About the data service

This data service presents quarterly statistics on the assets and liabilities of friendly societies.

Key points

The total assets of friendly societies was just over \$6 billion at 31 March 2003, virtually unchanged from the December quarter 2002. Short term securities decreased by \$0.4b (20%) and equities and units in trusts increased by \$0.3b (23%). Short and long term securities plus equities and units in trusts accounted for 72% of total assets.

Changes next issue

Following a rationalisation of dissemination practices, from the June 2003 issue onwards the release Friendly Societies Australia (Cat no 5660.0.40.001) will be discontinued. Instead this data will be available electronically via Ausstats in Managed Funds, Australia (Cat no 5655.0).

EXPLANATORY NOTES

Introduction

The statistics have been compiled from data furnished to the ABS by 25 of the largest friendly societies in the quarterly Survey of Financial Information.

Scope

A friendly society for the purposes of the survey is any organisation registered as a friendly society under the appropriate State legislation. All assets and liabilities of the friendly societies arising from services offered by them are within scope.

Coverage

The information in this table is compiled from data furnished to the ABS by 25 of the largest friendly societies as part of the Survey of Financial Information. These societies approximated 95 per cent of the total assets of friendly societies as at September 2002.

Basis of valuation

Respondents to the survey are requested to report assets at their market value.

Financial Instruments

The classification of financial instrument used follows that set out in the ABS Publication *Australian National Accounts, Financial Accounts (5232.0).* A definition of these instruments is contained in that publication.

Revisions

Revisions to previously published statistics are included in this publication.
