RELATED STATISTICS

This publication presents the value of sales and transfers out of commodities manufactured in Australia.

This issue formally introduces the Manufacturing Input-Output Commodity Classification (MIOCC), a new classification first used in the 1995-96 issue of this publication and slightly modified for this issue. This classification is based upon the Australian and New Zealand Standard Commodity Classification (ANZSCC). For more information, see paragraphs 4 and 5 of the Explanatory Notes.

The data contained in this publication have been adjusted for deficiencies in the number of businesses recorded on the Australian Bureau of Statistics (ABS) business register. The nature of these adjustments and the reasons for making them are described in paragraphs 22 and 23 of the Explanatory Notes.

Sales and transfers values for products shown in this publication exclude values for products manufactured or assembled on commission for non-manufacturers (such as wholesalers or retailers). Values for most products are unaffected or are affected in only a minor way. However, commission manufacture is a significant activity in some industries (see paragraphs 17 to 20 of the Explanatory Notes).

The 1996-97 MIOCC used in this issue is slightly modified from that used in the 1995-96 issue. Most changes are only descriptive but 1995-96 data in this issue have been footnoted where data comparability with 1996-97 has been affected.

Manufacturing industry statistics presenting structural data (such as employment, wages and salaries, turnover and industry gross product) based on the Australian and New Zealand Standard Industrial Classification (ANZSIC) for Australia and each State have been released in a series of publications Manufacturing Industry, 1996-97 (Cat. nos 8221.0 - 8221.6). The publication for New South Wales (Cat. no. 8221.1) also contains selected data for the Australian Capital Territory.

For many of the products included in this publication, corresponding imports and exports data are available. For further information about the availability of these data, please contact Information Services on Canberra 026252 5400, or any ABS State office (refer to the back of this publication for contact details).

Data on the quantity of commodities produced are no longer collected as part of the annual manufacturing collection, being last published for the 1993-94 reference year. However, quantity data for a limited number of commodity items are available from ABS subannual production collections. For more information, see paragraph 30 of the Explanatory Notes

In 1996-97 the total value of sales and transfers out of goods produced by manufacturing establishments was $\$ 194,475$ million. This was $3.7 \%$ higher than that recorded for the previous year, 1995-96, ( $\$ 187,629$ million), and 11.2\% higher than that for 1993-94 ( $\$ 174,875$ million), the earliest year for which corresponding data are available.

Under the MIOCC used in this issue, manufactured products are classified to 1,059 commodities. For the purposes of this publication, these commodities are grouped into nine main sections and 93 sub-sections. Published items may be single commodities or combinations of commodities which have been aggregated to enable publication.

For the 1996-97 year, 29 published commodity items showed sales and transfers out values in excess of $\$ 1,000$ million. Six of these exceeded $\$ 3,000$ million, with one exceeding $\$ 5,000$ million.

The published item with the largest value of sales and transfers out in 1996-97 was Cars, station wagons and other finished motor vehicles (with fewer than 10 persons capacity) (MIOCC 281111 and 281112), at $\$ 7,439$ million.

Other items which exceeded $\$ 3,000$ million in value of sales and transfers out in 1996-97 were:

- Automotive petrol; refined or blended gasoline; motor spirit (including aviation spirit) (MIOCC 251010) - \$4,010 million.
- Trade advertising material or commercial catalogues; printed pictures, designs and photographs; business forms; calendars; transfers (decalcomanias) and other printed matter, n.e.c. (MIOCC 241214) - \$3,804 million.
- Primary and secondary recovery of copper (including brass), nickel, lead, silver, platinum and zinc (all excluding from purchased scrap) (MIOCC 272311-272314, 272910 and 272911) - $\$ 3,473$ million.
- Bovine meat for human consumption (fresh, chilled or frozen) (MIOCC 211113) \$3,154 million.
- Alumina (basic metal) (MIOCC 272110) — $\$ 3,039$ million.

1 This publication presents the value of sales and transfers out of commodities manufactured in Australia, compiled from a sample survey of manufacturing establishments for 1996-97. The sample was drawn from the population of the manufacturing census of that year. Data on the quantity of commodities produced are no longer collected as part of the annual manufacturing collection and were last collected and published for the 1993-94 reference year.

2 The manufacturing collection is conducted on an annual basis. Businesses selected in the 1996-97 census were asked to provide data on employment, wages and salaries, turnover and the percentage of goods exported. A sample of approximately 7,000 manufacturing establishments was asked to supply additional information, including the value of sales and transfers out for commodities produced.

3 Details of commodities produced were previously collected as part of the 1995-96 and 1994-95 manufacturing surveys, as well as the 1993-94, 1989-90 and 1986-87 manufacturing censuses. In years prior to 1986-87, they were collected annually except for 1985-86, when no census was conducted. Commodity data are now being collected on an annual basis.
4 The Manufacturing Input-Output Commodity Classification (MIOCC) used in this publication is based on the Australian and New Zealand Standard Commodity Classification (ANZSCC) which was last used in the 1993-94 issue of this publication. The MIOCC covers the full range of manufacturing commodities produced and presents data at a broader level (in most cases) than the ANZSCC. The ANZSCC comprises approximately 2,500 commodity categories, whereas the MIOCC used in this publication comprises approximately 1,000 categories.

5 The MIOCC was first used to code sales and transfers out of commodities produced for the 1994-95 collection. However, due to its experimental nature, data for a significant number of commodities for that year are not available for publication or dissemination. The commodity classification was modified prior to its use in the 1995-96 collection and further slightly modified for the 1996-97 collection. Data for the full range of commodities collected are included in this publication.

## SCOPE AND COVERAGE

6 The statistics in this publication relate to all manufacturing establishments which operated in Australia during the years ended 30 June 1996 and 30 June 1997. Excluded are those manufacturers not employing staff at 30 June of the reference year (such as sole proprietorships or family partnerships) which had not registered as group employers with the Australian Taxation Office. Though a substantial number, these businesses would contribute only marginally to aggregate data were they to be included. Also excluded is the production from establishments predominantly engaged in non-manufacturing activities but which also undertake limited manufacturing activities. However, except for a few commodities, the effect of this on production levels is marginal.

## STANDARD UNITS

## Establishment

7 The establishment is the smallest accounting unit of a business, within a State or Territory, controlling its productive activities and maintaining a specified range of detailed data enabling value added to be calculated. In general, an establishment covers all operations at a physical location, but may consist of a group of locations provided they are within the same State or Territory. The majority of establishments operate at one location only.

## Manufacturing establishment

8 A manufacturing establishment is one predominantly engaged in manufacturing activities. The data collected for such establishments cover all activities of the establishment (including non-manufacturing activities). Conversely, some establishments are predominantly engaged in non-manufacturing activities while undertaking limited manufacturing activities and are excluded.

9 A small number of manufacturing establishments engage, in a significant way, in a variety of activities which are normally carried out by different industries. For example, a predominantly manufacturing establishment may also undertake significant amounts of wholesaling. In such cases, the original establishment is 'split' into a separate establishment for each significant activity which belongs to a separate industry. For the 1996-97 manufacturing collection, 'significant' was defined as $\$ 7.3$ million or more.

## COMMODITY ITEMS COLLECTED

10 In summary, the value of sales and transfers out relates to goods sold or transferred during the year excluding goods resold without processing. In general, sales values represent the amounts received by manufacturers, minus sales taxes, excise duties and delivery or installation charges (where separately invoiced to customers). Exports are valued on a free on board basis. Transfers (goods produced then physically transferred elsewhere within the same business for sale or further processing) are valued at commercial value, i.e. the amount that would have been received had the goods been sold to another business (also net of taxes, etc.). Further information on the valuation of goods sold or transferred is in paragraphs 11 to 14 .

11 Manufacturing establishments were asked to report the value of sales of specified products that they had manufactured or that had been manufactured on commission for them. (See paragraphs 17 to 20 for an explanation of the treatment of transactions which are carried out on a commission basis.)

12 The valuation which was sought was the factory selling value. The concept of factory selling value is the amount which was paid by the purchaser (after deducting discounts but ignoring trade-ins) to the manufacturer minus any sales taxes or excise duties payable to the government or any charges for delivery or installation. However, it was not always possible for manufacturers to net off the value of delivery or installation, so reported values will include those elements in some cases.

13 Where businesses operate more than one establishment, they are asked to report for each manufacturing establishment the value of those products which are manufactured and then transferred to another establishment either for sale or for further processing. Excluded are any products which are transferred to other establishments for storage or quality inspection, testing, etc. purposes.

COMMISSION MANUFACTURING
17 Manufacturing on a commission basis involves one establishment manufacturing or assembling products using materials provided by another establishment (generally an establishment owned by a different business). The establishment which provides the materials retains ownership of those materials and of the manufactured products made from them.

18 As products can only be sold by their owner, only the owning establishment can report the value of sales (and transfers out) in the manufacturing collection. In the case of commission production, the owning establishment reports the sales of products made for it on commission whereas the establishment which actually manufactures the products does not report any sales of goods produced as it does not own them.

19 Provided that the owning establishment is a manufacturing establishment and is therefore included in the scope of the manufacturing collection, there will be no gaps in market measurement as a result of commission arrangements. However, where products are manufactured on commission for non-manufacturing establishments, the sales value of that manufacturing will not be represented by the statistics in this publication.

20 Commission manufacturing occurs to some extent in most manufacturing industries and quite commonly on behalf of non-manufacturers. However, the scale of commission operations of this type is not generally high, except for products related to the oils and fats, textiles and clothing manufacturing industries. Affected to a lesser extent are products related to the meat processing, log sawmilling and timber dressing, printing, petroleum refining and ceramics manufacturing industries.

## RELIABILITY OF ESTIMATES

21 For information on this subject, see the section Technical Note.

22 All data in this publication have been adjusted to allow for lags in processing new businesses to the ABS business register, and the omission of some businesses from the business register. First, adjustments have been made to allow for new businesses which had commenced operations but for which details had not been processed to the ABS business register in time for inclusion in the annual manufacturing industry collection. Adjustments of this type will continue to be applied in future periods. Second, adjustments have been made for businesses which had been in existence for several years, but, for various reasons, were not previously added to the ABS business register. In this issue of this publication, a further set of adjustments have been made to allow for omissions not previously identified. In respect of this further set of adjustments, actual data have been collected for 1996-97 and adjustment factors have been applied for 1995-96. For more information on these various adjustments, please refer to the Information Paper: Improvements to ABS Economic Statistics, 1997 (Cat. no. 1357.0)
23 The majority of businesses affected by these lags and omissions and to which both types of adjustments apply are small in size. As a guide, the effect on 1996-97 total Australian turnover is an adjustment of $2.2 \%$.

## COMPARABILITY WITH PREVIOUS STATISTICS

24 The 1993-94 manufacturing census was the first and only collection in which ANZSCC-based commodity production quantity and sales data were collected. Commodity production quantity data was not collected thereafter. The 1994-95 manufacturing survey introduced an experimental commodity classification into the manufacturing collection, which was modified prior to its use in the 1995-96 manufacturing survey. The classification was slightly modified to become the MIOCC used for the 1996-97 collection. For further information, see paragraphs 4 and 5 of these Explanatory Notes.

## INFORMATION PAPER

25 The Information Paper: Availability of Statistics Related to Manufacturing, 1997 (Cat. no. 8205.0) outlines the vast amount of data available about the manufacturing industry in both published and unpublished form available from the annual manufacturing industry collection and other ABS collections. This publication updates the 1996 issue.

STATE DATA
26 Because of the nature of the sample design, State level commodity production statistics are not available from the annual manufacturing collection. However, State level production quantity data for a limited number of commodity items are available from ABS subannual production collections. For further information, see paragraph 30 of these Explanatory Notes.

## ACKNOWLEDGMENT

27 ABS publications draw extensively on information provided freely by individuals, businesses, governments and other organisations. Their continued cooperation is very much appreciated: without it, the wide range of statistics published by the ABS would not be available. The data contained in this publication have been obtained from a sample of manufacturers. As such, these data are subject to sampling variability; that is, they may differ from the figures that would have been produced if the data had been obtained from all manufacturers in the population. One measure of the likely difference is given by the standard error, which indicates the extent to which an estimate might have varied by chance because the data were obtained from only a sample of units. There are about two chances in three that a sample estimate will differ by less than one standard error from the figure that would have been obtained if the data had been obtained from all units, and about 19 chances in 20 that the difference will be less than two standard errors.

The standard error can also be expressed as a percentage of the estimate, and this is known as the relative standard error. The relative standard error for most of the data contained in this publication is $24 \%$ or less. Detailed relative standard errors can be made available on request.

The effects of sampling variability have a particular relevance to the data contained in this publication. This is because the sample design is based on a sample of manufacturers classified by industry (who then report a value for all of the individual commodities that they sell or transfer out), rather than being based on a list of manufacturers of the various commodities. The sample is also orientated towards the larger businesses. As a result, it is possible that where the value of sales and transfers out for a particular commodity is shown as nil, this could be purely because no manufacturers of that commodity were selected in the industry-based sample. Commodities with a minimal value of sales and transfers out could be purely of this size for similar reasons. The effect is particularly important where either there are few producers of a commodity or there are many producers of the commodity but they are all (or mainly) small in size.

NON-SAMPLE ERROR
The imprecision due to sampling variability, which is measured by the standard error, should not be confused with inaccuracies that may occur because of inadequacies in available sources from which the population frame was compiled, imperfections in reporting by providers, errors made in collection such as in recording and coding data, and errors made in processing data. Inaccuracies of this kind are referred to collectively as non-sampling error and they may occur in any enumeration, whether it be a full count or a sample.

While it is not possible to quantify non-sampling error, every effort is made to reduce it to a minimum. Collection forms are designed to be easy to complete and assist businesses to report accurately. Efficient and effective operating procedures and systems are used to compile the statistics. In addition, the ABS has undertaken a program of upgrading the business register. This on-going upgrade has resulted in improvements in the quality of the statistical series whose population frames are drawn from the register.
