#### ABOUT THE PUBLICATION

This Special Data Series publication presents details on Private Acute and Psychiatric Hospitals from the 2001–2002 national census of private hospitals.

The 2001–2002 national census of private hospitals used two forms to collect data: PHE1 for private acute and psychiatric hospitals and PHE2 for free-standing day hospital facilities. A copy of the relevant collection form can be provided on request. The form contains definitions which may help you with the interpretation of the data in the tables.

Please note that in each table title, a reference to the relevant question number on the collection form is shown in brackets.


