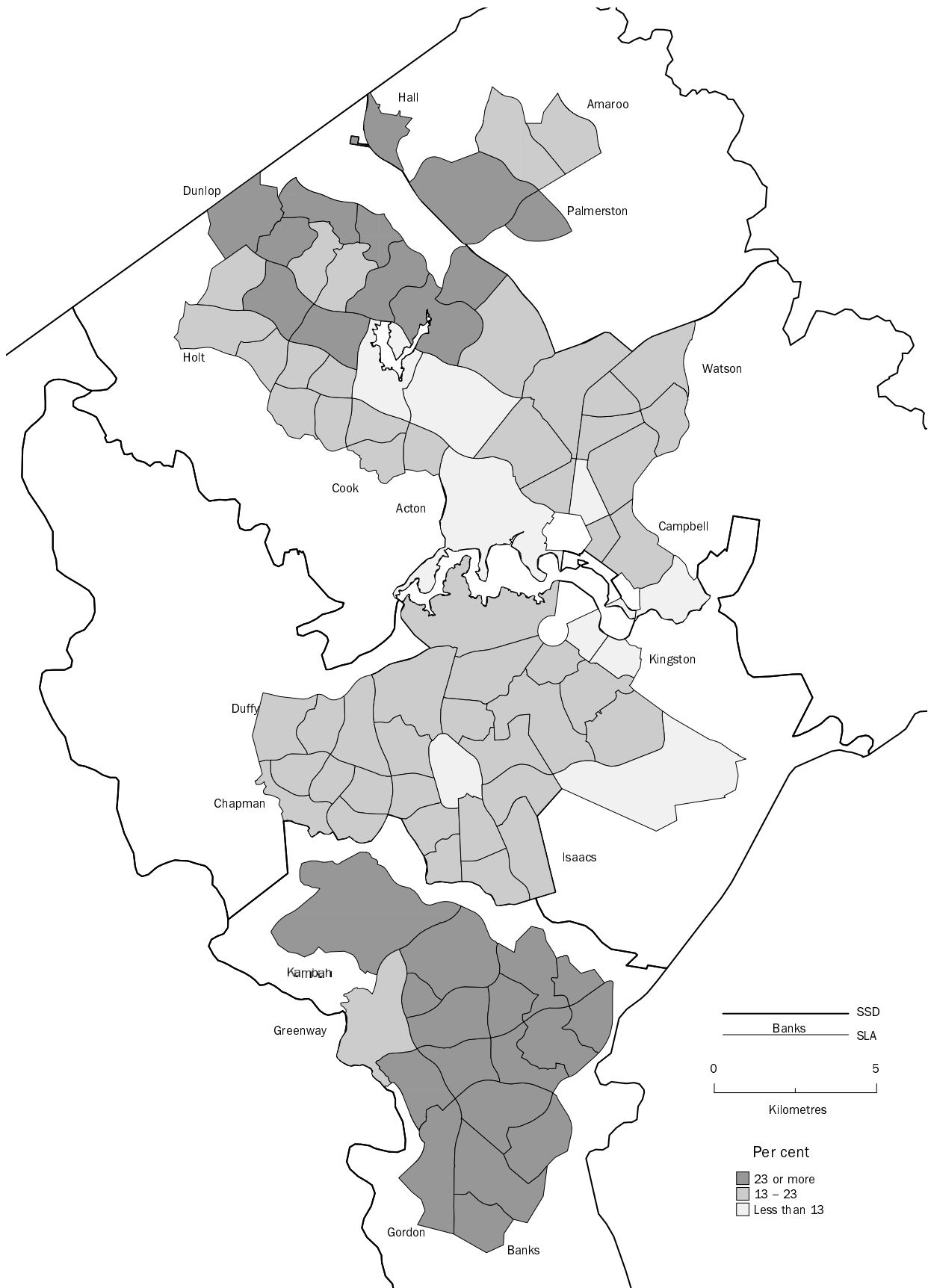

# ANALYSIS

## POPULATION AGED 15–24 YEARS

The population aged 15–24 years was 53,400 or 17.3% of the population of the ACT as at 30 June 1997, compared with 39,700 persons (18.6%) 20 years ago. The suburbs with the highest proportion of people aged 15–24 years were those with institutions attracting these people, for example, Acton (81.3%), Duntroon (72.4%) and Bruce (43.0%). Belconnen Town Centre (42.8%) has a large amount of medium to high density dwellings, attracting young childless adults.

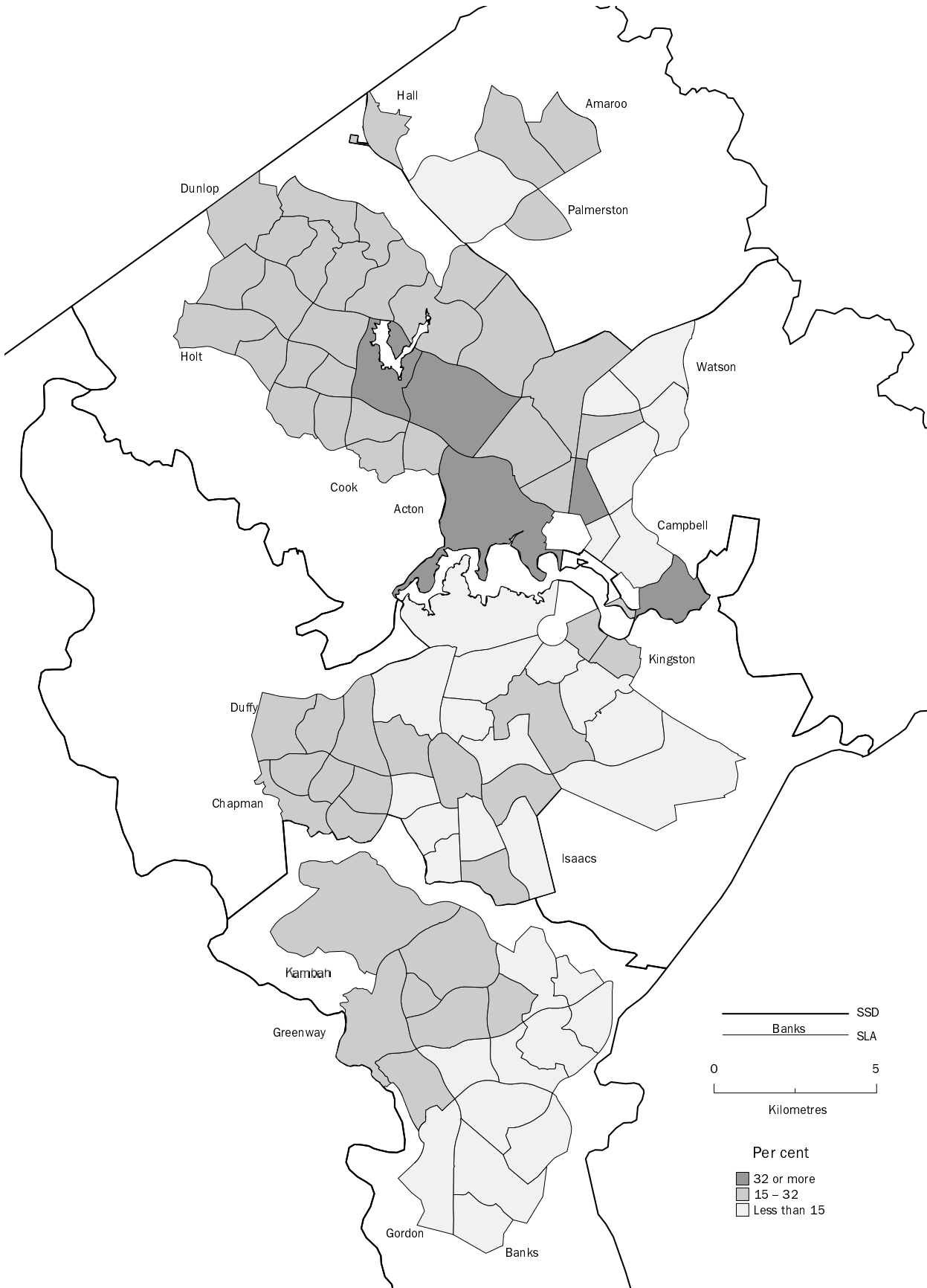
As to be expected, many of the newly developed suburbs in Tuggeranong had low proportions of people in the 15–24 years age group. The older and more established suburbs in Canberra's centre (such as Downer, Watson, Hackett and Narrabundah) also had lower proportions of this age group.

## ANALYSIS

### POPULATION AGED 65 YEARS AND OVER

The population aged 65 years and over was 23,000 or 7.4% of the population of the ACT as at 30 June 1997, compared with 6,800 persons (3.2%) 20 years ago. During this period, the number of people aged over 85 years grew from 400 persons in 1977 to 1,800 persons in 1997.

The largest proportion of the population aged 65 years and over were in the older suburbs of Canberra, mostly in the south (for example, Deakin (22.0%), Red Hill (17.7%) and Narrabundah (17.6%)) and in the north (such as Campbell (18.6%) and Ainslie (17.6%)). This may be attributed to people who moved to these suburbs of Canberra earlier in their life and have remained living in these suburbs as they have aged.

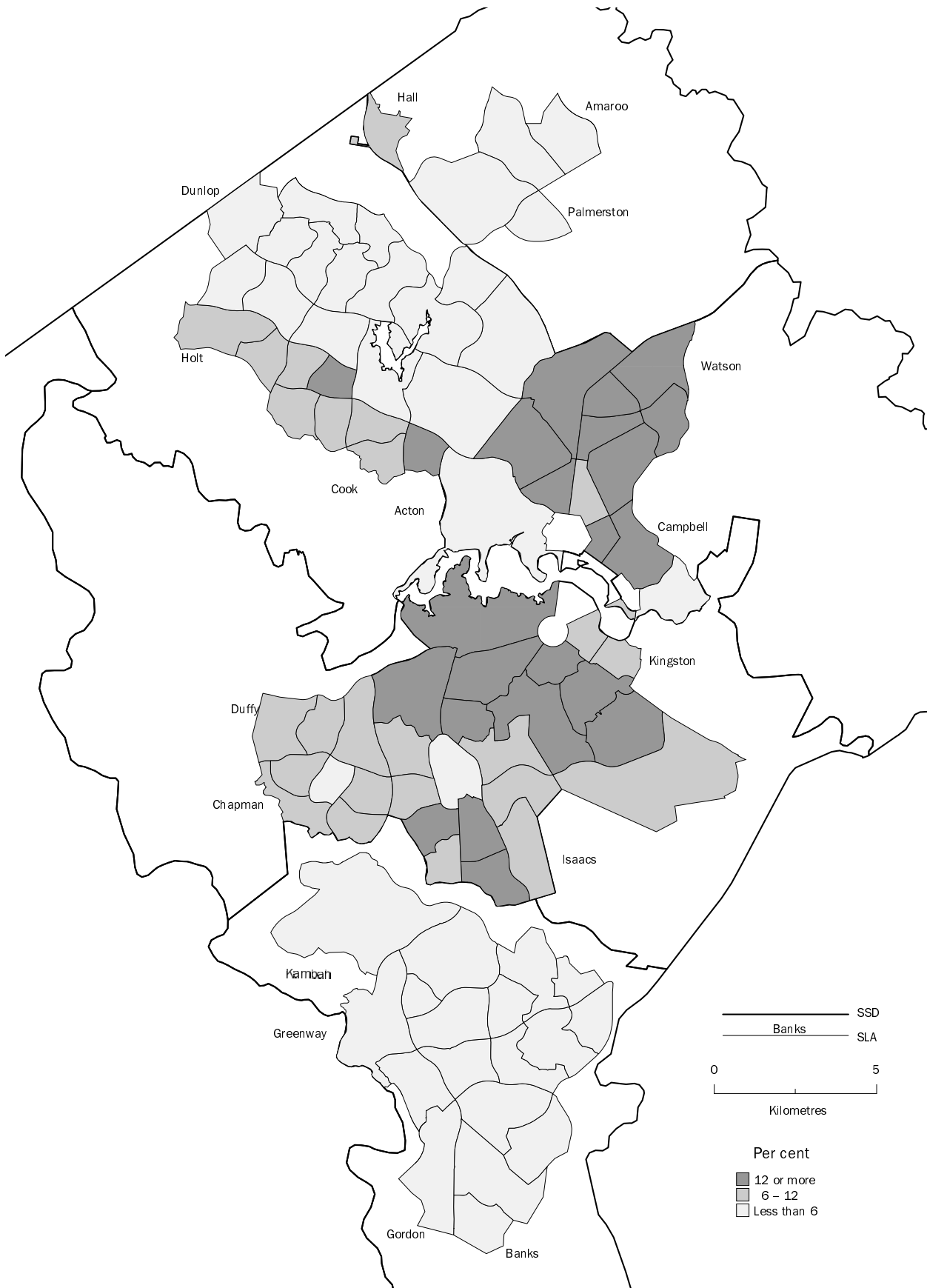
Very low proportions of people aged over 65 years were recorded for all suburbs in Tuggeranong and Gungahlin as these subdivisions are mostly populated by young families or young adults without children. Most of the suburbs in Belconnen had very low proportions of people aged over 65 years, except in areas where retirement villages or nursing homes are available (such as Aranda and Page).

## EXPLANATORY NOTES

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### INTRODUCTION

**1** This publication contains preliminary estimated resident population (ERP) by age and sex for the Statistical Local Areas (SLA) of the ACT at 30 June 1997.

### POPULATION ESTIMATES

**2** The ERP of an area is the estimate of the number of people who usually reside in that area.

**3** An explanation of the concept of ERP, as adopted by the Australian Bureau of Statistics (ABS) for official population estimates, is given in *Information Paper: Demographic Estimates—Concepts, Sources and Methods* (Cat. no. 3228.0) issued on 23 June 1995.

### METHODOLOGY

**4** The total population of each SLA is based on results of the 1996 Census of Population and Housing and calculated for post-census dates by a linear regression model which uses independent indicators of population change such as electricity connections, dwelling approvals and Medicare enrolments. These inter-censal estimates of the resident population are revised each time a population census is taken.

**5** The age and sex estimates were prepared using the cohort component method. Post-censal age distributions were obtained by advancing the age and sex estimates for 30 June 1996 to the next age, subtracting deaths and adding births and net estimated inter-regional and overseas migration. Inter-regional and overseas migration was estimated from analysis of arrivals and departures data and individual SLA profiles derived from the 1996 Census.

**6** After each census final estimates for the preceding inter-censal period are calculated by incorporating an additional adjustment (intercensal discrepancy) to ensure that the total inter-censal increase at each age agrees with the difference between the estimated resident population at the two respective census dates.

### GEOGRAPHIC BOUNDARIES

**7** The geographic areas used in this publication are defined in the *Statistical Geography: Volume 1—Australian Standard Geographical Classification (ASGC) Edition 2.6* (Cat. no. 1216.0). The boundaries of SLAs used in determining the population are those in existence at 30 June 1996. The population for previous years have been adjusted where appropriate so that they reflect the population changes for each area had the June 1996 boundaries existed then.

**8** The SLAs in Canberra equate directly with the suburbs. Details for the adjacent (New South Wales) Queanbeyan Subdivision are not included in this publication. They are published in *Population by Age and Sex, New South Wales* (Cat. no. 3235.1).

### RELIABILITY

**9** Although estimates of resident population are shown to the nearest unit, accuracy to this level is not claimed and should not be assumed.
