
SUMMARY OF FINDINGS

TOTAL POPULATION

The estimated resident population of the Australian Capital Territory (ACT) as at 30 June 1998 was 308,400, an increase of 400 since 30 June 1997. The growth rate for 1997–98 was 0.1%, compared with a growth rate of –0.1% for the previous financial year. The growth rate for Australia was 1.2% in 1997–98.

Population growth varied considerably between subdivisions in 1997–98. As a result of the development of the new suburbs of Ngunnawal, Nicholls, and Amaroo, Gungahlin-Hall Subdivision recorded the only population increase (up 1,600 persons or 10.8%). In all other subdivisions there was some decline in population with Weston Creek-Stromlo (down 336 persons or 1.4%) recording the largest decrease in 1997–98, followed by Belconnen (down 213 persons or 0.3%) and Tuggeranong (down 202 or 0.2%). For Belconnen Subdivision, families with teenagers or younger children tended to moved out, possibly to newly developed areas in the ACT or interstate, but this outward movement was partially offset by people aged fifty and over moving into Belconnen.

AGE

The median age of the population (where half are older and half younger) of the ACT at 30 June 1998 was 32.1 years, an increase of 6.4 years in the last 20 years, 3.4 years in the last 10 years and 0.4 years since 30 June 1997. However, the ACT has a much younger population than Australia as a whole, which has a median age of 34.6 years. The highest median age among the subdivisions was in South Canberra (37.6 years), followed by Woden Valley (37.5 years), Weston Creek-Stromlo (37.2 years), North Canberra (32.5 years), Belconnen (31.8 years), Tuggeranong (29.4 years) and Gungahlin-Hall (28.1 years).


The population of the ACT is continuing to age, following the national trend. Over the last five years there has been a small decline in the population aged 0–14 years (decreased by 4%), whereas the population aged 15–64 years has increased by 4% and the number of people aged 65 years and over has increased by 20%. This compares to an increase in population of 0–14 years by 2%, 15–64 years by 7% and 65 years and over by 11% for Australia.

AGE *continued*

In the ACT the peak ages are in the late teens to mid twenties with fewer people aged over 50 years. This largely reflects the number of students who move into the ACT to undertake tertiary education. The size of each age group decreases dramatically after age 50.

In 1993 the large birth cohort of people born in 1971–72 was boosted by this influx of students to form a very dominant peak of 19–21 year olds. In 1998 the peak population was spread over a wider range, the largest single ages being 21 years followed by 20 and 23 years. The dominant peak in 1993 had declined because some of the peak age 20 year olds in 1993 (aged 26 years old in 1998) had moved away from the ACT after completing their studies.




POPULATION BY AGE IN SUBDIVISIONS


The age of the population in each subdivision varied considerably in 1998. There was a peak in the age structure in North Canberra, between age 18 and the mid 20s. This is primarily due to the high number of university students resident in Acton and surrounding suburbs and military personnel in Duntroon. A large proportion of Belconnen's population is also adolescents or young adults, illustrating the influence of the university and athletes at the Australian Institute of Sport as well as the ageing of families in this subdivision who moved in when many of the suburbs were established in the early 1970s (the peak age groups in 1998 were 19–22 years olds and 46–51 years olds). Woden Valley's age structure is much more evenly spread than the other subdivisions. Like Belconnen, Weston Creek-Stromlo's population were older families, but unlike Belconnen, there were more people aged 48–50 years in this subdivision than there were adolescents or young adults (as it does not have the influence of any university or sport-related campuses in the subdivision). Tuggeranong has a similar double peak to Weston Creek-Stromlo, but with much younger families, the peaks were at younger ages. The more established subdivision of South Canberra has many people in their twenties and thirties, but relatively few children, as well as a high proportion of older people. Like Tuggeranong, the newly developed Gungahlin-Hall Subdivision is mostly populated with young families, but unlike Tuggeranong, this subdivision also has a large proportion of young adults who have not yet had children.


AGE OF POPULATION—North Canberra Subdivision



AGE OF POPULATION—Belconnen Subdivision




AGE OF POPULATION—Woden Valley Subdivision




AGE OF POPULATION—Weston Creek-Stromlo Subdivision



AGE OF POPULATION—Tuggeranong Subdivision




AGE OF POPULATION—South Canberra Subdivision





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
AGE OF POPULATION—Gungahlin-Hall Subdivision

ANALYSIS

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POPULATION AGED UNDER 15 YEARS

The population aged 0–14 years was 65,500 or 21.2% of the population of the ACT as at 30 June 1998, compared with 65,900 persons (30.2%) 20 years ago. As the following map shows, the areas with the largest proportions of children aged under 15 years were concentrated mostly in the newer suburbs of Tuggeranong, North Belconnen and Gungahlin. Areas with low proportions of children were found in the inner north and inner south as well as inner Belconnen, where students and young working adults without children, live.

The suburbs with the highest proportion of children aged 0–14 years were in the recently developed subdivision of Tuggeranong. These included Gilmore (35.4%), Conder (34.7%), Macarthur (34.2%), and Chisholm (33.7%). Acton had the lowest proportion of children (1.1%), due to the large student population in this suburb, followed by Phillip (4.6%), where it is related to the large young adult population living in medium to high density dwellings in this suburb.

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

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POPULATION AGED 15–24 YEARS

The population aged 15–24 years was 52,100 or 16.9% of the population of the ACT as at 30 June 1998, compared with 40,050 persons (18.4%) 20 years ago. The suburbs with the highest proportion of people aged 15–24 years were those with institutions attracting these people, for example, Acton (78.3%), Dunroon (70.8%) and Bruce (42.3%). Belconnen Town Centre (41.6%) has a large amount of medium to high density dwellings, attracting young childless adults.

As to be expected, many of the newly developed suburbs in Tuggeranong (such as Condor, Banks and Theodore) had low proportions of people in the 15–24 years age group. The older and more established suburbs in Canberra's centre (such as Campbell, Yarralumla and Ainslie) also had lower proportions of this age group.

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

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POPULATION AGED 65 YEARS AND OVER

The population aged 65 years and over was 24,020 or 7.8% of the population of the ACT as at 30 June 1998, compared with 7,420 persons (3.4%) 20 years ago. During this period, the number of people aged over 85 years grew from 450 persons (0.2%) in 1978 to 1,950 persons (0.6%) in 1998.

The largest proportion of the population aged 65 years and over were in the older suburbs of Canberra, mostly in the south (for example, Deakin (22.3%), Narrabundah (17.8%) and Yarralumla (17.6%) and in the north (for example Campbell (19.5%) and Ainslie (17.6%)). This may be attributed to people who moved to these suburbs of Canberra earlier in their life and have remained living in these suburbs as they have aged.

Very low proportions of people aged over 65 years were recorded for all suburbs in Tuggeranong and Gungahlin as these subdivisions are mostly populated by young families or young adults without children. Most of the suburbs in Belconnen had very low proportions of people aged over 65 years, except in areas where retirement villages or nursing homes are available (such as Aranda and Page).

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

EXPLANATORY NOTES

INTRODUCTION

1 This publication contains preliminary estimated resident population (ERP) by age and sex for the Statistical Local Areas (SLA) of the Australian Capital Territory at 30 June 1998.

POPULATION ESTIMATES

2 The ERP of an area is the estimate of the number of people who usually reside in that area.

3 An explanation of the concept of ERP, as adopted by the Australian Bureau of Statistics (ABS) for official population estimates, is given in *Information Paper: Demographic Estimates and Projections—Concepts, Sources and Methods* (Cat. no. 3228.0) issued on 23 June 1995.

METHODOLOGY

4 The total population of each SLA is based on results of the 1996 Census of Population and Housing and calculated for post-census dates by a regression model which uses independent indicators of population change such as electricity connections, dwelling approvals and Medicare enrolments. These inter-censal estimates of the resident population are revised each time a population census is taken.

5 The age and sex estimates were prepared using the cohort component method. Post-censal age distributions were obtained by advancing the age and sex estimates for 30 June 1996 to the next age, subtracting deaths and adding births and net estimated inter-regional and overseas migration. Inter-regional and overseas migration was estimated from analysis of arrivals and departures data and individual SLA profiles derived from the 1996 Census.

6 After each census final estimates for the preceding inter-censal period are calculated by incorporating an additional adjustment (intercensal discrepancy) to ensure that the total inter-censal increase at each age agrees with the difference between the ERP at the two respective census dates.

GEOGRAPHIC BOUNDARIES

7 The geographic areas used in this publication are defined in *Australian Standard Geographical Classification (ASGC), 1998* (Cat. no. 1216.0). The boundaries of SLAs used in determining the population are those in existence at 1 July 1998. The population for previous years have been adjusted where appropriate so that they reflect the population changes for each area had the July 1998 boundaries existed then.

8 The SLAs in Canberra equate directly with the suburbs. Details for the adjacent (New South Wales) Queanbeyan Subdivision are not included in this publication. They are published in *Population by Age and Sex, New South Wales* (Cat. no. 3235.1).

RELIABILITY

9 Although estimates of resident population are shown to the nearest unit, accuracy to this level is not claimed and should not be assumed.
